

This report is based on media monitoring of infectious and emerging diseases globally and within ASEAN Member States, to enhance pandemic and epidemic preparedness and response in the ASEAN Region. We publish this report three times a week.

Regional Situation

Dengue

- **Indonesia:** Gunungkidul District, Special Region of Yogyakarta Province reported 163 dengue cases with no deaths as of June 2026, a significant decline as the dry season begins (Harian Jogja, 2026). Monthly cases dropped from 62 in January to only three in June. Health authorities continue prevention activities through community education, larval monitoring, and ovitrap use, while maintaining vigilance. [\[Full article\]](#)

East Kalimantan Province reported 1,530 dengue cases with two deaths so far in 2026, yielding a case fatality rate of 0.13%, below the strategic target of 0.4% (Antara News, 2026). Highest case counts were reported in Balikpapan (327), Samarinda (246), and Kutai Kartanegara (241). Health authorities attribute low fatality to early medical intervention, vaccination, and *Wolbachia* mosquito control, while urging continued community participation in source reduction as larval indices remain at risk levels. Cirebon District, West Java Province, reported 350 cumulative dengue cases, representing a decline of approximately 50% compared with the previous period (Detik, 2026). Despite the reduction in cases, authorities continue to emphasize vigilance, sustained vector control, and public awareness, noting that favorable environmental conditions could lead to renewed transmission. - **Malaysia:** Kulim, Kedah, reported 74 cumulative dengue cases, indicating ongoing local transmission within the district (Sin Chew Daily, 2026). The case count reflects active circulation of the virus at the community level, likely driven by mosquito breeding conditions. In response, authorities have prompted continued vector control and public health monitoring to prevent further spread. [\[Full article\]](#)
- The **Philippines:** Norala District Hospital in South Cotabato reported 36 confirmed dengue cases as of late June 2026, with patients ranging from infants to 62 years old (22 male, 14 female) (Max FM Tacurong City Official, 2026). Authorities intensified fogging, larval surveillance, and community clean-up activities. The Department of Health's control strategy remains central, alongside public awareness efforts to reduce mosquito breeding and transmission. [\[Full article\]](#)



- **Singapore:** Health authorities reported 120 dengue cases in the past week, bringing the cumulative total to 1,196 cases in 2026, indicating ongoing transmission (8 world, 2026). Authorities continue to emphasize vector control, elimination of mosquito breeding sites, and public awareness measures to prevent further increases and reduce transmission risk. [[Full article](#)]

Hand, Foot and Mouth Disease (HFMD)

- **Indonesia:** Pulang Pisau District, Central Kalimantan Province reported seven cases of HFMD from May to June 2026, mostly affecting children (Newsway, 2026). Five cases were managed at local health facilities and two at the district hospital. Health authorities advise parents to monitor symptoms and promote hand hygiene, environmental sanitation, and reduced contact with cases. [[Full article](#)]
- **Viet Nam** reported approximately 55,000 cumulative HFMD cases nationwide, reflecting a sharp increase in transmission, particularly among children (VOV, 2026). Case numbers have reportedly doubled compared with the same period in previous years, indicating widespread virus circulation. Authorities have strengthened surveillance, promoted hygiene measures, and emphasized early detection and clinical management to reduce transmission and prevent severe complications. HIV/AIDS

- **Indonesia:** Samarinda Municipality, East Kalimantan Province reported 180 new HIV cases so far in 2026, with men who have sex with men (MSM) as the largest affected group (Nomor Satu Kaltim, 2026). Most cases occurred among people aged 20–40 years, and around 140 patients initiated treatment. Authorities emphasize early detection, treatment adherence, stigma reduction, and strengthened TB-HIV control measures. [[Full article](#)]

Malaria

- **Indonesia:** Sleman District, Special Region of Yogyakarta Province, reported 39 malaria cases in 2026, matching the total recorded throughout 2024 and indicating increased transmission in the district (Harian Jogja, 2026). The rise highlights the need for strengthened surveillance, early diagnosis, and vector control to prevent further spread and reduce the risk of sustained local transmission. [[Full article](#)]

Melioidosis

- **Viet Nam** reported one confirmed melioidosis case in Ho Chi Minh City involving a patient who developed severe liver and kidney failure following infection with *Burkholderia pseudomallei* (Suckhoedoisong, 2026). Authorities emphasize the importance of early diagnosis, prompt treatment, and proper wound protection, as melioidosis can progress rapidly and become life-threatening despite its relatively low incidence. Mpox

