COVID-19: Highlights and Situation Overview

- Worldwide, there have been over 104.3 million cases and more than 2.2 million deaths attributed to COVID-19.
- The Enhanced Movement Control Order (EMCO) placed at the Pekan Nenas Immigration detention centre and staff quarters in Pontian, Johor has been lifted. The Senior Minister said that health authorities had carried out 408 screenings for COVID-19 as of February 4, with 125 positive results. All positive patients who were sent to quarantine centres were discharged on February 4 and that health officials are not waiting for any more test results. The government agreed to lift the enhanced MCO in this locality, a day before the scheduled date, following the advice of the Health Ministry. Meanwhile, the Sabah government has allowed hair salons and car wash centres to reopen for business. However, in a statement released by the state Local Government and Housing Ministry on Thursday (February 4), night markets are still not allowed to operate in Sabah. The Minister said that the car wash and salon sectors, which involve micro businesses, were allowed to operate with strict standard operating procedure (SOP) in place starting Friday (February 5).

Vaccine Update

- Singapore said on February 3 that it has approved the use of drugmaker Moderna's vaccine, the second vaccine to which the government has given the approval after the Pfizer-BioNTech vaccine. Singapore's Health Sciences Authority said it has granted an "interim authorization" for the use of the vaccine in the city-state, with the first shipment expected to arrive around March. Taking into account some delays in the shipments of the Pfizer-BioNTech vaccine, Singapore is aiming to have enough vaccines for all Singaporeans and long-term residents within 2021, with the government promising free but voluntary vaccinations. Aside from Pfizer-BioNTech and Moderna, Singapore has also signed a purchase deal with China's Sinovac Biotech's vaccine. Singapore began its vaccination campaign on December 30 with the Pfizer-BioNTech vaccine. So far, more than 175,000 people have received the first dose, among which 6,000 have received their second dose.
- Malaysia's Prime Minister said on February 4 that the national COVID-19 vaccination programme will begin its rollout by the end of this month to immunize some 26.5 million Malaysians. He said the first phase of the immunization programme will involve vaccinating a total of 500,000 medical and non-medical frontliners and is expected to be completed by April. The second phase will involve those in the high-risk groups such as senior citizens who are aged 60 years and above, the disabled, those with heart ailments, obesity, diabetes and hypertension. The third phase of the programme will involve the remaining group, aged 18 and above, with the vaccinations to be carried out between May this year and February next year.
- Thailand's Health Minister said on Thursday (February 4) that Thailand will import the first doses of AstraZeneca's vaccine from Asia after Europe enforced export controls. The European Union (EU) last week set restrictions on the export of vaccines from the bloc through to March to ensure it will secure the supplies it had bought in advance, including shots from AstraZeneca. Thailand will still import the first 50,000 of 150,000 "early doses" of the AstraZeneca vaccine later this month, just not from Europe as previously planned. South Korea and India are among the countries in Asia currently producing the AstraZeneca vaccine. China's Sinovac Biotech will also deliver the first 200,000 of two million doses of its vaccine that Thailand had ordered around the end of February.
- The second shipment of Myanmar's COVID-19 vaccines from India has been delayed due to the country's ongoing political conflict. The Indian Embassy in Myanmar said that the scheduled date of the Covishield/AstraZeneca, scheduled to arrive in Myanmar on February 4, has been pushed back to February 11. The country initially planned to start vaccination of the general population on February 5.

- The Philippine government has identified the detailed priority population in its Covid-19 vaccination program which now includes more sectors like teachers, social and government workers, overseas Filipino workers and more. In a statement today (February 5), presidential spokesperson said the following priority groups have been approved by country's Interim National Immunization Technical Advisory Group (iNITAG): A1) Frontline workers in health facilities both national and local, private and public, health professionals and non-professionals like students, nursing aides, janitors, barangay health workers, etc.; A2) Senior citizens aged 60 and above; A3) Persons with comorbidities not otherwise included in the preceding categories; A4) Frontline personnel in essential sectors including uniformed personnel and those in working sectors identified by the IATF as essential during ECQ; A5) Indigent population not otherwise included in the preceding categories; B1) Teachers, Social Workers; B2) Other Government Workers; B3) Other essential workers; B4) Socio-demographic groups at significantly higher risk other than senior citizens and indigenous people; B5) Overseas Filipino Workers; B6) Other Remaining Workforce; and C) Rest of the Filipino population not otherwise included in the above groups. Meanwhile, the Philippines, along with 91 low and middle-income countries, is exempted from the European Union's export ban on Covid-19 vaccines, the trading bloc's delegation in Manila said on February 4. The EU Delegation to the Philippines said the export ban on Covid-19 vaccines would have "no impact" on the Philippines and other poor countries.

