

## **COVID-19: Highlights and Situation Overview**

#### **Global Updates**

- Worldwide, over 696 million cases and over 6 million deaths have been attributed to COVID-19.
- **India:** reported a single-day rise of 72 new COVID-19 infections while the active caseload has been recorded at 348, according to Union Health Ministry data. The death toll has been recorded at 532,035, updated at 8am on October 11. The country's COVID-19 case tally currently stands at 44,999,438. [Full article]
- Republic of China (Taiwan): The Centers for Disease Control (CDC) reported a slight increase in COVID-19 hospitalizations last week, with 110,210 hospital visits for influenzalike illnesses and 11 influenza-related deaths reported. The average number of hospitalized moderate-to-severe COVID-19 cases last week was 39 per day, slightly higher than the previous week's average of 35 per day. The number of prescriptions for oral antiviral drugs to treat COVID-19 also rose slightly last week. COVID-19 infections might peak by the end of December, with an estimated 22,000 to 24,000 new cases per day. The CDC encourages elderly people and high-risk groups to get vaccinated to reduce the risk of severe complications or death. The Omicron XBB 1.5-adapted COVID-19 vaccine has been available for elderly people and high-risk groups since September 26, with about 150,000 people receiving shots. Eligibility for the vaccine has been expanded to all people aged six months or older. The annual flu vaccination program was launched on October 9 last week, and more than 1.23 million vaccines had been administered as of yesterday. [Full article]

### **Regional Updates**

- Philippines: The Department of Health (DOH) reported 152 new COVID-19 cases, raising
  the total to 4,116,794. The country has 3,033 active cases and a 98.3% recovery rate. The
  DOH reported that 224 of 1,969 available ICU beds are occupied, with 3,028, 16,29% of
  18,590 beds in use. [Full article]
- **Vietnam** reported 17 new COVID-19 cases on October 11, with 15 patients recovering. Since the beginning of the epidemic, Vietnam has had 11,623,911 cases, ranking 13/231 countries and territories. The total number of deaths due to COVID-19 in Vietnam to date is 43,206, accounting for 0.4% of the total number of infections. The total number of vaccine doses administered is 266,532,582, with the number of doses for people aged 18 years and older being 223,841,647, and for children aged 12-17 years at 23,965,655. ## **COVID-19 Cases and Deaths**

- As of 12 October 2023 (5PM, GMT+7), worldwide, there were **696,472,014** confirmed cases, including **6,925,314** deaths. Globally, Case Fatality Rate (CFR) was **1.0%**.
- 36,430,795 total confirmed cases of COVID-19 have been reported in the ASEAN Region.
- The Case Fatality Rate in the ASEAN Region was 1.01%.



From January 1 to October 12, 2023



From January 1, 2023 to October 12, 2023



As of September 2023



From January to September 2023



as of 12 October 2023




January 1 – September 26, 2023

## **Mpox: Highlights and Situation Overview**

- From 01 January to 26 September 2023, there were 6,517 confirmed cases worldwide in 2023, including 83 deaths. Globally, the Case Fatality Rate (CFR) was 1.27%.
- 403 confirmed cases including 1 death in the ASEAN region in 2023, with a CFR of **0.25%**.
- 6,114 confirmed cases of mpox have been reported in other 5 regions in 2023 (other than the ASEAN region):

#### **Regional Updates**

• **Vietnam:** Ho Chi Minh City's Department of Health (HCMC) reported a quick report on epidemic prevention and control activities, including an mpox outbreak. The city has detected 10 new cases of mpox, with four confirmed cases. The health sector is monitoring early detection and treatment. Hospitals in Ho Chi Minh City are open daily, with around 800-900 medical visits. [Full article]
