

COVID-19: Highlights and Situation Overview

- Worldwide, there have been over 119.2 million cases and more than 2.6 million deaths attributed to COVID-19.
- The much-anticipated report from the international mission of the World Health Organization's expert team to Wuhan to investigate COVID-19's origins is set to be published this week. The WHO mission was aimed at finding clues as to how the virus originally jumped from animals into humans. Now, a month after leaving Wuhan, the team and its Chinese counterparts are set to issue their findings - which should help to identify the most likely pathways, while relegating other less probable hypotheses.
- The Philippines on Saturday (March 13) reported its first case of the highly contagious coronavirus variant first identified in Brazil. A Filipino returning from Brazil tested positive for the P1 Brazil variant after 752 samples were sequenced at the genome center. The country also reported 59 new infections of the B117 variant first detected in Britain, and 32 cases of the B1351 variant discovered in South Africa. This brings cases for those variants to 177 and 90, respectively.
- Cambodia officials on Monday (March 15) have reiterated calls for the public to remain vigilant as the number of COVID-19 cases linked to the February 20 community transmission continues to rise. On Sunday (March 14) alone, the Ministry of Health reported another 41 cases of COVID-19 linked to the community outbreak, bringing the total to 792 in just over three weeks. As of March 14, Cambodia had recorded a total of 1,305 COVID-19 cases.
- Thailand's Ministry of Health on Sunday (March 14) reported a new cluster of COVID-19 that is linked to a market on the outskirts of Bangkok. At least 90 people have tested positive from the Bang Khae Market cluster, prompting the Bangkok Metropolitan Administration (BMA) to order the market to close from Saturday. The Centre for COVID-19 Situation Administration (CCSA) said that in the 170 new cases, 156 were local transmissions and 14 were imported cases, including three from Malaysia. Of the 156 local transmissions, 136 were through active case detection – Bangkok (90), Samut Sakhon (31), Pathum Thani (10), Phetchaburi (three) and Narathiwat (two) - while 20 were from those seeking treatment at hospitals.

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- The head of the China's Center for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) said on Saturday (Mar 13) that the country is aiming to vaccinate 70% to 80% of its population by the end of this year or mid-2022. With four approved vaccines, China will vaccinate 900 million to 1 billion people. China has already administered 52.5 million vaccine doses through the end of February.
- According to the Philippines' head of the government's vaccine strategy on Sunday (March 14), the Philippines is on track with its COVID-19 inoculation drive and that it would be able to achieve its target of inoculating about 70% of the country's population within this year. The country's vaccination drive started on March 1 with 600,000 Sinovac shots donated by China. The Philippines also received an initial 525,600 doses of AstraZeneca's vaccine through the COVAX facility.
- Thailand's Public Health Minister said that Thailand is in talks about purchasing an additional 5 million doses of China's Sinovac COVID-19 vaccine. The announcement comes as the government postpones administration of the AstraZeneca vaccine over blood clotting concerns. However, without further explanation, the minister stated that inoculation using the AstraZeneca jab will begin next week. The World Health Organisation has insisted that the vaccine is safe, pointing out that there is no confirmed causal link between the vaccine and some reports of blood clots. Meanwhile, 800,000 doses of the Sinovac vaccine are expected to arrive in the country on March 20. The minister, however, said that the AstraZeneca vaccine remains the primary jab for mass inoculation.

- Singapore: Singapore and Australia are in talks on a possible travel bubble that will allow residents to travel between both countries without having to quarantine. According to Singapore's Ministry of Foreign Affairs (MFA), the two countries are also in discussions on the mutual recognition of vaccination certificates and resuming travel with priority for students and business travellers. Meanwhile, according to Singapore's Prime Minister, he hoped Singapore would start reopening its borders by the end of the year as more countries ramp up vaccination drives against COVID-19 infections.

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- As of 15 March 2021 (2PM, GMT+8), worldwide, there were **120,110,414** confirmed cases, including **2,655,918** deaths. Globally, Case Fatality Rate (CFR) is **2.2**.
- In **China**, there were **102,332** confirmed cases with **4,849** deaths, including deaths in Hong Kong (203) and Taiwan (10). Confirmed cases in China include confirmed cases in Hong Kong (11,282), Macau (48), and Taiwan (985).
- **2,598,001 confirmed cases** of COVID-19 have been reported in the ASEAN region with a total of **55,822 deaths**, with a CFR of **2.1**.

