



This report is based on media monitoring of infectious and emerging diseases globally and within ASEAN Member States, to enhance pandemic and epidemic preparedness and response in the ASEAN Region. We publish this report three times a week.

Regional Situation

Chikungunya

- The **Philippines**: Samar Town, Gandara, confirmed 84 cases of chikungunya in Barangays Ngoso and Catorse de Agosto, marking 23 incidences per 1,000 population (Gandara, 2026). Most cases occurred among adults aged 30–39 years. Code Red was declared in the two affected barangays. The Municipal Health Office implemented active surveillance, coordination with PESU/RESU, and community-level prevention and control measures. [\[Full article\]](#)

Dengue

- **Cambodia**: Kampong Chhnang Province has reported 752 dengue cases so far in 2026, a 50% increase from the previous year, mostly among children aged 2–14 years (Khmer Times, 2026). Of these, 671 cases were treated in provincial hospitals. The Provincial Health Department launched mosquito control campaigns, including insecticide spraying and community education to reduce breeding sites. [\[Full article\]](#)
- **Indonesia**: Klaten District, Central Java Province reported 110 dengue cases, including one death, from January to June 2026, a decline from 355 cases and three deaths during the same period in 2025 (Media Indonesia, 2026). Health authorities attributed the reduction to mosquito source reduction, routine public health education, and community larval surveillance to prevent resurgence. [\[Full article\]](#)

Trenggalek District, East Java Province, reported 54 dengue fever cases from January to June 2026, a sharp decline from the past two years (Kabar Trenggalek, 2026). Health authorities emphasized prevention efforts, including community larval surveillance, 3M Plus campaigns, community education, and cross-sector collaboration. [\[Full article\]](#)

Bantul District, Special Region of Yogyakarta Province, recorded 35 dengue fever cases with no deaths as of June 2026, a sharp decline compared to 476 cases during the same period in 2025 (Harian Jogja, 2026). The decrease was attributed to climate conditions and improved community participation in mosquito source eradication. Authorities continued urging vigilance through the 3M Plus strategy to sustain prevention and reduce transmission risks. [\[Full article\]](#)



Bagansiapiapi District, Riau Province, reported 134 dengue fever cases as of July 2026, a significant increase compared with the previous year (Metro Riau, 2026). Most patients were children. Health authorities urged residents to implement the 3M strategy, use betta fish in water storage to control mosquito larvae, participate in community clean-up campaigns, and seek early medical care to prevent the disease. - **Viet Nam:** Long Hai Commune, Ho Chi Minh City, reported 64 dengue fever cases as of July 8, 2026, an 88% increase compared to the same period in 2025, including 13 new cases in the first week of July (Sai Gon Giai Phong, 2026). Local officials launched mosquito eradication campaigns and strengthened surveillance to prevent further spread. [\[Full article\]](#)

Hanoi reported a severe dengue hemorrhagic fever case in July 2026 involving a 69-year-old woman with type 2 diabetes treated at the National Hospital for Tropical Diseases (Lao Dong, 2026). The patient progressed to shock, acidosis, clotting disorder, and respiratory failure, requiring intubation, mechanical ventilation, blood filtration, and transfusion. Doctors advised early care for high-risk individuals to prevent life-threatening complications. [\[Full article\]](#)

Gia Lai Province reported a fatal severe dengue case in a 37-year-old man with type 2 diabetes from Bien Ho Commune, who died on July 5, 2026 (Znews, 2026). Since January, Bien Ho recorded 36 dengue cases across 14 villages. Authorities implemented vector control, and insecticide spraying, while urging early medical consultation and community participation in eliminating mosquito breeding sites. [\[Full article\]](#)

Ho Chi Minh City reported 739 dengue cases during epi-week 27 (June 29 – July 5, 2026), a 44.6% increase from the previous four-week average, bringing the cumulative total to 20,514 cases (Vietnam.vn, 2026). High-incidence areas included An Nhon Tay, Tay Nam, and Ngai Giao. Health authorities urged residents to eliminate mosquito breeding sites, control larvae, use bed nets, and participate in community sanitation campaigns. [\[Full article\]](#)

Hand, Foot and Mouth Disease (HFMD)

