## COVID-19: Highlights and Situation Overview

- Worldwide, there have been over 28.2 million cases and more than 911,000 deaths attributed to COVID-19.
- The U.S. State Department said during an online ministerial meeting with the members of the Association of Southeast Asian Nations on September 10 that U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention will open a regional office in Hanoi to increase its public health engagement in Southeast Asia. During Thursday's virtual U.S.-ASEAN foreign ministers meeting, the ministers highlighted the breadth and depth of U.S. engagement and commitment to the ASEAN region.
- Indonesia has recorded another record daily case number as the national task force confirmed 3,861 new COVID-19 infections on Thursday, bringing the national total to 207,203. Indonesian government is currently preparing personnel from various institutions to jointly carry out an operation to ensure the implementation of the mask-wearing protocol in subdistricts and villages across Indonesia amid the current spike of confirmed COVID-19 cases. The operation will involve personnel from the Indonesian Military, the National Police, public order agencies (Satpol PP), as well as prosecutors and judges. COVID-19 Response and National Economic Recovery Committee chairman said that Indonesia's President has directed that the country's 83,000 subdistricts and villages be at the forefront of COVID-19 management. The government has said that civil servants will be allowed to work from home in compliance with Jakarta's decision to reimpose full large-scale social restrictions (PSBB) starting Monday (September 14). However, the officials said that there should be work shifts that require 10-25% of civil servants to take turns performing their duties at their respective offices in some ministries, agencies and local administrations. All non-essential sectors in Jakarta must work from home, dine-in will not be allowed in restaurants, tourist destinations will be closed and large gatherings are banned.
- Myanmar increased lockdown measures in its biggest city on Thursday (September 10) after reporting another record daily rise in COVID-19 cases. Health authorities expanded a stay-at-home order to nearly half of the townships in greater Yangon where most of the new cases were found. That prompted authorities to close schools nationwide and reimpose some restrictions that had earlier been eased. Authorities said offices, factories and government institutions would remain open in Yangon and workers would be exempt from the order to stay home.
- As of September 10, Vietnam's Ministry of Health's tally of COVID-19 confirmed cases is 1,059. Da Nang city beaches will reopen while restaurants and eateries will reopen for dine-in services starting today (September 11) after no new local transmission was reported for the past 13 days in the city. However non-essential services such as bars, karaoke, clubs, and gyms will remain closed.

### Travel Advisories (new update/s)

- Myanmar: The government has ordered people not to travel other than in an emergency. Domestic airlines also announced that their services were suspended until the end of September.
- Singapore: According to Foreign Ministers of both countries today (September 11), Singapore and Japan will launch a "reciprocal green lane" to facilitate

essential business and official travel between the two countries on September 18. The business track will allow the safe resumption of cross-border travel and business exchanges with the necessary public health safeguards in place. Safeguards include pre-departure and post-arrival testing as well as the need to adhere to a controlled itinerary for the first 14 days in the receiving country. Singapore also welcomes discussions with Hong Kong on the gradual resumption of cross-border travel between both sides. The statement comes after Hong Kong's Secretary for Commerce and Economic Development Edward Yau Tang-wah said earlier this week that the territory is planning "travel bubbles" with 11 countries, including Singapore, South Korea, Australia, New Zealand, Malaysia, France and Germany.

### Cases and Deaths as of 11 September 2020

- As of September 11 (2PM, GMT+8), worldwide, there were **28,292,477** confirmed cases, including **912,255** deaths. Globally, Case Fatality Rate (CFR) is **3.22**.
- In **China**, there were **90,655** confirmed cases with **4,740** deaths, including deaths in Hong Kong (99) and Taiwan (7). Confirmed cases in China include confirmed cases in Hong Kong (4,914), Macau (92), and Taiwan (496).
- **530,111 confirmed cases** of COVID-19 have been reported in the ASEAN region with a total of **12,787 deaths**.

