



## COVID-19: Highlights and Situation Overview

- Worldwide, there have been over 121.3 million cases and more than 2.6 million deaths attributed to COVID-19.
- The Philippine capital Manila will widen a ban on minors leaving their residences to include youths of up to 18 years old for two weeks starting on Wednesday (March 17), tightening coronavirus restrictions in a bid to tackle a new surge of infections. Only those aged 18 to 65 will be allowed out of their homes. Additional measures such as liquor bans and localized lockdowns in areas with high infection rates have also been put in place.

### Vaccine Update

- According to Vietnam's Ministry of Health on Wednesday (March 17), Vietnam's first domestically developed COVID-19 vaccine, called Nanocovax, is expected to be available by the fourth quarter of this year and will be put into use in 2022. The health minister said on Wednesday that 1.3 million AstraZeneca doses will arrive in Vietnam by the end of March and be distributed across the country. Vietnam is also in talks to buy vaccines from Pfizer-BioNTech, Moderna, Johnson & Johnson and the maker of Russia's Sputnik V, the minister said, adding that it may reach a deal to secure 30 million doses of the Pfizer vaccine this year.
- Philippines' authority said that nearly 2.4 million doses are expected by early April, comprising 979,200 doses of AstraZeneca's vaccine through the COVAX facility and 1.4 million Sinovac shots including 400,000 donated by China. The authority added that the government has no plan to halt the use of AstraZeneca's vaccine to inoculate healthcare workers, even though several European countries have paused administering it after reports of possible serious side-effects. The government has also signed an agreement with the Serum Institute of India for 30 million Novavax vaccine doses, due to arrive in the third or fourth quarter of the year.
- Indonesia's Health Minister said on late Monday (March 15) that the country will delay the administering of AstraZeneca's COVID-19 vaccine due to reports of blood clots among some recipients in Europe and would await a review from the World Health Organization (WHO). Indonesia received 1.1 million doses of the AstraZeneca vaccine via the COVAX vaccine-alliance scheme this month and is set to receive some 10 million more in the next two months. The decision will leave Indonesia with just one approved vaccine, developed by China's Sinovac Biotech, for use in its nationwide vaccination drive.
- Singapore's Ministry of Health (MOH) announced that the Moderna COVID-19 vaccine will be administered at four new vaccination centres in the country starting Wednesday (March 17). These facilities include the Hong Kah North Community Club, Marsiling Community Club, Punggol 21 Community Club and Radin Mas Community Club. All other vaccination centres, as well as polyclinics and selected Public Health Preparedness Clinics (PHPCs), will continue to offer the Pfizer-BioNTech vaccine. MOH said that the Moderna vaccine will be available at more vaccination centers as more supplies of it arrive. In addition, according to the Ministry of Health (MOH) in a press release on Tuesday (March 16), Singaporeans and permanent residents under "exceptional circumstances" will now be allowed to appeal for early vaccination against COVID-19. MOH will consider the appeals of those who have an urgent need to travel overseas for formal education or to move overseas for work, or to travel to visit or care for a critically ill immediate family member, or for their own medical treatment if it cannot be accessed in Singapore.

### Travel Advisories (new update/s)

- Philippines: The Philippines will close its border to foreigners and restrict the number of Filipinos entering the country as authorities battle to contain a spike COVID-19 cases. The temporary measures come after the number of daily cases hit a seven-month high of 5,404 on Monday and experts predict the figure could double by the end of March. The ban on overseas arrivals was announced late on Tuesday (Mar 16) by the government's COVID-19 task force and takes effect on March 20. Overseas Filipino workers will be exempted, but the number of passenger arrivals will be limited to 1,500 a day.
- Vietnam: Inter-provincial bus routes in Hanoi were allowed to resume operations starting March 16.
- Malaysia: Inter-district travel in Sabah and Sarawak is still not allowed yet. Sarawak's conditional movement control order (MCO) is effective for 14 days from March 16.
- China: China will ease border restrictions to allow some foreigners including from the US, India and Pakistan to enter the country, provided they have taken a Chinese-made COVID-19 vaccine. Chinese embassies in several countries have issued notices saying the country will open visa applications to select people who have taken a China-made jab. The Chinese Embassy in the US said in a statement dated March 15 that it would begin to process "visa applicants inoculated with Chinese COVID-19 vaccines". This applies to those visiting the Chinese mainland for work resumption, business travel, or for "humanitarian needs", such as reuniting with family members. In addition, China's embassy in the Philippines said on Monday (March 15) it would simplify visa applications for anyone in the country who has been inoculated with Chinese-made COVID-19 vaccines to allow regular travel to resume. China will return to its pre-pandemic visa application requirements for those fully vaccinated with its home-grown vaccines, according to a statement by its embassy in Manila.

