## **COVID-19: Highlights and Situation Overview**

- World Health Organization's (WHO) Director-General in his media briefing on June 3, stated that more than 100 000 cases of COVID-19 have been reported to WHO for each of the past 5 days. The Americas continues to account for the most cases. For several weeks, the number of cases reported each day in the Americas has been more than the rest of the world put together. We are especially worried about Central and South America, where many countries are witnessing accelerating epidemics. WHO also saw an increasing numbers of cases in the Eastern Mediterranean, South-East Asia and Africa, although the numbers are much smaller. Meanwhile, the number of cases in Europe continues to decline.
- Brunei's Ministry of Health announced on June 4 some additional social distancing measures for COVID-19 to be implemented effective today (June 5). The new measure will now apply to tuition schools and music schools, whereby only one-on-one classes are allowed at this time. Managers of the aforementioned premises are required to obtain a specific BruHealth QR Code for their premises and shall be shown at the entrance area of the premise for customers to scan prior to entry and upon leaving the premise; conduct body temperature checks on all customers at the entrance and ensure the customers obey the guidelines on social distancing; and advice anyone who have signs of infection and those of high risk to not come to the premises.
- Indonesia's President has increased the COVID-19 testing target to 20,000 samples per day as new cases mount in several regions in the country. According to a report published by the national COVID-19 task force on June 3, the total number of tests has reached 11,970 per day. The President also urged the national COVID-19 task force, the Indonesian Military (TNI) and the National Police to focus on mitigating the spread of the virus in the country's three hardest-hit regions: East Java, South Sulawesi and South Kalimantan. On another note, the governor of Indonesia's capital, Jakarta, said on Thursday (June 4) that movement restrictions to stem the spread of the coronavirus would be extended in Jakarta, but June would be a transition period with some rules conditionally eased. Starting today (June 5), public transport networks would resume normal operations and the houses of worship will reopen, both with new social restrictions in place. Meanwhile, Surabaya in East Java has been designated a "black zone" as the region as cases are increasing, making it the epicenter of the COVID-19 outbreak in the province.
- According to Malaysia's Health Minister, 277 new COVID-19 cases, the highest daily number to date. Health Ministry's Director-General said at a press briefing on June 4 that 270 of the new cases are foreign nationals detained at an immigration detention center on the outskirts of Kuala Lumpur.
- Myanmar's Ministry of Health announced on June 4 the first confirmed case of COVID-19 in a Muslim Rohingya within its borders, highlighting concerns over the potential for an outbreak within the ethnic community packed into squalid refugee camps in Rakhine state.
- In conjunction with Singapore's move towards Phase One ("Safe Re-opening")
  of the post-Circuit Breaker period, Singapore has explored the piloting of fast
  lane arrangements with a few other countries and regions. This is part of
  Singapore's gradual reopening of borders for Singaporeans and residents to
  conduct essential activities overseas and to allow safe travel for foreigners

- entering Singapore in limited numbers, with the necessary safeguards in place to ensure public health considerations are addressed.
- China has donated another batch of medical supplies to aid Cambodia's fight against the COVID-19. Chinese Ambassador to Cambodia has handed over the supplies to Cambodia's Health Minister at a ceremony held in Phnom Penh on Wednesday (June 3) afternoon.
- On June 4, according to the Korea Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, 39 more people tested positive for COVID-19 over the past 24 hours. It said most of the cases were in the capital Seoul, where there has recently been a steady increase in infections linked to church gatherings. Because the majority of cases were identified in the capital Seoul, the city has shut down many of its public spaces until June 14. The shutdown affects state-run museums, including the National Museum of Korea, the National Palace Museum of Korea, and the locations of the National Museum of Modern and Contemporary Art (MMCA) in Seoul, Gwacheon and Deoksugung

### **Travel Advisories** (new update/s)

- Indonesia: Starting today (June 5), public transport networks will resume normal operations with new social restrictions in place.
- Singapore: Singapore and China have agreed to create a *fast lane* to facilitate essential business and official travel between both countries. The fast lane will be established between six Chinese provinces and municipalities (Chongqing, Guangdong, Jiangsu, Shanghai, Tianjin and Zhejiang) and Singapore. The scheme is open to residents in Singapore and China who need to make essential business or official trips between the two countries. The arrangement will be gradually expanded to other Chinese provinces and municipalities. On another note, Singapore Airlines (SIA) is resuming flights to several destinations in June and July, and increasing the number of flights for some of its other services. The airline will be flying to 27 cities in June and July, up from the 15 that had been earlier announced for June. The reinstated scheduled services include flights to Amsterdam, Barcelona, Christchurch, Hong Kong, Melbourne and Osaka. These flights are subject to regulatory approvals and changes.
- Vietnam: Vietnam continues to implement strict control of the entry of foreign workers. More than 1,800 foreign experts and managers have been quarantined on arrival while a further 2,700 are expected in the next two months as per the Ministry of Health.

### Cases and Deaths as of 05 June 2020

- As of June 5 (2PM, GMT+8), worldwide, there were **6,604,217** confirmed cases, including **391,082** deaths. Globally, Case Fatality Ratio (CFR)\* is **5.92**.
- In **China**, there were **84,609** confirmed cases with **4,645** deaths, including deaths in Hong Kong (4) and Taiwan (7). Confirmed cases in China include confirmed cases in Hong Kong (1,099), Macau (45), and Taiwan (443).
- 6,519,608 confirmed cases of COVID-19 have been reported in 212 countries/states (other than China, Hong Kong, Taiwan and Macau):