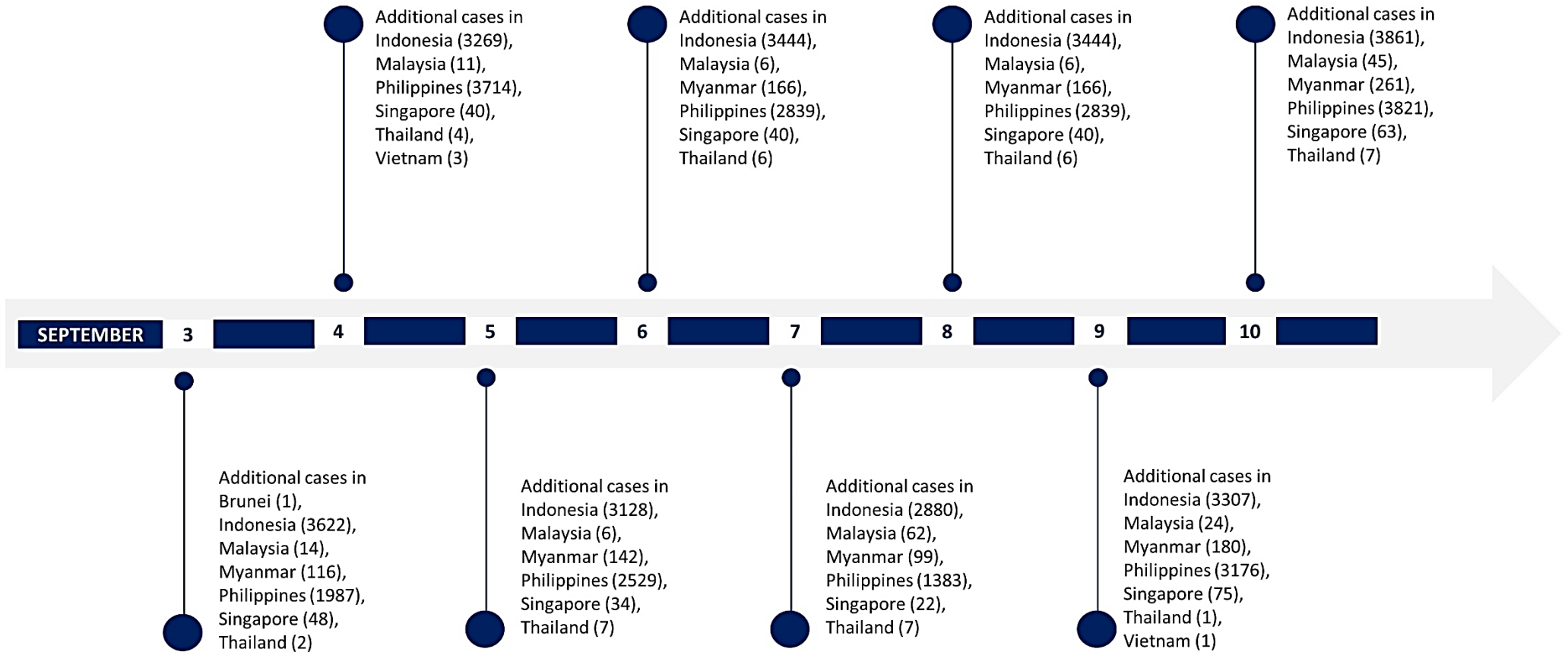

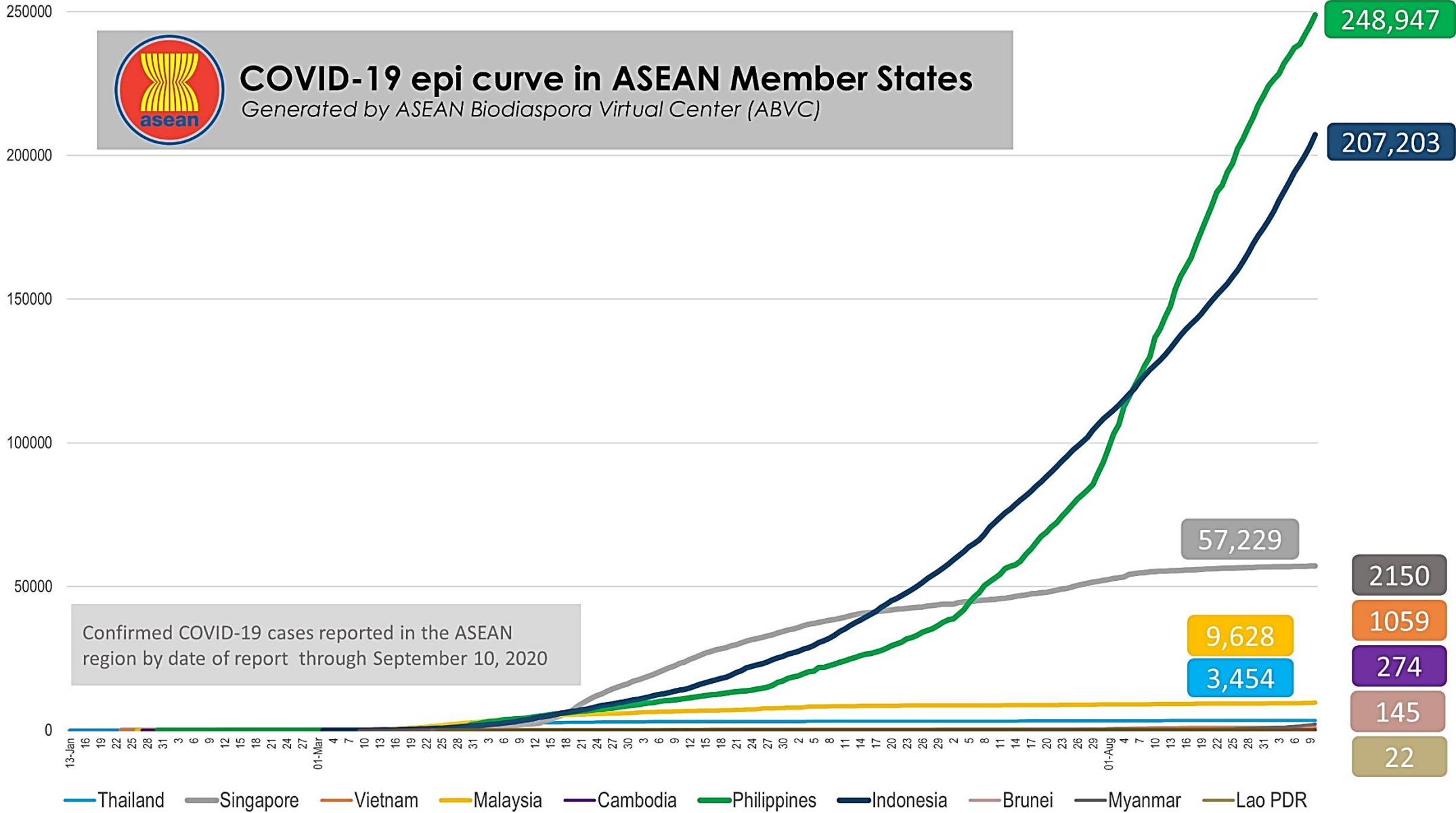