- The **Philippines**: The Department of Health (DOH) reported 44 mpox cases nationwide from January 1 to June 13, marking a 79% decrease compared to 205 cases in the same period last year (Malaya, 2026). A confirmed case was recently detected in Mandaluyong City. The DOH continues to coordinate with local government units and advises vigilance while stressing that overall transmission remains low. Mandaluyong, Metro Manila Province one mpox case, emphasizing that no outbreak has been identified (Rappler, 2026). The patient is being managed through isolation, contact tracing, and monitoring, with no additional linked cases detected to date. Authorities continue enhanced surveillance and response measures to prevent further spread. [\[Full article\]](#)

Tuberculosis (TB)

- **Indonesia** has reported 1,464 cumulative TB cases among inmates in correctional facilities nationwide, highlighting the substantial disease burden in high-risk, closed settings (DPR RI, 2026). Authorities are strengthening TB screening, early case detection, and treatment services within prisons and detention centers to reduce transmission and protect both inmates and staff. Health authorities in **Cilegon**, Banten Province, reported 816 cumulative TB cases in (Banten News, 2026). The findings indicate continued community transmission, particularly in densely populated areas. Authorities are strengthening active case finding, contact tracing, and treatment adherence to reduce transmission and improve treatment outcomes. [\[Full article\]](#)

Global Situation

Ebola

- **Democratic Republic of the Congo**: The Ministry of Health reported 1,307 confirmed Ebola cases as of June 29, 2026, including 377 deaths (case fatality rate: 28.8%) (Outbreak News Today, 2026). A total of 615 patients remain hospitalized or in isolation, while 180 have recovered. The outbreak affects health zones in Ituri, North Kivu, and South Kivu. Response teams continue surveillance, contact tracing, and patient care. [\[Full article\]](#)

Chikungunya

- The **United States (US)**: Florida state health officials reported two additional travel-associated chikungunya cases as of June 27, 2026, one each in Broward and Okaloosa Counties, raising the cumulative total to 38 (Outbreak News Today, 2026). Most cases originated from Cuba (32). No local transmission has been reported in 2026. Authorities continue surveillance and emphasize mosquito control and awareness of symptoms. Crimean-Congo hemorrhagic fever (CCHF)

- **Iraq:** The Ministry of Health reported 219 confirmed CCHF cases, including 16 deaths since the beginning of the year (The Star, 2026). During the last week of June, 23 new cases and three deaths were recorded. Dhi Qar Province remains the most affected, with 101 infections and eight deaths. Authorities are conducting daily monitoring with veterinary and regulatory bodies, urging preventive measures to reduce transmission risks from ticks and livestock exposure. [\[Full article\]](#)

The **Nineveh** Health Department confirmed a new CCHF case in a 21-year-old man from Kokgli on June 30, 2026, following laboratory confirmation in Baghdad (Shafaq, 2026). This brings Nineveh's total to seven confirmed cases. Health authorities continue surveillance, laboratory testing, case management, and response measures as infections increase in the province. - **Turkiye:** Erzincan Province reported 18 patients hospitalized with suspected CCHF as of jate of June 2026, including nine laboratory-confirmed cases, six negative cases, and three under evaluation (Haberler, 2026). No deaths have been reported this season. Health authorities continue surveillance and advise residents to take precautions against tick bites as case numbers are expected to increase in July. Dengue

- **India:** Kerala reported 1,862 dengue cases and six confirmed deaths in June 2026, with nine additional suspected fatalities under review (Madhyamam, 2026). Since January, Kerala has recorded 4,330 confirmed cases and 19 deaths. Authorities continue dengue surveillance and urge intensified vector control, safe water practices, and community awareness. - **Sri Lanka:** The National Dengue Control Unit reported 54,189 dengue cases and 31 deaths as of late June of 2026 (News18, 2026). More than 57% of cases were reported from Western Province, particularly Colombo District. Health authorities continue surveillance and urge strengthened vector control, public awareness, and community participation to prevent further transmission. [\[Full article\]](#)

Leptospirosis

- **India:** Kerala State reported two leptospirosis-related deaths in Kannur District and nine new cases on June 29, 2026 (Asianet News, 2026). Authorities urged preventive measures during the monsoon season. [\[Full article\]](#)
- **Taiwan (Province of China):** A man in his 60s developed severe leptospirosis after cleaning flooded fields barefoot following heavy rainfall (Yahoo News Taiwan, 2026). He was admitted to intensive care with septic shock and multi-organ dysfunction but recovered after targeted antibiotic treatment. Health authorities advise avoiding contact with contaminated floodwater and seeking prompt medical care for compatible symptoms. [\[Full article\]](#)



