## COVID-19: Highlights and Situation Overview

- Worldwide, there have been over 118.33 million cases and more than 2.62 million deaths attributed to COVID-19.
- Ho Chi Minh City (Vietnam) authorities allowed the reopening of additional non-essential businesses such as gyms, fitness centers, and pubs from March 9, however, bars, nightclubs, and karaoke parlors will remain closed until further notice. In the latest outbreak of community transmission that broke out January 28, Vietnam has registered 894 cases, including one confirmed case last Tuesday evening in epicenter Hai Duong. The latest outbreak has been basically been under controlled as 10 out of 13 affected localities, including Ho Chi Minh City and Hanoi, have not recorded any new infections in 24 days. As of March 9, 2021, Vietnam's Ministry of Health confirmed a total of 2,526 cases of COVID-19 and recorded 35 deaths due to the pandemic.
- Brunei had previously announced further reduction of social distancing measures and implementation of New Normal for major social activities including mass gathering which has initiated on Monday (March 8). The changes include the implementation of New Normal for activities in places such as mosques, schools, museums, sports facilities, restaurants, cinemas, stalls and markets. Mass gathering limitation will also be expanded from 350 people to 1,000 people. Brunei's Ministry of Health said that the COVID-19 pandemic in Brunei is currently under control as the last case of local infection was reported over 300 days ago. According to the health ministry, the changes are for activities carried out within the country only by maintaining the current cross-border travel restrictions to strictly control the possibility of re-occurrence of COVID-19 infection in the country.

### Vaccine Update

- Indonesia's Food and Drug agency (BPOM) said on Tuesday (March 9) that the country has approved AstraZeneca's COVID-19 vaccine for emergency use. According to the Foreign Minister, Indonesia will get about 11.7 million doses of AstraZeneca's vaccine through COVAX, which will come in batches till May
- Malaysia will buy additional doses of Pfizer-BioNTech's COVID-19 vaccine, bringing the total secured to 32 million, enough to cover half of its population. In addition to the deal with Pfizer-BioNTech, Malaysia has also reached a supply agreement with Britain's AstraZeneca, Russia's Gamaleya Research Institute, as well as China's Sinovac Biotech and CanSino.
- According to the national Expanded Program on Immunization (EPI), Vietnam will receive 4.177 million doses of the AstraZeneca COVID-19 vaccine via the COVAX program with support from the UNICEF. Covax has pledged to provide Vietnam with 4.9 million doses of the AstraZeneca vaccine in the first half and around 33 million doses in the second half of this year. Under this, 1.37 million doses are scheduled to arrive on March 25 and the rest in April.
- According to the National Task Force against COVID-19 deputy chief implementer on Wednesday (March 10), the Philippine government is aiming to vaccinate 250,000 to 300,000 individuals per day when the bulk of vaccines arrive in the country to achieve the goal of inoculating 50 million individuals in 2021. On March 8, the government has so far administered 44,000 vaccine doses since last week.

### Travel Advisories (new update/s)

- China: China has launched a health certificate programme for domestic travellers, leading the world in plans for so-called virus passports. The digital certificate, which shows a user's vaccination status and virus test results, is available for Chinese citizens via a programme on

Chinese social media platform WeChat that was launched on Monday (March 8). However, the international health certificate is currently only available for use by Chinese citizens and it is not yet mandatory.

- Malaysia: According to the Senior Minister on Tuesday (March 9), travel for tourism will be allowed under the targeted bubble travel between states under the recovery movement control order (RCMO) and will take effect from Wednesday (March 10) but is subject to strict conditions. The minister added that those who want to travel for domestic tourism can only do so by using tour agency vehicles where the operator will have to seek police permission to make the journey. In addition, travel for tourism purposes for those in conditional MCO areas are still not allowed and those in the recovery MCO states also cannot go on holiday in conditional MCO states.
- Singapore: Passengers on Singapore Airlines (SIA) will now use a mobile app to verify their COVID-19 test results and vaccination status, as the national carrier becomes the first airline to test the International Air Transport Associations (IATA) Travel Pass. The trial will begin with passengers travelling from Singapore to London between March 15 and March 28. Travellers can download the Travel Pass app and create a digital identification with their photo and passport information. They also can submit flight information and book a COVID-19 test at one of seven participating clinics in Singapore, after which their test results can be viewed directly in the app. Check-in staff at Changi Airport can then verify the traveller's status via the app and speed up the check-in process.
- Thailand: Thailand will from next month reduce its mandatory quarantine from 14 to seven days for foreigners arriving in the country who have been vaccinated against COVID-19. Vaccinations must be administered within three months of the travel period and visitors will still be required to show negative COVID-19 test results within three days of their departure. Meanwhile, those that are not yet inoculated but with coronavirus-free certificates will be quarantined for 10 days. The new measures do not apply to those travelling from Africa, who would still be subject to quarantine for two weeks due to concerns about other variants of the virus.

