## COVID-19: Highlights and Situation Overview

- Worldwide, there have been over 27.6 million cases and more than 899,000 deaths attributed to COVID-19. The World Health Organization is working with China on requirements for international approval of any Chinese COVID-19 vaccine. Chinese firm Sinovac Biotech Ltd said on Monday its coronavirus vaccine (CoronaVac) candidate appeared to be safe for older people, according to preliminary results from an early to mid-stage trial, while the immune responses triggered by the vaccine were slightly weaker than younger adults. CoronaVac being tested in Brazil and Indonesia in the final-stage human trials to evaluate whether it is effective and safe enough to obtain regulatory approvals for mass use, has already been given to tens of thousands of people, including about 90% of Sinovac employees and their families, as part of China's emergency inoculation scheme to protect people facing high infection risk.
- Vietnam Prime Minister Nguyễn Xuân Phúc speaks at the opening ceremony of the 53rd ASEAN Foreign Ministers Meeting held in Hà Nội on Wednesday (September 9). He called for solidarity among ASEAN members to deal with challenges posed by the COVID-19 pandemic and a complicated geopolitical and economic environment. "2020 will end in just four months while the COVID-19 pandemic continues to unfold in a complex manner, and our people and businesses continue to be outstretched by its repercussions," he said. And to ensure the continuity of the achieved results, PM Phúc suggested ASEAN foreign ministers promote a number of priorities including continuing upholding ASEAN's solidarity and unity in order to successfully realise the blueprints for the ASEAN Community Vision 2025. He proposed the COVID-19 Response Fund should be well utilized and the Regional Reserve of Medical Supplies should be operationalized so as to raise ASEAN's response capacity.
- Indonesia surpassed 200,000 confirmed COVID-19 cases on Tuesday (September 8), after consistently detecting record numbers of new infections in the past several weeks. According to government data released on Tuesday afternoon, the country's overall tally is 200,035 after recording 3,046 new cases. Jakarta detected the highest number of COVID-19 with 48,393 cases and 1,317 deaths, followed by East Java with 36,342 cases and 2,608 deaths. Both the central and local governments have insisted on reopening the economy after enforcing large-scale social restrictions (PSBB) in several high-risk areas. Data shows that when these restrictions were relaxed, infections started to increase. President Joko "Jokowi" Widodo has reminded his aides to prioritize health and COVID-19 mitigation over restarting economic activities, saying that health was the key to economic recovery.
- A health official predicts the coronavirus will reach the Thai-Myanmar border in the next 2 weeks. Border security has already tightened up after Myanmar reported a surge of COVID-19 cases. While the Thai government is making sure the virus isn't coming in from other countries, the Ministry of Public Health is also investigating potential local transmissions. The coronavirus situation in the neighboring country is a great concern for Thailand, according to the director of the Division of Communicable Diseases of Thailand. The outbreak mostly spread in the Rakhine state, on Myanmar's western coast. The major virus hotspots in Myanmar are still far from Thailand, but the director said that the virus will most probably spread to border towns within the next 2 weeks. Border

officials have also tightened patrol at areas along the Thai-Cambodia border which is also “at risk” of spreading the virus.

- Malaysia on Tuesday (September 8) announced 100 new COVID-19 cases, the highest in the three months since the government relaxed movement curbs on June 10. The 100 cases were by far the biggest single-day increase throughout the recovery MCO, overtaking Monday's 62 new cases, in a day. 62 of the new cases came from the Benteng Lahad Datu (LD) cluster in Sabah that originated from detention centres.
- Myanmar's Ministry of Health and Sports reported 191 new COVID-19 cases, the highest single-day number of cases, on September 8. Among the cases, Yangon region reported the highest number of cases at 141.
- The Philippines' Department of Health on Wednesday (September 9) forewarned the public to expect spikes in the daily reported cases of COVID-19 as more testing laboratories submit complete data. Health spokesperson said late submissions from laboratories will come in within the week as more testing facilities adjust and comply with DOH's requirement to submit the patient's complete address and personal numbers for easier contact tracing.

#### **Travel Advisories** (new update/s)

- Malaysia: Indonesians, as well as citizens of several other countries, are being denied entry to Malaysia as of Monday (September 7), the Foreign Ministry has confirmed. According to the Malaysian Embassy in Jakarta, the travel ban was temporary. The Malaysian ambassador said this policy was temporary and would be reviewed every week. In addition to Indonesians, Malaysia is banning the entry of citizens of the Philippines, India, the United States, the United Kingdom, Brazil, Russia, Spain, Bangladesh, France, Saudi Arabia and Italy, all of which are among the top 25 countries with the most confirmed COVID-19 cases.

#### **Cases and Deaths as of 09 September 2020**

- As of September 09 (2PM, GMT+8), worldwide, there were **27,721,449** confirmed cases, including **902,041** deaths. Globally, Case Fatality Rate (CFR) is **3.25**.
- In **China**, there were **90,627** confirmed cases with **4,740** deaths, including deaths in Hong Kong (99) and Taiwan (7). Confirmed cases in China include confirmed cases in Hong Kong (4,896), Macau (92), and Taiwan (495).
- **515,322 confirmed cases** of COVID-19 have been reported in the ASEAN region with a total of **12,405 deaths**.




