COVID-19: Highlights and Situation Overview

- WHO Director-General stated that ensuring free movement of essential health products is vital for saving lives and curbing the social and economic impacts of the pandemic. WHO is working intensively with partners to increase access to life-saving products, including diagnostics, PPE, medical oxygen, ventilators and more.
- WHO has updated the operational planning guidelines to help countries maintain essential health services during the COVID-19 pandemic. The document includes a set of immediate actions that countries should consider at national, regional, and local level to reorganize and maintain access to high quality essential health services for all. - On March 31, Indonesian President Joko Widodo signed the regulations needed for cities and provinces to enforce what the government described as "large-scale social restrictions" and declared public health emergency status amid the COVID-19 pandemic. Restrictions will be based on the 2018 Law on Health Quarantine, which allows cities and provinces to shut down nonessential services and limit religious and social activities.
- On March 30, Vietnam's Prime Minister Nguyen Xuan Phuc declared COVID-19 a nationwide pandemic and urged authorities at all levels to focus on efforts to contain the pandemic.

• Travel Advisories (new updates)

- Indonesia: The Indonesian government will temporarily ban all foreign visitors from entering the country and oblige all its citizens returning from other countries to undergo a two-week quarantine to stop imported cases of COVID-19. Diplomatic passport holders and foreigners who hold stay and work permits in Indonesia will be exempted from the regulation, but health protocols will be applied. With restrictions on travel and public gatherings already in place, the government will also restrict cross-border mobility to curb the imported cases.
- Thailand: Thailand's Department of Land Transport announced that four southern provinces – Pattani, Yala, Narathiwat and Phuket – will be closed to all public transport, except essential goods vehicles, medical and government vehicles. The director-general Jirut Wisanjit said the closures are effective March 31 to help prevent the virus from spreading between neighbouring provinces. The Governor of Phuket reported that he signed an order to close Phuket International Airport from April 10-30, 2020. Travelers should expect all flights in or out of Phuket to stop beginning at 12:01a.m. April 10.
- Vietnam: Vietnam has closed borders with its south-western neighbors Laos and Cambodia starting today (April 1) in its continued bid to contain the COVID-19 pandemic. Foreign Ministry suspended crossborder activities at main border gates, secondary border gates, trails and entry points at its border areas with Cambodia and Laos. Starting today (April 1), Ho Chi Minh City suspended all public bus services as a preventive measure against the spread of the Covid-19 virus. The suspension, in force until April 15, aims to restrict travel in the city of 13 million people.

- As of April 01 (2PM, GMT+8), worldwide, there were **839,457** confirmed cases, including **41,203** deaths.
- In **China**, there were **82,595** confirmed cases with **3,315** deaths, including deaths in Hong Kong (4) and Taiwan (5). Confirmed cases in China include confirmed cases in Hong Kong (714), Macau (41), and Taiwan (`322).
- **756,862 confirmed cases** of COVID-19 have been reported in **201 countries/states** (other than China, Hong Kong, Taiwan and Macau):

Transmission Category of COVID-19 Affected Countries

BlueDot has classified countries worldwide into categories based on the observed rate of COVID-19 transmission using data generated by our global epidemic surveillance system, as of 1:00 AM PHT (GMT+8) on April 1. To contextualize each country's current situation, Bluedot calculated: (1) each country's rate of change for COVID-19 case reports, (2) case fatality ratios (CFR) for each country, and (3) each country's COVID-19 case burden, per 1,000 population. We also utilized the Infectious Disease Vulnerability Index as a measure of each country's public health capacity to detect, respond, and/or control a COVID-19 outbreak.

Map 1: Map depicting countries by the corresponding COVID-19 transmission category, as defined below.

Map 2: Map depicting the total number of COVID-19 cases reported per 1,000 population at a national level since the beginning of the pandemic. This case count includes active cases, resolved cases, and fatalities.

Table: Summary of country categorizations, IDVI value, and COVID-19 cases per 1,000 population

- Countries reporting <100 cases and a stable-to-slowly increasing rate of COVID-19 transmission
 These countries have reported <100 confirmed cases of COVID-19, a CFR ≤4%, and have a favorable IDVI suggesting adequate capacity to detect, respond, and/or control an epidemic.
 Interpretation: The available surveillance data suggest that these countries may be in an early phase of the epidemic with limited community-based transmission.
- B Countries reporting a steadily increasing or stabilizing rate of COVID-19 transmission
 - These countries have reported \geq 100 confirmed cases of COVID-19 and have a steadily increasing or stabilizing rate of COVID-19 transmission.

• Interpretation: The available surveillance data suggest that these countries may be in a stage of the epidemic with either steadily-increasing community-based transmission, early evidence of epidemic control measures, or incomplete testing/reporting (e.g. testing demand exceeds supply and countries have reached their daily testing capacity).

Countries reporting a rapidly increasing rate of COVID-19 transmission

• These countries have reported \geq 100 confirmed cases of COVID-19 and have an accelerating rate of COVID-19 transmission.

• Interpretation: The available surveillance data suggest that these countries may be experiencing more widespread community-based transmission.

Countries reported a decreasing rate of COVID-19 transmission

• These countries have reported $\geq\!100$ confirmed cases of COVID-19 and have a decelerating rate of COVID-19 transmission.

• Interpretation: The available surveillance data in these countries suggest that epidemics in these countries are slowing down secondary to robust and effective control measures and potentially increased herd immunity.

Countries reporting <100 cases AND a high case fatality ratio OR limited public health capacity to detect and/or respond to COVID-19 based on IDVI

• These countries have reported <100 confirmed cases of COVID-19, AND: are reporting a CFR >4% OR have an IDVI value (<0.6).

• Interpretation: The available surveillance data suggest that these countries are experiencing a larger outbreak than reported case counts indicate, and/or may indicate concerns for detecting and controlling spread of COVID-19.

F Countries where insufficient information is available on COVID-19 transmission

• These countries have not reported imported or local cases of COVID-19 as of April 1, 1:00 AM PHT (GMT+8)




Figure 1. Map depicting countries by the corresponding COVID-19 transmission category




Figure 2. Map depicting the total number of COVID-19 cases reported per 1,000 population at a national level since the beginning of the pandemic. This include active cases, resolved cases, and fatalities