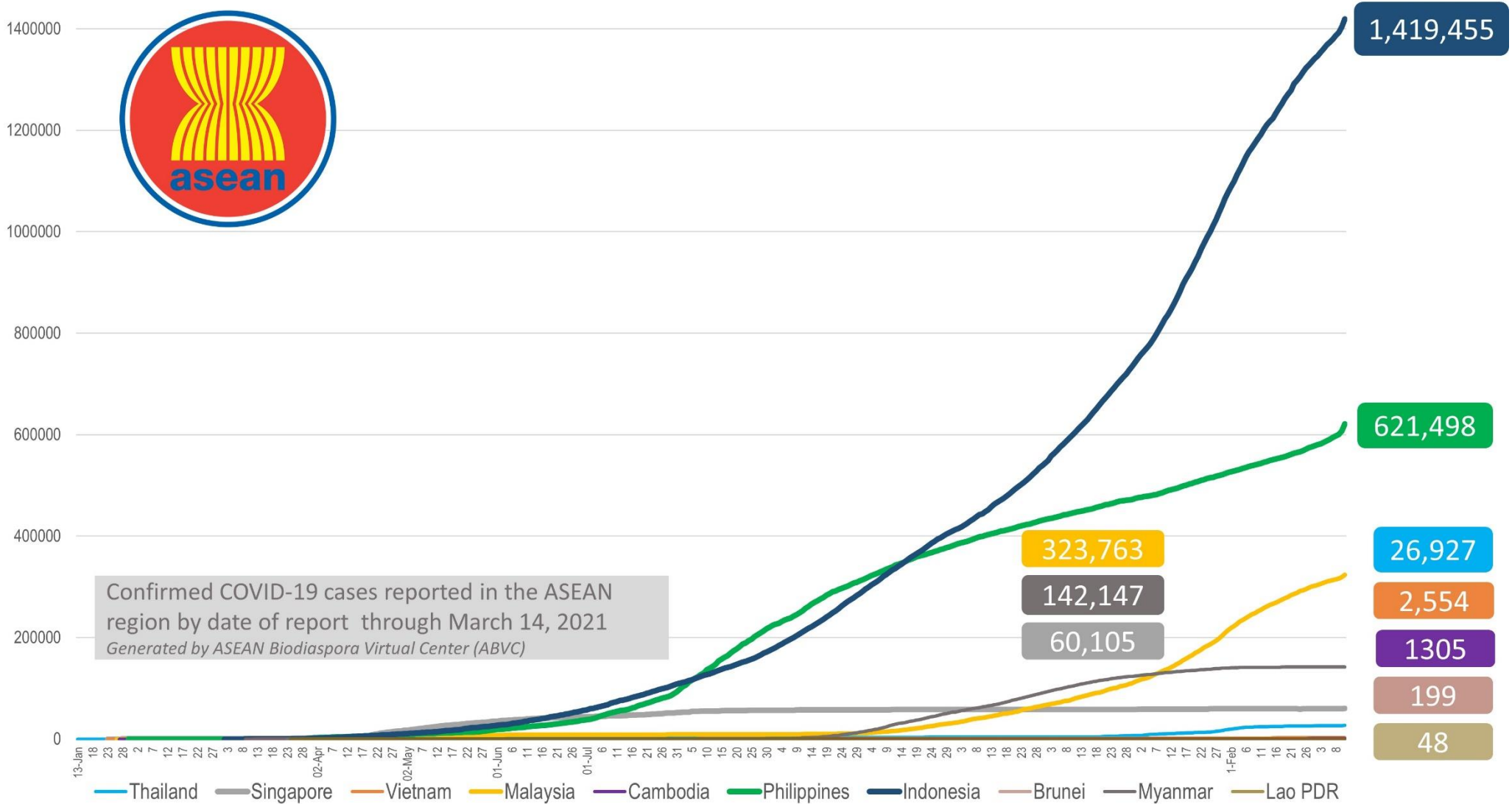
