## COVID-19: Highlights and Situation Overview

- Worldwide, there have been over 95.3 million cases and more than 2 million deaths attributed to COVID-19.
- The worldwide death toll from coronavirus approached 2 million on Friday (January 15), with Europe topping 30 million infections and World Health Organisation experts working on advice to fight new, more contagious strains of the disease. Global health experts were expected on Friday to issue recommendations to stem the spread of this variant and other new strains.
- Coronavirus infections in the Philippines have surged past 500,000. The Department of Health reported 1,895 new infections on Sunday (January 17), bringing confirmed COVID-19 cases in the country to 500,577, the second highest in Southeast Asia. Meanwhile, the foreign ministers of China and the Philippines on Saturday (January 16) committed to prioritizing post-pandemic recovery efforts as senior Chinese diplomat Wang Yi wrapped up a week-long visit to four Southeast Asian countries. The Philippines' foreign minister, Teodoro Locsin, said close cooperation to beat the pandemic enhanced ties and deepened the friendship between the two nations, adding that collaborative work on economic and infrastructure projects had resumed.
- Malaysian Prime Minister Muhyiddin Yassin has announced a new economic assistance package worth RM15 billion (US\$3.7 billion) on Monday (Jan 18) to mitigate the impact of COVID-19. In a televised address, Mr. Muhyiddin said the package dubbed PERMAI, or the Malaysian Economic and Rakyat Protection Assistance Package, strengthens the current initiatives in place to help Malaysians cope with the economic impact of COVID-19. In his Monday address, Mr. Muhyiddin said initiatives under the first objective of combating COVID-19 included the implementation of the country's COVID-19 vaccination programme, hiring more workers to strengthen the healthcare system, collaboration with private hospitals and more tests for healthcare frontliners. For the second objective of protecting people's welfare, among the initiatives he highlighted was that bank moratorium assistance and loan repayment reduction will continue to be provided. For the third objective of supporting business continuity, initiatives include a one-off monetary assistance for taxi and bus drivers, and a special 10 per cent discount on electric bills from January until March to six business sectors across the country.
- Two new community COVID-19 cases were reported on Sunday (January 17), forming a new cluster linked to a Singapore Police Force (SPF) para-veterinarian. The two community cases were among Singapore's 30 new COVID-19 infections reported as of noon on Sunday (Jan 17), according to data released by the Ministry of Health (MOH). Sunday's two community cases are linked to Case 59280, a 32-year-old male Singaporean working as a para-vet with the K-9 Unit at the SPF. He was confirmed to have COVID-19 on January 13 and his wife also confirmed to have COVID-19 on January 15. Meanwhile, plans to provide COVID-19 vaccines to 37,000 frontline workers in the aviation and maritime sectors kicked off on Monday (Jan 18), with vaccination centres for the two industries coming into full swing. During a visit to one of the vaccinations centres at Changi Airport Terminal 4, Transport Minister Ong Ye Kung said about 13,000 workers from the two sectors are already scheduled to

be vaccinated this week under the Sea-Air Vaccination Exercise. About 2,000 workers from the aviation sector will receive the vaccine on Monday at T4, while about 1,000 maritime workers will be vaccinated at the Raffles City Convention Centre.

### Travel Advisories (new update/s)

- Singapore: According to the Ministry of Health (MOH) on Saturday (January 16), travellers, including Singaporeans and permanent residents, will need to take a COVID-19 polymerase chain reaction (PCR) test upon arrival in Singapore effective January 24, as part of tighter border measures to manage the risk of imported COVID-19 cases. Existing stay-home notice requirements, including a PCR test at the end of the notice period, will continue to be in place, said the ministry.

### Cases and Deaths as of 18 January 2021

- As of 18 January (2PM, GMT+8), worldwide, there were **95,570,705** confirmed cases, including **2,041,095** deaths. Globally, Case Fatality Rate (CFR) is **2.1**.
- In **China**, there were **98,687** confirmed cases with **4,804** deaths, including deaths in Hong Kong (162) and Taiwan (7). Confirmed cases in China include confirmed cases in Hong Kong (9,558), Macau (46), and Taiwan (855).
- **1,774,616 confirmed cases** of COVID-19 have been reported in the ASEAN region with a total of **39,575 deaths**, with a CFR of **2.2**.