- The **Philippines:** Iloilo Province reported 500 HFMD cases from January 4 to June 27, 2026, a 40% decrease from 838 cases during the same period in 2025, with no deaths reported (Daily Guardian, 2026). Dumangas (48), Passi City (44), Mina (42), Barotac Nuevo (40), and Barotac Viejo (33) had the highest case counts, while Mina showed a sharp increase compared to 2025. Health authorities continued promoting hand hygiene, surface disinfection, and home isolation of infected children to prevent further transmission. [\[Full article\]](#)
- **Viet Nam:** Ho Chi Minh City reported 910 HFMD cases from June 29 to July 5, 2026, remaining stable compared with the previous four-week average and bringing the cumulative total to 24,151 cases in 2026 (Vietnam.vn, 2026). Health authorities urged strict personal hygiene, frequent handwashing, disinfection of toys and surfaces, and early medical consultation for children with suspected symptoms. HIV/AIDS

- **Indonesia:** West Kotawaringin District, Central Kalimantan Province, reported 676 cumulative HIV cases so far in 2026 (Detik, 2026). Of these, 295 patients (43.6%) were receiving antiretroviral therapy (ARV), while 322 (46.9%) were lost to follow-up. A total of 26 new cases were reported from early June to early July 2026, all initiated on ARV. Health authorities expanded HIV screening, TB-HIV integration, ARV provision, and community education to improve adherence and reduce transmission. [\[Full article\]](#)
- **Viet Nam:** Ha Tinh Province reported that over 30,000 people underwent community-based HIV screening between 2025 and the first half of 2026, detecting 21 positive cases, all linked to treatment (Vietnam.vn, 2026). Supported by the Global Fund, Ha Tinh CDC expanded mobile testing, peer education, and counseling to improve early detection and reduce transmission risk. [\[Full article\]](#)

Dak Lak Province reported 48 new HIV cases and two deaths during the first six months of 2026, bringing cumulative totals to 2,418 infections and 722 deaths (Công Lý, 2026). The provincial health sector continued preventive medicine, medical examinations, and treatment activities, while launching a periodic health check-up and screening program (2026–2030) to strengthen early detection and improve healthcare access. Leptospirosis

- **Indonesia:** Pacitan District, East Java Province, reported 157 leptospirosis cases as of early July 2026, increasing from 147 cases in June, with Tulakan Subdistrict recording the highest number (Times Indonesia, 2026). Health authorities urged high-risk groups to use protective equipment and adopt clean living practices, while promoting rodent control, sanitation, and risk reduction measures. [\[Full article\]](#)
- **The Philippines:** Antique Province recorded 25 leptospirosis cases with three deaths from January 1 to July 4, 2026 (K5 Antique Updates, 2026). Sebaste and Culasi recorded the highest number of cases (4 each), followed by Tibiao and Sibalom (3 each). Health authorities urged residents to avoid floodwaters and seek doxycycline prophylaxis at Rural Health Units after exposure to reduce transmission and fatalities. [\[Full article\]](#)

Malaria

- **Myanmar:** Rakhine State reported at least five malaria-and dengue-related deaths during the 2026 rainy season in Phuong Tha Creek, Mingcheng Township (DMG Burmese, 2026). More than 52,000 residents faced difficulties accessing care due to difficult transportation and shortages of hospitals. [\[Full article\]](#)

Measles

- **Indonesia:** Cimahi City, West Java Province, reported 155 suspected measles cases, including 16 laboratory-confirmed cases (PPID Cimahi Kota, 2026). Of the confirmed cases, 15 patients had not received measles or MR vaccination. Health authorities urged parents to ensure routine immunization for children and emphasized vaccination as the most effective prevention measure. [\[Full article\]](#)



Global Situation

Crimean-Congo Hemorrhagic Fever (CCHF)

- **Iraq:** Nineveh Province reported two confirmed CCHF cases on July 7, 2026, involving two 10-year-old children from Mosul's 17 Tammuz neighborhood and Bashiqa subdistrict, bringing the provincial total to 14 cases (Shafaq News, 2026). Both were hospitalized after suspected infection on July 2. Iraq reported 160 confirmed cases and 10 deaths since so far in 2026. [[Full article](#)]
- **Turkiye:** Tokat Province reported a suspected fatal CCHF case in July 2026 involving a 61-year-old man from Sulusaray District who developed severe illness after removing a tick (Ulusal, 2026). He died despite intensive treatment. Authorities advised against handling ticks directly and urged early medical consultation after suspected exposure. [[Full article](#)]
- **Uganda:** Kanungu District confirmed a CCHF case in July 2026 involving an artisanal gold miner who was isolated at a health facility (Kamwokya Times, 2026). Thirty-six contacts are under daily monitoring, while four suspected cases tested negative but remain under observation. The district task force strengthened surveillance, IPC measures, community sensitization, and response activities to prevent further transmission. [[Full article](#)]