Malaria

- **France:** Mayotte reported 244 laboratory-confirmed malaria cases since January to June 21, 2026, the highest since 2010 (Beacon Bio, 2026). Of these, 161 were imported (mainly from Comoros). Transmission has expanded to six municipalities, with 71 hospitalizations including four ICU admissions. All cases involved *Plasmodium falciparum*. Santé publique France described the situation as concerning, with intensified vector control and surveillance ongoing. [\[Full article\]](#)
- **India:** East Singhbhum District, Jharkhand, reported 51 new malaria cases detected from 507 blood samples during a special screening drive in Potka Block on June 30, 2026 (Jagran, 2026). Two severe patients were admitted to CHC Potka, while five others were under treatment. The District Health Department deployed 12 teams for door-to-door screening and intensified testing in hotspot villages. [\[Full article\]](#)

Measles

- **Bangladesh:** On June 30, 2026, the Directorate General of Health Services (DGHS) reported two child deaths and 866 new suspected measles infections in the past 24 hours (Rising BD, 2026). Since March 15, a total of 101,077 suspected cases and 11,965 confirmed cases have been recorded nationwide. Hospital data show 84,627 admissions and 80,974 recoveries. Cumulatively, 625 suspected and 93 confirmed measles deaths have been reported, with health authorities continuing surveillance and case management. [\[Full article\]](#)

Chattogram District reported 13 new laboratory-confirmed measles cases on June 29, 2026, bringing the total to 321 (Bangladesh Pratidin, 2026). Of these, 266 cases are in metropolitan areas and 55 in 15 upazilas. Fifty-five suspected patients were admitted in the past 24 hours, and 248 remain hospitalized, mostly in the metropolitan area. A total of 3,467 patients have recovered to date. Health authorities continue surveillance, case management, and public awareness efforts. [\[Full article\]](#)

- **Canada:** Two measles cases were confirmed in Portneuf, Quebec (Le Soleil, 2026). Public Health authorities reported that potential exposures may have occurred at locations in Pont-Rouge and the emergency department of Portneuf Regional Hospital in Saint-Raymond. [\[Full article\]](#)
- The **United States (US):** On June 25, 2026, the Virginia Department of Health expanded the measles outbreak area from Buckingham County to neighboring Cumberland County after confirming local transmission (Farmville Herald, 2026). The Piedmont Health District reported 106 outbreak-associated cases, while 129 cases were recorded statewide. Authorities urge unvaccinated individuals to avoid large gatherings, and stress vaccination as the most effective protection. Surveillance and public advisories continue until two incubation periods pass without new cases. [\[Full article\]](#)



Meningococcal Disease

- **Australia:** South Australian Health confirmed an invasive meningococcal disease case (serogroup B) in a woman in her 40s on June 30, 2026 (National Tribune, 2026). She remains hospitalized in stable condition, while eight close contacts received antibiotics. This brings South Australia's total to nine cases in 2026. Authorities continue surveillance and promote vaccination and early medical care. [\[Full article\]](#)

Mpox

- **France:** La Réunion reported 20 mpox clade Ib cases as of epi-week 25 of 2026, up from 15 in the previous report (Beacon Bio, 2026). The increase was driven by imported cases, with 15 importations (all men returning from Madagascar) and five indigenous cases, including three secondary transmissions. Eight new cases were detected in June. Authorities launched a prevention campaign on June 30, emphasizing vaccination, post-exposure prophylaxis, and targeted travel advisories amid heightened risk during school holiday travel. Rabies

- **Canada:** An 11-year-old boy died from rabies in June 2026, following direct contact with a bat, marking the first locally acquired case in Ontario since 1967 (Science Alert, 2026). The child developed symptoms 19 days after exposure and deteriorated rapidly despite supportive care. Canada has reported only 28 rabies cases since 1924. Health authorities emphasize immediate post-exposure prophylaxis after bat exposure, even without visible wounds, due to rabies' high fatality. [\[Full article\]](#)

West Nile Virus (WNV)

- The **United States (US)** reported 28 WNV cases nationwide, including 19 in Arizona, reflecting ongoing seasonal transmission across affected states (Yahoo News, 2026, 2026). At least one death has been reported, underscoring the potential severity of WNV infection. Authorities continue to strengthen mosquito surveillance and vector control while urging the public to use personal protective measures to reduce the risk of infection. [\[Full article\]](#)

Two human WNV cases were confirmed in the **Houston area**, including one case in Harris County and one in Montgomery County (Fox 26 Houston, 2026). Fort Bend County previously declared a public health emergency due to high mosquito populations. Health officials emphasize mosquito bite prevention, elimination of standing water, and adherence to the "Four Ds" for protection. [\[Full article\]](#)
