

COVID-19: Highlights and Situation Overview

- Worldwide, there have been over 13.7 million cases, and over 585,000 deaths attributed to COVID-19. As the global economy gradually recovers from an unprecedented decline, the IMF expects that a second wave of infections will cause more economic disruptions and increase the numbers of poor and unemployed. As the focus of health care shifts to COVID-19, the WHO and UNICEF also warn of widespread disruptions to global immunization programs for children. About 75% of 82 countries surveyed in May reported disrupted vaccination campaigns due to the COVID-19 pandemic, exposing children to increased risk of vaccine-preventable diseases. Such disruptions are largely due to the low supply of personal protective equipment for health care workers, travel restrictions, and low availability of health care workers
- 75 countries have submitted expressions of interest to protect their populations and those of other nations through joining the COVAX Facility, a mechanism designed to guarantee rapid, fair and equitable access to COVID-19 vaccines worldwide. The goal of COVAX is to deliver two billion doses of safe, effective vaccines that have passed regulatory approval and/or WHO prequalification
- WHO and UNICEF have warned of a decline in vaccinations, due to disruptions in delivery caused by the COVID-19 pandemic. UNICEF Executive Director Henrietta Fore noted that "COVID-19 has made previously routine vaccination a daunting challenge" and stressed that further impact on vaccine coverage needs to be avoided, otherwise there is a risk of exchanging one crisis for another (WHO Situation Report 178)
- According to World Health Organization's (WHO) latest country situation report, the number of confirmed COVID-19 cases in Indonesia continues to rise, with the daily average of new cases increasing to 1,716 cases in the past week from 1,473 new cases per day the week prior. The report also found that none of the six provinces in Java have met the WHO's criteria for entering the new normal. Banten has seen a decline in its COVID-19 infection rate, with the rate of new cases dropping 50 percent over a three-week period from June 22 to July 12 from around 100 cases per week to 50. However, Banten has conducted fewer than 0.5 tests per 1,000 people over the past three weeks, much lower than the WHO's threshold of one suspected case tested per 1,000 people. Central Java's average for new confirmed cases also dropped to 800 over the past week from 1,000 the week prior, but, similar to Banten, the province's testing rate is far below the WHO's threshold. Central Java also has a positivity rate of around 16 percent, much higher than the WHO's threshold of 5 percent. Meanwhile, Jakarta, West Java, Yogyakarta and East Java have all seen record highs in new confirmed cases in the past week. According to the government's official count, Indonesia has recorded 81,668 confirmed COVID-19 cases, with 3,873 deaths as of July 16.
- The Philippines now has 61,266 coronavirus cases, prematurely reaching the projection of experts of 60,000 cases by the end of July. The number of cases on July 16 is the 5th time in the last week that new daily cases reported surpassed 2,000. The new cases on Thursday is the second-highest single-day rise, following the 2,539 new cases reported on July 8. Most of the new cases – 76% (1,886) still comes from Metro Manila. The DOH said that 1,886 of the new cases come from the capital region followed by Cebu province with 198 new cases. Metro Manila will continue to be on general community quarantine (GCQ) until July 31.

- Researchers from Singapore publishes new research findings that could help with development of COVID-19 vaccines and develop a more accurate testing. Researchers have discovered the specific sites on the novel coronavirus that trigger the body to produce antibodies that can prevent further COVID-19 infection. The National Centre of Infectious Diseases (NCID) and the A*STAR's Singapore Immunology Network (SIgN), said in a statement on Friday (July 17) that antibodies produced during infection attach to many parts of the virus, but only some antibodies are capable of eliminating the virus or offering protection against infection. The findings come from two studies comprising tests on more than 100 convalescent COVID-19 patients, and could help in the development of treatments and vaccines as well as more accurate diagnostic testing. These two studies were published in international scientific journals Nature Communications and EBioMedicine by The Lancet.

Travel Advisories (new update/s)

- Laos: The government of Laos has chosen to keep its borders closed to foreign visitors, with testing and medical certification required before travelers can exit the country. Following the case of a Myanmar national who tested positive for COVID-19 after exiting Laos, the National Taskforce Committee for COVID-19 Prevention and Control has declared that all travelers, including residents and Lao citizens, must carry a medical certificate before visiting another country. The national taskforce also declared that only foreign technical experts, diplomats, and students will be allowed to travel outside the country. They must obtain an official letter from their embassy and need to declare the specific objective and details of their travel. In addition, Laos Airlines plans to soon resume its international service from Laos capital Vientiane to Hanoi in Vietnam, with two flights a week on Mondays and Fridays. According to the Director of the Commercial Department of Laos Airlines, when flights resume on the Vientiane-Hanoi route, passengers from both countries will be able to enter the destination country without having to stay at a quarantine center.
- Philippines: Philippines' COVID-19 task force has approved the entry of foreign nationals holding long-term visas starting this August. Foreigners with valid and existing visas would need to undergo quarantine upon arrival.
- Thailand: Thailand on Friday (July 17) said it would give foreigners a grace period until September to apply for visa extensions as it eased restrictions amid the pandemic. After which, if a request was not made and the visa expired, overstaying will be considered illegal. In addition, the Civil Aviation Authority of Thailand will enforce a new rule requiring all passengers, even on Thai-owned chartered flights or special flights transitioning through Thailand, to have a valid COVID-19 clearance certificate. The Centre for COVID-19 Situation Administration (CCSA) also noted that no passengers without proper approval are allowed to disembark and enter Thailand.

Cases and Deaths as of 17 July 2020

- As of July 17 (2PM, GMT+8), worldwide, there were **13,813,177** confirmed cases, including **591,007** deaths. Globally, Case Fatality Ratio (CFR)* is **4.28**.

- In **China**, there were **85,766** confirmed cases with **4,651** deaths, including deaths in Hong Kong (10) and Taiwan (7). Confirmed cases in China include confirmed cases in Hong Kong (1,656), Macau (46), and Taiwan (452).
- **203,079 confirmed cases** of COVID-19 have been reported in the ASEAN region with a total of **5,732 deaths**