### Cases and Deaths as of 10 March 2021

- As of 10 March 2021 (2PM, GMT+8), worldwide, there were **118,330,512** confirmed cases, including **2,622,536** deaths. Globally, Case Fatality Rate (CFR) is **2.2**.
- In **China**, there were **102,148** confirmed cases with **4,848** deaths, including deaths in Hong Kong (202) and Taiwan (10). Confirmed cases in China include confirmed cases in Hong Kong (11,121), Macau (48), and Taiwan (977).
- **2,542,077 confirmed cases** of COVID-19 have been reported in the ASEAN region with a total of **54,823 deaths**, with a CFR of **2.2**.

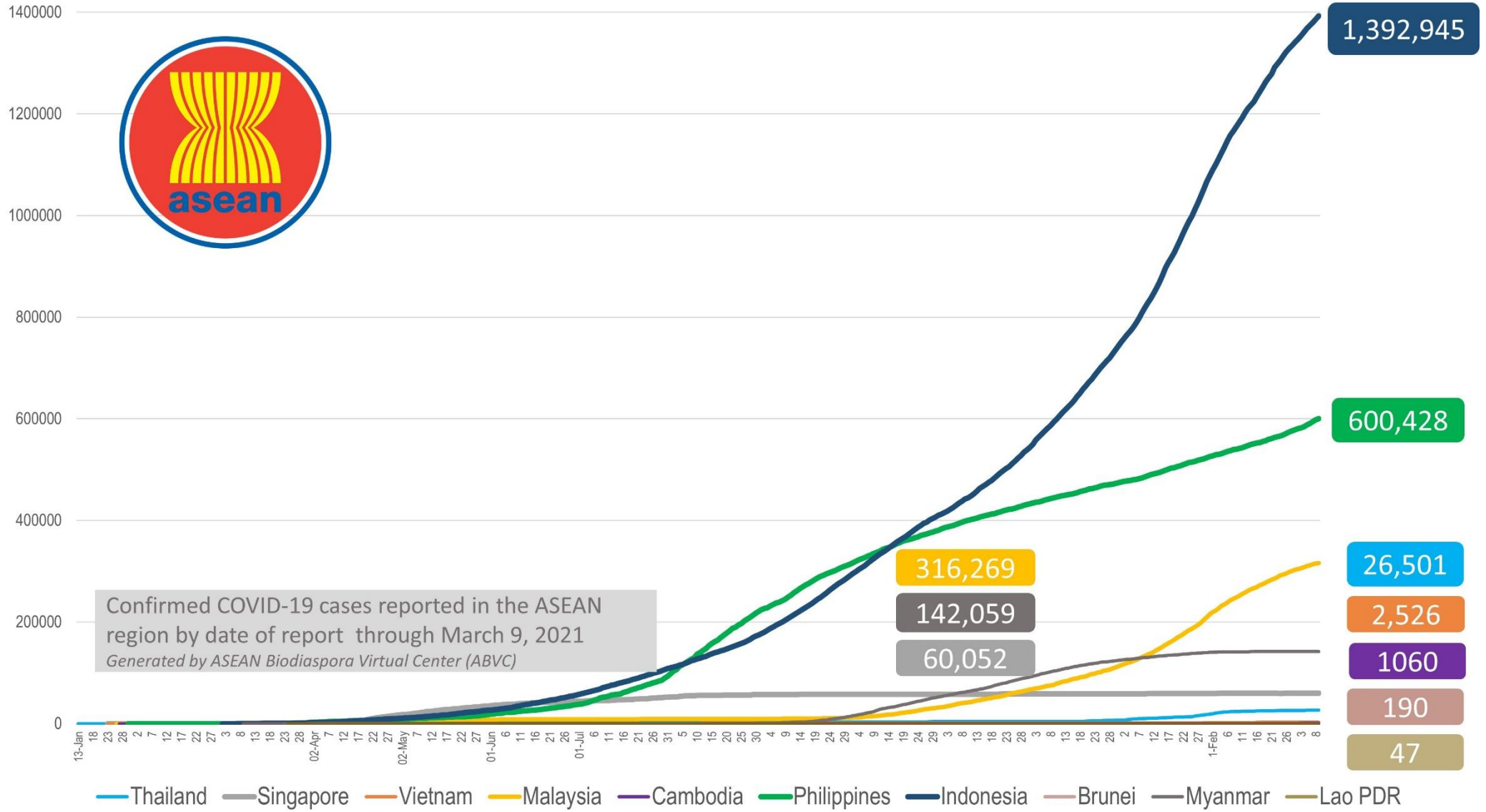
