2019-nCoV Highlights and Situation Overview

- The World Health Organization (WHO) has declared a Public Health Emergency of International Concern (PHEIC) on January 30 related to the 2019-novel coronavirus outbreak centered in Wuhan, China.
- The WHO also recommends the name of the disease caused by 2019nCoV should be "2019-nCoV acute respiratory disease".

Cases and Deaths as of 27 January 2020

- As of January 31 (2PM, PH time), worldwide, there were **9,822** confirmed cases, including **212** deaths.
- The 2019-nCoV outbreak, originally centered in **Wuhan city**, is continuing to show evidence of **broader geographic** spread across **mainland China**.
- As of **January 27**, in China, there were **9720** confirmed cases with 212 deaths. Confirmed cases in China include confirmed cases in Hong Kong (12), Macao (SAR), and Taiwan (9)
- 102 imported cases of 2019-nCoV have been reported in 20 countries.

Control Strategies

- Strict surveillance measures are being enforced at airports, seaports and border crossings to prevent the disease wide-spreading into countries which share border with China Mainland.
- Macau has currently increased their border control and has closed all schools and universities to contain the outbreak.
- Accordingly, Japan, South Korea and some ASEAN countries (notably Myanmar, the Philippines, Thailand, Singapore, and Vietnam) are monitoring passengers arriving at major international airports, while flights from and/or to Wuhan were ceased operating. More seriously, North Korea even bans international flights and foreign visitors, and Papua New Guinea (PNG) bans travelers from all Asian countries.
- Mongolia, North Korea, the Far East regions of Russia close their borders with China Mainland. At the same time, Vietnam shuts a border gate down while its other three are still in active but provided with strict measures. Hong Kong closes four out of its eleven border checkpoints with mainland China. Activity through gateways in Laos, Myanmar and Vietnam are put under extra supervision from the Government and medical staffs. PNG ordered a close on border with Indonesia on the island of New Guinea.
- Kazakhstan, Malaysia, Singapore, Sri Lanka, the Philippines and Vietnam suspend visa issuance either: on arrival with Chinese citizens, toward the entire infected area of China, toward Hubei-related visitors who previously had travel history or currently hold a passport issued by Hubei and its neighborhood's authorities.

Map of 2019-nCoV Affected Countries




Figure 1. Map of countries with 2019-nCoV confirmed cases as of January 31, 2020 (2 PM, PH Time)