Dengue

- **Bangladesh:** The Directorate General of Health Services (DGHS) reported 190 new dengue cases and two deaths as of July 9, 2026, bringing the national total to 7,747 cases and 24 deaths (Tob News, 2026). Most new infections occurred in Dhaka (71), Barishal (48), Chattogram (34), and Khulna divisions (22). A total of 655 patients remained hospitalized, while 7,068 recovered. Cases and fatalities declined compared with the same period in 2025. [[Full article](#)]
- **France:** Bas-Rhin, Strasbourg, confirmed a dengue fever case in Illkirch-Graffenstaden on July 8, 2026 (BFM TV, 2026). The patient was receiving care at Strasbourg University Hospitals. Authorities scheduled targeted insecticide spraying from July 9–10 to eliminate mosquitoes and prevent local transmission. Residents in the intervention area received precautionary advice, while public events were suspended to facilitate control measures. [[Full article](#)]
- **India:** Kerala State reported 834 confirmed dengue cases in the first eight days of July 2026, including 96 cases on July 8 alone, with children mainly affected (Deshabhimani, 2026). The increase was linked to inadequate cleaning. Authorities implemented mosquito control, environmental sanitation measures, while hospitals reported shortages of essential medicines affecting outbreak management. [[Full article](#)]
- **Italy:** Casella, Liguria, confirmed an imported dengue case in July 2026 involving a resident of Cortino locality (Genova24, 2026). The municipality ordered extraordinary disinfection within a 150-meter radius to target tiger mosquitoes and larvae in public and private areas. Larvicide and adulticide treatments will be conducted by specialized teams. Residents were advised to follow precautionary measures. [[Full article](#)]



- **Pakistan:** Chiniot District, Punjab Province reported a dengue fever case on July 8, 2026, involving a 47-year-old patient from Chiniot admitted to the isolation ward at Faisalabad Allied Hospital-I (24 News HD, 2026). The national dengue tally reached seven cases in 2026, including two each from Faisalabad and Chiniot and one each from Sheikhpura, Lahore, and Rawalpindi. [\[Full article\]](#)
- **Sri Lanka:** The National Dengue Control Unit reported 63,835 dengue cases nationwide and 42 deaths so far in 2026 (Virakesari, 2026). Of these, 8,450 infections occurred in early July alone, indicating a sharp increase. Health authorities announced a special dengue control programme will be carried out in the next few days. Kandy City, Central Province reported 590 dengue cases and four deaths as of early July 2026, with seven high-risk zones identified (Island, 2026). Hospitals reported increased admissions, with 110 patients at Kandy National Hospital and 90 at Peradeniya Teaching Hospital. The Municipal Council intensified inspections of institutions, schools, and residences, warning of legal action against mosquito breeding sites. [\[Full article\]](#)

- The **United States (US):** The CDC's ArboNET system documented over 500 dengue cases nationwide as of mid-June 2026, with locally acquired infections confirmed in Florida, Texas, Hawaii, Arizona, and California (MSN, 2026). Most cases remained travel-related, but repeated clusters highlighted expanding risks associated. Local health departments implemented targeted spraying, outreach, and public advisories on eliminating standing water and using repellents. [\[Full article\]](#)

Leptospirosis

- **India:** Kerala State reported 113 confirmed leptospirosis cases in the first eight days of July 2026, including 15 cases on July 8 alone, among patients treated at government hospitals (Deshabhimani, 2026). Authorities continued prevention efforts amid challenges from essential medicine shortages. [\[Full article\]](#)

Dakshina Kannada District, Karnataka State, reported 53 leptospirosis cases as of June 2026, compared with 86 cases during the same period in 2025 (Vartha Bharathi, 2026). Most cases occurred in Mangaluru (20), Bantwal (14), Belthangady (9), Puttur (7), and Sullia (3). Health officials intensified preventive measures focused on rodent control, sanitation, and early medical consultation. [\[Full article\]](#)

Malaria

- **India:** Rayagada District, Odisha, reported the death of a 10-year-old boy from malaria on July 7, 2026, after several days of fever (OMMCOM News, 2026). The child tested positive during school screening. The case raised concerns over emergency response after the family alleged difficulties accessing transport services. [\[Full article\]](#)

East Singhbhum District, Jharkhand State, reported five deaths and increasing cerebral malaria cases in Potka Block as of July 9, 2026 (News18 Hindi, 2026). A total of 70 new infections were detected among 1,250 tested, while 128 malaria cases were confirmed districtwide in one day, including 98 *Plasmodium falciparum* infections. Health teams conducted village-level screening, treatment, pesticide spraying, and planned a special fogging drive in 11 Potka villages by July 13. [\[Full article\]](#)



