

COVID-19: Highlights and Situation Overview

- WHO has delivered a new shipment of emergency medical supplies to the Islamic Republic of Iran as part of COVID-19 response measures. According to the WHO Representative, these important medicines will not only support the treatment of patients by the Ministry of Health and Medical Education and its affiliated hospitals at the provincial level who are facing critical shortages, but will also help the country contribute significantly to the Solidarity Trail in an effort to find an effective treatment for the virus.
- Diagnostic testing for COVID-19 is critical to tracking the virus, understanding epidemiology, informing case management, and to suppressing transmission. WHO has updated the Laboratory Testing Strategy document according to the 4Cs transmission scenarios. - As **Myanmar** migrant workers have seen their workplaces in Thailand shut down and many more are returning home, Myanmar and Thai authorities kept the Mae Sot-Myawaddy Bridge No. 2 checkpoint open until 6PM of March 23. On March 23, around 1,840 migrant workers had returned to Myanmar across the border with Thailand in addition to 9400 who returned in the last weekend. Officials worked to ensure everyone entering Myanmar at the immigration checkpoint in Myawaddy had to pass a health screening and body temperature check.
- On March 24, **Thailand**'s Prime Minister Prayut Chan-ocha announced that Thailand will be placed under emergency rule for a month (starting March 26) to curb the spread of COVID-19. Starting March 26, Prayut will assume sole authority to implement future coronavirus containment policies, which under the relevant 2005 royal decree allows for authorities to ban travel, shutter and censor media and impose curfews.
- **Myanmar** confirmed its first COVID-19 cases:
 - First confirmed case: 36/M
 - Myanmar national who arrived from the United States through Yangon International Airport on March 13. He travelled to a village in Tedim Township in Myanmar. On March 19, he was suffering from a high fever and was admitted at Tedim General Hospital where he tested positive for the virus.
 - Second confirmed case: 26/M
 - Myanmar national who returned from the UK. He was quarantined last March 22 in Yangon and tested positive for coronavirus. The patient is stable and is being treated at Waibargi Hospital.
 - Third confirmed case: 26/M
 - Today (March 25), third case was confirmed in Myanmar. The affected individual returned from the UK on March 21. The man tested positive while under quarantine at the Insein Public Hospital in Yangon.
- Laos confirmed its first COVID-19 cases:
 - First confirmed case: 28/M
 - traveled in Thailand from March 5 to 8 to attend a seminar. He
 returned to Laos on March 9 via Vientiane's Wattay International
 Airport. By March 23 he began to feel ill, exhibiting symptoms
 consistent with Covid-19, such as headaches, body aches, a sore

throat and shortness of breath. He was admitted to the Mittaphab Friendship Hospital in Vientiane, where he was quarantined and tested positive for the virus.

- Second confirmed case: 36/F
 - patient began to exhibit symptoms on March 10 and was taken to the same hospital for testing. A blood test and chest x-ray was conducted but did not find anything abnormal, and so the patient returned to a hotel to rest. After symptoms worsened, the patient was again brought to the Mittaphab Friendship Hospital and tested positive for COVID-19.

• Travel Advisories (new updates)

- Brunei: Effective Tuesday (March 24), all foreign nationals are not allowed to enter or transit in Brunei Darussalam through land, sea and air control posts until further announcement. The minister also explained that categories of application and facilities affected by the measure include the issuing of Visa on Arrival at all control posts; application for visit, students and dependent visas. Permit letters for visit, student and dependent visa issued by the Immigration and National Registration Department as well as Brunei Darussalam Embassies and foreign offices will also be suspended. For foreign nationals issued with visit, student and dependent visas as well as with re-entry visas but still in their countries are advised to delay their visit to Brunei Darussalam.
- Myanmar: The Myanmar government has ordered mandatory quarantines in government facilities for all travelers, except diplomats and UN officials, arriving from any country as Myanmar has confirmed its first cases of COVID-19. On March 24, the Ministry of Foreign Affairs (MOFA) said that the temporary restrictions will take affect for all travelers starting March 25. MOFA said that all arrivals—both Myanmar nationals and foreigners from any country—will be subject to a 14-day government facility quarantine upon arrival in Myanmar. In addition, foreign nationals, including diplomats and UN officials, travelling to Myanmar are required to present a medical certificate showing they tested negative for COVID-19, issued no more than 72 hours prior to the date of travel, before boarding any flights bound for Myanmar. Diplomats and UN officials arriving in Myanmar will be subject to home quarantine for 14 days.
- Thailand: Thailand will close its land borders beginning late on Monday to curb the spread of the virus. Among the border checkpoints ordered closed were the crossings between Thailand and Malaysia, Thailand and Laos in Nakhon Phanom, and the crossings between Thailand and Cambodia in Sa Kaeo Province. Myanmar and Thai authorities kept the Mae Sot-Myawaddy Bridge No. 2 checkpoint open until 6PM of March 23. The Thai government closed all other border checkpoints starting morning of March 23. The governor of Thailand's Tak Province, where Mae Sot is located, closed the Mae Sot-Myawaddy Bridge No. 1 already last March 21. On March 23, around 1,840 migrant workers had returned to Myanmar across the border with Thailand in addition to 9400 who returned in the last weekend.

Cases and Deaths as of 25 March 2020

- As of March 25 (2PM, GMT+8), worldwide, there were **405,776** confirmed cases, including **18,693** deaths.
- In **China**, there were **81,798** confirmed cases with **3,894** deaths, including deaths in Hong Kong (4) and Taiwan (2). Confirmed cases in China include confirmed cases in Hong Kong (386), Macau (25), and Taiwan (216).
- **323,978 confirmed cases** of COVID-19 have been reported in **189 countries** (other than China, Hong Kong, Taiwan and Macau):

Transmission Category of COVID-19 Affected Countries

The following global map depict countries by corresponding COVID-19 transmission <u>ca</u>tegory:

- A Countries reporting fewer than 100 confirmed cases
 - These countries have confirmed imported cases of COVID-19 from affected countries and may have limited community-based transmission.
- B Countries reporting an increasing rate of COVID-19 transmission
 - These countries have reported increasing rates of COVID-19 transmission, likely driven by ongoing community-based transmission.
- C Countries reporting a steady or decreasing rate of COVID-19 transmission
 - These countries have reported steady or decreasing rates of COVID-19 transmission compared to previous weeks, likely driven by the establishment of robust control protocols.
- D Countries reporting case counts that do not align with observed international COVID-19 Exportation
 - These countries are reporting fewer cases of COVID-19 than expected based on reports of international exportation of COVID-19 from that country, or other metrics. Statistical and mathematical models suggest that COVID-19 transmission is likely occurring at a higher rate than reported in these countries.

• These countries have not reported imported or local cases of COVID-19 as of March 24 at 12:00PM EST.




Figure 1. Countries worldwide and its category based on level of COVID-19 transmission, supported by data generated by Bluedot's global epidemic surveillance system
