COVID-19: Highlights and Situation Overview

- Worldwide, there have been over 115.4 million cases and more than 2.55 million deaths attributed to COVID-19.
- Malaysia announced that it will ease COVID-19 restrictions and reinstate the conditional movement control order (CMCO) for Selangor, Kuala Lumpur, Johor and Penang. Malaysia's Senior Minister for Security said during a press conference on Tuesday (March 2) that these areas, originally under the movement control order (MCO), will be placed under CMCO from March 5 until March 18. Additionally, Malaysia will relax the COVID-19 restrictions for other areas that are previously under CMCO including Melaka, Pahang, Sabah, Terengganu, as well as the federal territories of Putrajaya and Labuan to be placed under the recovery movement control order (RMCO). The minister said that the decision was made because of the reduction in cluster, sporadic and community cases, as well as improvement in Malaysia's infectivity rate.
- Malaysia's Health Minister said on March 3 that the country will be implementing an order, as stated in the new provisions under the Emergency (Prevention and Control of Infectious Diseases) (Amendment) Ordinance 2021, to wear a tracking device starting March 11. He said that the high-tech device in the form of a wristband, aimed at controlling movement, is mandatory to wear for 10 days among these three categories: 1) individuals who have tested positive for COVID-19; 2) persons under investigation (PUI) or close contacts of COVID-19 patients and; 3) persons under surveillance (PUS).
- Indonesia's officials said on Tuesday (March 2) that the country has detected two cases of the more infectious COVID-19 variant first discovered in Britain, the B117. The Deputy Health Minister said that the detection of this variant represents a new challenge as the country tries to contain further spread of COVID-19.
- The Philippines' Department of Health on Tuesday (March 2) said that the country has documented six cases of the South African coronavirus variant, B.1.351, raising concern among its experts that the current vaccines might be less effective. According to health authority, while there is no evidence that this variant causes more severe disease, the pattern of mutations within this variant suggests higher transmissibility and may have an impact on vaccine efficacy. Of the six cases with the South African variant, three were detected locally (in Pasay City) and two were Filipinos returning from overseas. The Department of Health today (March 4) has confirmed that one of the six cases of the South African variant was also confirmed to be from Pasay City, bringing to four the number of variant cases in the city.

Vaccine Update

- Malaysia on Tuesday (March 2), just days after launching its nationwide COVID-19 vaccine programme, granted conditional approval for the use of vaccines made by UK firm AstraZeneca and China's Sinovac. Malaysia began its vaccination drive on Feb 24 using a shot developed by US drugmaker Pfizer and German partner BioNTech. Acording to the Health's Director-General, this conditional approval means Malaysia will use the vaccines developed by Astrazeneca and Sinovac, but both firms (along with Pfizer) will be required to provide additional data on rolling submissions to ensure the vaccines' effectiveness and safety. Health authorities are also evaluating the COVID-19 vaccine produced by Russia's Gamaleya Research Institute and the local bottling facility for Sinovac's vaccine.
- Bangkok Metropolitan Administration (BMA) deputy governor has announced that Bangkok has received 66,000 doses of Sinovac vaccine allotted by the government and had started inoculating the target group since Monday. Medical professionals will be the first group to receive the vaccine at two doses per person. The second group will be public health volunteers who have high risk of contacting

infected patients during proactive testing missions and will receive the vaccination starting next week. Sophon added that the last target group to receive the first lot of Sinovac vaccine would be those who have chronic diseases and therefore would be more vulnerable if they contracted COVID-19. However, there are 10 groups of people who are prohibited from receiving the Sinovac vaccine. These include those under 18 years old and over 60 years; women who are pregnant, are breastfeeding or planning to get pregnant during the vaccination period; those who have undergone transfusion of blood, plasma or other related products for the treatment of COVID-19 in the last 90 day; those who have uncontrollable symptoms such as chest pain, trouble breathing, palpitations and those who are suffering from brain or nervous diseases. Others included in this group are those who have tested positive for COVID-19 in the past 10 days; those who have acute disease and have been out of the hospital for less than 14 days; those who have immune deficiency or are taking immunosuppressant; those who have bleeding disorder or are under anticoagulation treatment and those who show symptoms of fever, shivering, have trouble breathing or have weakened muscles.

• Philippines' authority said today (March 4) that 87,200 doses of COVID-19 vaccines developed by British-Swede pharmaceutical firm AstraZeneca will arrive in the Philippines on Thursday (March 4). The Philippines is expected to receive at least 5.6 million doses of COVID-19 vaccines from Pfizer-BioNTech and AstraZeneca via the COVAX facility within the first quarter of 2021. The country started on Monday (March 1) its mass vaccination program, following the delivery of 600,000 doses of Sinovac Biotech's vaccine, CoronaVac, donated by the Chinese government. The Philippines is also expecting to receive one million doses of Sinovac's vaccines in the third week of March once it signs the purchase order with the Chinese firm.

Travel Advisories (new update/s)

- Malaysia: Senior Minister for Security on March 2 announced that inter-district travel would now be permitted in all states except Sabah. Interstate travel is still prohibited.
- Thailand: International travellers will now be allowed to transit Thailand from Monday after the Civil Aviation Authority of Thailand (CAAT) relaxed COVID-19 measures. CAAT also says regulations are being relaxed on domestic travel as well. The authority says operators of domestic flights can resume serving in-flight meals and drinks starting from Thursday (March 4). Transport Minister says the move is part of a resolution by the Centre for Covid-19 Situation Administration to relax measures. Flight attendants and passengers, however, are still mandated to follow COVID control measures that include wearing face masks during the length of the flight except when eating or drinking.
- Singapore: Newly arrived migrant workers will soon be housed in centres where they will complete their stay-home notice, medical examination and orientation programme all at once. Singapore's Migrant Worker Onboarding Centre and the Ministry of Manpower (MOM) said on Wednesday (March 3) that the new facilities will help reduce the transmission risk from imported COVID-19 cases to the community "while helping these new workers to settle in better". The process, which will initiate on March 15, applies to workers entering the construction, marine and process sectors from "higher-risk" regions that include India and Bangladesh, where many of the workers are from. Under the new arrangement, workers will serve their stay-home notice for a few days at hotels as they wait for the results of their on-arrival tests. Workers who clear these tests will move to the onboarding centres to serve their remaining quarantine period and complete their onboarding requirements under one roof. The onboarding process comprises both an "enhanced" medical examination and "residential" settling-in programme.

Cases and Deaths as of 03 March 2021

- As of 03 March 2021 (2PM, GMT+8), worldwide, there were 115,447,742 confirmed cases, including 2,559,758 deaths. Globally, Case Fatality Rate (CFR) is 2.2.
- In **China**, there were **101,959** confirmed cases with **4,845** deaths, including deaths in Hong Kong (200) and Taiwan (9). Confirmed cases in China include confirmed cases in Hong Kong (11,033), Macau (48), and Taiwan (955).
- 2,463,121 confirmed cases of COVID-19 have been reported in the ASEAN region with a total of 53,378 deaths, with a CFR of 2.2.