### Cases and Deaths as of 17 March 2021

- As of 17 March 2021 (2PM, GMT+8), worldwide, there were **121,397,942** confirmed cases, including **2,681,834** deaths. Globally, Case Fatality Rate (CFR) is **2.2**.
- In **China**, there were **102,430** confirmed cases with **4,849** deaths, including deaths in Hong Kong (203) and Taiwan (10). Confirmed cases in China include confirmed cases in Hong Kong (11,330), Macau (48), and Taiwan (990).
- **2,621,493 confirmed cases** of COVID-19 have been reported in the ASEAN region with a total of **56,178 deaths**, with a CFR of **2.1**.

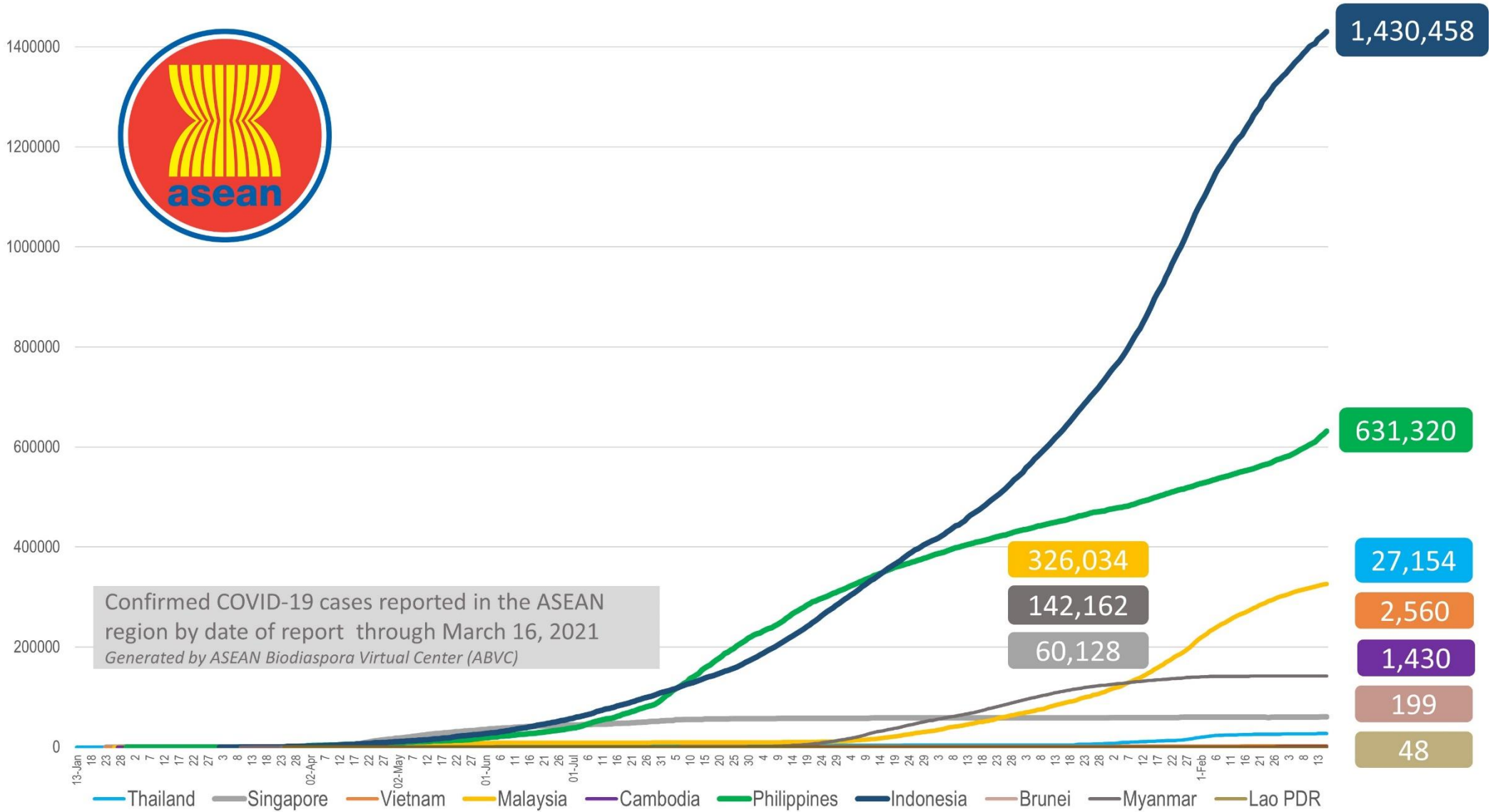
