## COVID-19: Highlights and Situation Overview

- Worldwide, there have been over 67.3 million cases and more than 1.54 million deaths attributed to COVID-19.
- Indonesia's National COVID-19 Task Force said that the Health Ministry will add more hospital rooms to treat patients should Indonesia face a case surge of 100%. According to the task-force spokesperson, if the cases increase by 20 to 50% then hospitals would continue operating like at the moment. He added that hospitals are capable of accommodating patients if cases do not increase beyond 50%. However, should cases increase by 100%, the ministry would turn general care units into makeshift rooms for COVID-19 patients. Data from the Health Ministry as of Tuesday (December 1) showed that the bed occupancy rate in isolation wards and intensive care units for COVID-19 patients had reached 57.97%. West Java recorded the most occupied beds at 77%. Bandung alone, for example, currently risks facing a shortage of beds with 88.6% of beds already occupied. Indonesia's daily number of coronavirus infections have accelerated in recent weeks, with total confirmed cases reaching 575,796 on Sunday with 17,740 deaths.
- Vietnam's Prime Minister Nguyen Xuan Phuc signed a new Directive strengthening measures to contain the pandemic after the recent cases of local transmission. These include the wearing of face masks and using hand sanitizers, avoiding necessary gatherings, and strict quarantining for those returning from overseas. As of December 6, Vietnam's Ministry of Health confirmed a total of 1,366 cases of COVID-19. However, 1,220 of the affected patients have recovered and been discharged from hospitals. Vietnam has also recorded 35 deaths due to the pandemic. The latest cases were all imported and quarantined on arrival.
- South Korea raised its coronavirus alert to the second-highest level in Seoul and surrounding areas on Sunday (December 6) as authorities struggle to contain a fresh outbreak. The country largely brought the virus under control with a "trace, test and treat" approach, but in recent weeks new infections have jumped from around 100 a day to more than 500. South Korea has confirmed 631 new COVID-19 cases on December 6 (the highest in nine months) with majority of cases found in the greater Seoul region according to the Korea Disease Control and Prevention Agency. South Korean President called on Monday (December 7) for expanded COVID-19 testing and more thorough tracing as the country struggled to control its latest and largest wave of infections. The President ordered the government to mobilize every available resource to track infections, and to expand testing by deploying the military and more people from the public service.

### Vaccine Update

- Indonesia received its first shipment of coronavirus vaccine from China on Sunday (December 6) as the government prepares a mass inoculation programme. The President said in an online briefing that the country received 1.2 million doses from China's Sinovac Biotech (a vaccine Indonesia has been testing since August). He added that the government plans to receive another 1.8 million doses in early January 2021. Late-stage trials of the Sinovac vaccine are also under way in Brazil and Turkey, with interim results on efficiency from Brazil expected by mid-December. Indonesia is also expected this month to receive

shipments of raw materials to produce 15 million doses and materials for 30 million doses next month. The President also said that the vaccine still needs to be evaluated by the country's food and drug agency (BPOM) while his administration continues to prepare for distributing the vaccine across the vast archipelago of 270 million people.

- According to Philippines' Department of Health today (December 7), three developers of vaccines against COVID-19 have passed the review of the ethics board, advancing their applications to conduct clinical trials in the country. Belgium's Janssen Pharmaceutical, United Kingdom's AstraZeneca, and China's Clover Biopharmaceuticals have all secured clearance from the Ethical Review Board. The Department of Science and Technology has said Janssen and AstraZeneca may soon get their initial clearance from the vaccine experts' panel (VEP). Meanwhile, China's Sinovac and Clover already cleared the VEP. Vaccine makers need to pass both the VEP and the Ethics Review Board before they could seek the approval from the Food and Drug Administration (FDA) of the Philippines to conduct clinical trials in the country.
- According to Vietnam's Ministry of Health, Vietnam will conduct the first phase of human trials of a locally made COVID-19 vaccine from December 10. To date, Vietnamese producers have worked to accelerate the research of COVID-19 vaccines, with Ivac, Vabiotech and Nanogen completing production process at laboratory scale and currently evaluating the vaccines' safety and immunity in animals. Meanwhile, Nanogen is now ready to pilot the first phase of human trial. Nanogen will join hands with the Military Medical University to recruit volunteers for the first phase of clinical trial on December 10. At the meeting, experts and vaccine producers discussed progress of vaccine production and challenges during vaccine development, as well as outline solutions for the time ahead.
- According to government health adviser in India on Sunday (December 6), Pfizer has applied for emergency use authorization of its coronavirus vaccine in India, the first to do so in a country with the world's second-highest number of infections. The US company, whose vaccine was recently approved in Britain, approached Indian authorities on Saturday. India is hoping five locally-tested vaccines, including one being developed by AstraZeneca and Oxford University, will help the country in its response to COVID-19.

#### **Travel Advisories** (new update/s)

- Malaysia: The country will allow movement across states and districts nationwide starting today (December 7) without the need for a police permit, except in areas under a lockdown known as Enhanced Movement Control Order (EMCO). According to an official, the Conditional Movement Control Order (CMCO) will end as scheduled on December 6 for most states, however, it will be extended until December 20 for Kuala Lumpur, Sabah, most of Selangor, as well as some parts of Johor, Negeri Sembilan, Kelantan and Perak. Under the CMCO, all schools, institutions of higher learning, skills training institutes, pre-schools and tahfiz centers must be closed. All social and cultural activities including at entertainment centers and nightclubs are also not allowed.

### Cases and Deaths as of 07 December 2020

- As of December 07 (2PM, GMT+8), worldwide, there were **67,402,482** confirmed cases, including **1,542,585** deaths. Globally, Case Fatality Rate (CFR) is **2.29**.
- In **China**, there were **94,279** confirmed cases with **4,753** deaths, including deaths in Hong Kong (112) and Taiwan (7). Confirmed cases in China include confirmed cases in Hong Kong (6,898), Macau (46), and Taiwan (716).
- 1,251,727 confirmed cases** of COVID-19 have been reported in the ASEAN region with a total of **28,913 deaths**.
