COVID-19: Highlights and Situation Overview

Global Updates

- **Worldwide**, over 696 million cases and over 6 million deaths have been attributed to COVID-19.
- **Hong Kong (SAR)**: The recent death of a 20-month-old child who contracted COVID-19 underlines the need for parents to get their children vaccinated (RTHK, 2023). Experts, including Lau Yu-lung, a University of Hong Kong pediatrics professor, and Patrick Ip, an HKU pediatrician, emphasized the importance of vaccination. They said that complications from COVID-19 are more common in children without immune protection and who haven't been vaccinated. They also noted that up to October 15th, only 30% of Hong Kong's young children have received one or two doses of Covid vaccination. [\[Full article\]](#)
- **India** has recorded 51 new coronavirus infections, 259 active cases, and 533,293 deaths. The country's COVID-19 case tally is 45 million, with a recovery rate of 98.81% and a case fatality rate of 1.19% (PTI, 2023). The number of people recovering has increased to 44,467,574, and 2.21 billion doses of COVID-19 vaccine have been administered so far. [\[Full article\]](#)
- **Bulgaria** has reported 403 new confirmed cases of COVID-19 in the last 24 hours, with a 13.7% positive rate (Novinite.com, 2023). Six patients have died, and 458 people have been diagnosed in hospitals, with 28 in intensive care units. 208 people have been cured in the last 24 hours, and 5,343 active cases are currently present. 3,383 doses of COVID-19 vaccines have been administered in the last 24 hours, with 4,683,676 doses administered since the start of the vaccination campaign. 38,528 people have lost their battle against the virus. - **Republic of Korea**: South Korea's COVID-19 patient count decreased for the ninth consecutive week, with seniors accounting for nearly 40% of new cases (Yoon-seung, 2023). The country downgraded COVID-19 to Class 4, the lowest level on par with the seasonal flu, and suspended its full-scale testing system. Health authorities started vaccinations for seniors to address new variants, with younger citizens starting next month. [\[Full article\]](#)
- **Canada**: New Brunswick has seen a surge in COVID-19 hospital admissions, with 57 admissions between October 8 and 14, compared to the previous week (Perry, 2023). The majority of patients were aged 65 and over, with seven people aged 45 to 64, three people aged 20 to 44, and one person aged five to 19. Three more patients died in the hospital during that week, all aged 65 and over. The number of new COVID cases increased from 133 the previous week, and the test positivity rate rose to 17%. - **Pakistan** has reported 13 new COVID-19 cases in the past week, with a 0.76% positivity rate (Dental News, 2023). The Ministry for National Health Services has reinforced Border and Health Services to enhance preparedness and monitoring at entry points, including airports. Despite 90% of the population having received the vaccine, no new fatalities have been attributed to the virus. [\[Full article\]](#)

Regional Updates

- The **Philippines** has reported 152 new COVID-19 cases, bringing the total to 4,119,152 since the pandemic began (Untalan, 2023). Active infections increased by 23 cases to 2,912, while recoveries rose by 129 to 4,049,509. The death toll remains at 66,734. The National Capital Region had the most new cases in the past 14 days, followed by Quezon City, Cavite, Rizal, Laguna, and Bulacan provinces. [\[Full article\]](#)

- As of 26 October 2023 (5PM, GMT+7), worldwide, there were **696,957,814** confirmed cases, including **6,931,543** deaths. Globally, Case Fatality Rate (CFR) was **1.0%**.
- 36,445,502 total confirmed cases** of COVID-19 have been reported in the **ASEAN Region**.
- The CFR in the **ASEAN** Region was **1.01%**.



From January 1 to October 26, 2023



From January 1, 2023 to October 26, 2023



As of September 2023



From January to September 2023





January 1 – October 19, 2023



Mpox: Highlights and Situation Overview

- From 01 January to 26 October 2023, there were **7,018** confirmed cases worldwide in 2023, including **83** deaths. Globally, the CFR was **1.19%**.
- 506 confirmed cases** including **1 death** in the **ASEAN region** in 2023, with a CFR of **0.21%**.
- 6,512 confirmed cases** of mpox have been reported in other **5 regions** in 2023 (other than the ASEAN region):

Regional Updates

- Indonesia:** The number of positive cases of mpox in Jakarta has risen to 13, following the discovery of two additional cases on October 23, 2023 (Andelin, 2023). The increase was attributed to close contact between the two cases, with one resulting from sexual intercourse. The local Health Service's Head of Surveillance, Epidemiology and Immunization, stated that 11 other people were suspected of having symptoms, and those suspected have undergone PCR laboratory examination. The first positive case in Jakarta was in August 2022, involving a 27-year-old man with a history of traveling abroad. The number of cases increased by 1 on October 13, 2023. [\[Full article\]](#)
- Vietnam:** On October 25, Ho Chi Minh City recorded its first monkeypox death, marking the first in Vietnam (Tuan, 2023). The 29-year-old patient, residing in Long An province, was hospitalized due to fever and blisters for 9 days. Despite intensive treatment, the patient developed a severe systemic infection, progressing into septic shock and multiple organ failure. The Ho Chi Minh City Department of Health has directed the establishment of a Professional Council to report on this case. As of October 22, 20 cases of monkeypox were being treated at the Tropical Diseases Hospital, with 18 diagnosed with B20. Doctors are treating patients, but it is impossible to predict their outcomes in advance. [\[Full article\]](#)