- **Republic of Korea:** Gyeonggi Province issued the first malaria alert of 2026 in Paju City on July 9, 2026, following confirmation of a cluster case (Econo News, 2026). Nationwide, 169 malaria cases were reported, including 94 from Gyeonggi Province, accounting for over half of the total. Authorities conducted epidemiological investigations, strengthened mosquito control, and urged residents to use repellents and seek testing for fever symptoms. [[Full article](#)]

Marburg Virus Disease (MVD)

- **Uganda:** Kyegegwa District, Western Uganda reported a fatal Marburg virus infection in a 17-month-old child confirmed by WHO on July 2, 2026, detected through enhanced Ebola surveillance (VietnamPlus, 2026). No symptomatic contacts have been identified to date. WHO is supporting investigations into the source of infection, risk assessment, and community engagement to prevent further transmission. Measles

- **Bangladesh:** The DGHS reported two suspected child deaths among 818 new suspected measles cases on July 9, 2026; 128 were confirmed (Dhaka Tribune, 2026). Since March 15, a total of 108,998 suspected and 13,198 confirmed measles cases have been recorded, with 92,031 hospitalizations and 88,419 recoveries. Cumulative deaths included 654 suspected and 93 confirmed measles fatalities. [[Full article](#)]
- The **United Kingdom (UK):** England reported 883 confirmed measles cases between January 1 and July 6, 2026, including three deaths involving two children and one immunocompromised adult (Alpha Free Press, 2026). More than 60% of cases occurred among children under 10, with London accounting for 463 cases. Health authorities urged increased MMR vaccine uptake to prevent further spread. [[Full article](#)]
- The **United States (US):** The Iowa Department of Health and Human Services confirmed the state's first measles case of 2026 in a vaccinated adult resident of Polk County with recent international travel (KCCI, 2026). The patient visited multiple public locations while infectious, prompting exposure alerts and assessments of potentially affected individuals. The patient was recovering at home. Authorities emphasized vaccination, vigilance, and prompt testing for suspected symptoms. [[Full article](#)]

Chester County, Pennsylvania, confirmed two new measles cases on July 9, 2026, bringing the total to four since late June and five cases in 2026 (Inquirer, 2026). Statewide, Pennsylvania reported 101 cases, over six times last year's count, with Lancaster County recording the largest outbreak in three decades (52 cases). Some patients were hospitalized with serious complications. Authorities continued case tracking, vaccination outreach, and outbreak preparedness measures. [[Full article](#)]

Mpox

- **Hong Kong (SAR):** The Centre for Health Protection confirmed an mpox case on July 9, 2026, involving a 41-year-old man who developed fever and genital rash on July 2 and tested positive (Hong Kong China News Agency, 2026). The patient was hospitalized in stable condition after travel to Taiwan during the incubation period and reported high-risk contact there. Since 2022, Hong Kong has recorded 93 mpox cases, including 74 local and 19 imported cases, all among males. [[Full article](#)]



Typhoid

- **India:** Ahmedabad, Gujarat, reported 60 new typhoid cases during the first five days of July 2026, bringing the total registered since January to 994 (Times of India, 2026). Of 9,029 water samples were tested for chlorine, and 1,370 samples underwent bacteriological testing, with four found unfit. [\[Full article\]](#)

West Nile Virus (WNV)

- **Greece:** Agia Paraskevi, Athens, confirmed the first WNV case of the 2026 season on July 9, 2026, involving a patient over 60 who developed severe meningoencephalitis (SKAI Kriti, 2026). Symptoms began in late June, with local exposure. The National Public Health Organization (EODY) alerted health professionals, promoted personal mosquito protection, and continued surveillance to monitor virus circulation. [\[Full articles\]](#)
- **Italy:** Novara, Piedmont, confirmed two WNV in a woman from Ovest Ticino and a man from Novara, both were hospitalized (Torino Cronaca, 2026). The woman remained stable despite pre-existing conditions, while the man was in a more serious but stable condition. Authorities emphasized mosquito control and personal protection measures to prevent transmission. [\[Full article\]](#)
- The **United States (US):** The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) reported 56 human WNV cases nationwide as of July 7, 2026, marking the earliest surge in 20 years (The Sun, 2026). California confirmed 41 cases since May, mainly in Los Angeles County, with 38 positive mosquito pools detected above the seasonal average. Arizona reported 35 cases, Texas five, and sporadic cases elsewhere. [\[Full article\]](#)

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