Travel Advisories (new update/s)

- Myanmar: The Yangon International Airport ceased operations following political unrest which sparked on February 1.
- Philippines: The Philippines has allowed more foreign nationals with valid visas to enter the country starting February 16. Foreigners with visas issued as of March 20, 2020 and are still valid at the time of entry have been allowed by the Inter-Agency Task Force for the Management of Emerging Infectious Diseases (IATF) to enter the country. Also allowed to enter the Philippines are holders of valid and existing Special Resident and Retirees Visa (SRRV) and Section 9 (A) visas as long as they present an entry exemption document to the Bureau of Immigration upon arrival. All foreign nationals allowed to enter the country must have pre-booked accommodation for at least six nights in an accredited quarantine hotel or facility. They must also be subject to Covid-19 testing on the sixth day from the date of their arrival in the country.

Cases and Deaths as of 05 February 2021

- As of 05 February 2021 (2PM, GMT+8), worldwide, there were **105,487,577** confirmed cases, including **2,291,231** deaths. Globally, Case Fatality Rate (CFR) is **2.2**.
- In **China**, there were **101,168** confirmed cases with **4,830** deaths, including deaths in Hong Kong (185) and Taiwan (9). Confirmed cases in China include confirmed cases in Hong Kong (10,553), Macau (47), and Taiwan (919).
- 2,111,722 confirmed cases** of COVID-19 have been reported in the ASEAN region with a total of **46,133 deaths**, with a CFR of **2.2**.

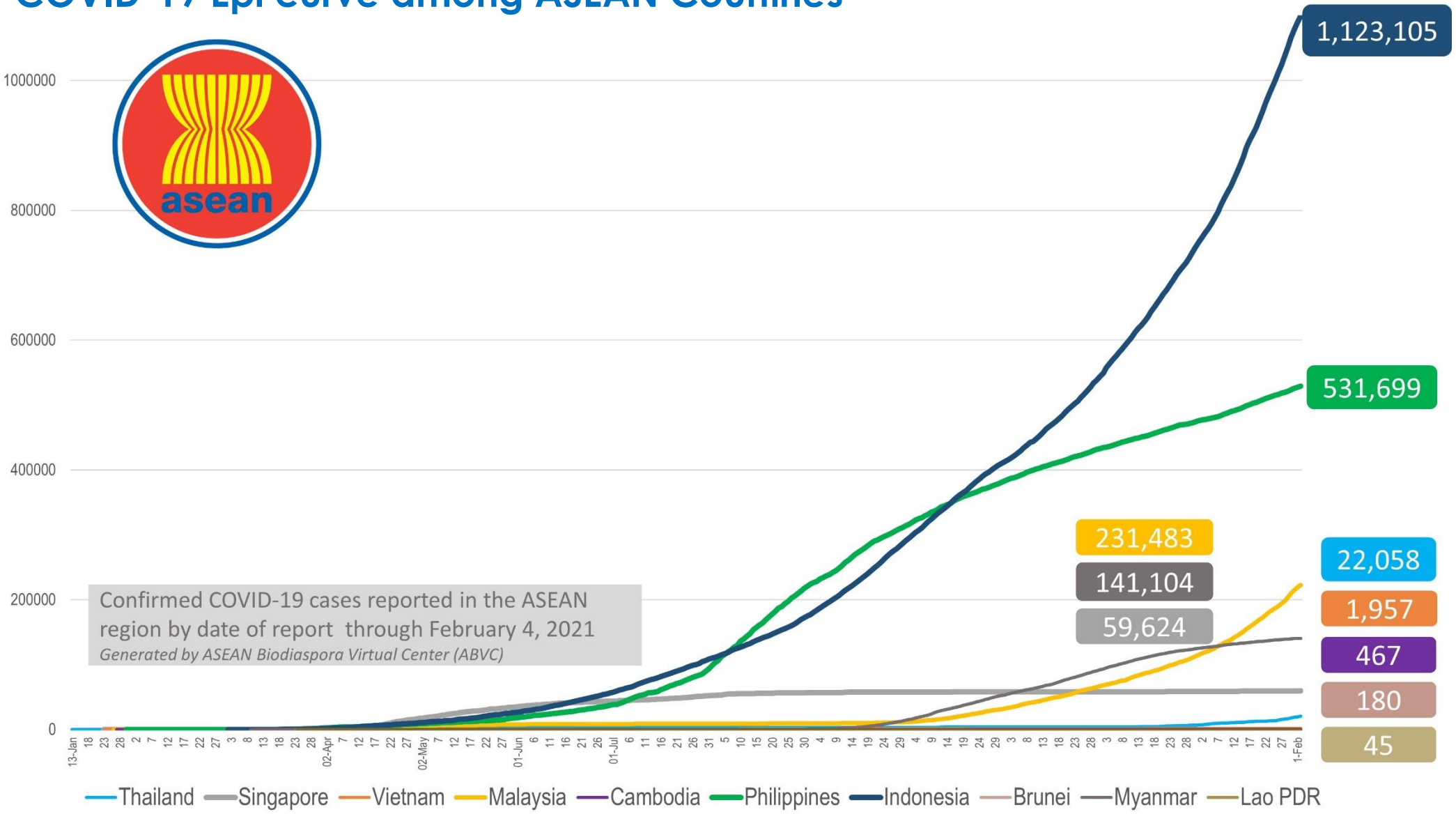
