# COVID-19: Highlights and Situation Overview

## Global Update

- Worldwide, there have been over 151 million cases and more than 3 million deaths attributed to COVID-19.
- India's COVID-19 infections crossed the 18 million mark on Thursday (Apr 29) with almost 380,000 new cases, breaking another world record for new daily infections. According to health ministry data, India reported 379,257 new cases and 3,645 new deaths, taking its total caseload to 18.38 million and fatalities to 204,832. It was the highest number of deaths reported in a single day in India since the start of the pandemic. This month alone, India has added more than 6 million new cases. Experts said the country's best hope to curb its second deadly wave of COVID-19 was to vaccinate its vast population. On Wednesday it opened registrations for everyone above the age of 18 to be given jabs starting Saturday (May 1). The crisis is particularly severe in New Delhi, with people dying outside already-crowded hospitals where three people are often forced to share beds. Delhi is reporting one death from COVID-19 every four minutes and ambulances have been taking the bodies of COVID-19 victims to makeshift crematorium facilities in parks and parking lots, where bodies burned on rows and rows of funeral pyres. The World Health Organization said in its weekly epidemiological update that India accounted for 38% of the 5.7 million cases reported worldwide last week.

## Regional Update

- Vietnam authorities said on Thursday (April 29) it had detected its first locally transmitted cases of the COVID-19 in 35 days, as authorities ordered tighter surveillance to prevent a new outbreak. Authorities ordered provinces and state agencies to tighten screening and controls. Contact-tracing efforts, meanwhile, were launched after the community infections were found. Meanwhile, Hanoi required residents to wear face masks in public spaces. The city on April 27 ordered to suspend all festive activities and the operation of walking street and continue to limit unnecessary events and activities that draw large gatherings. At the meeting of Hanoi Steering Committee for COVID-19 Prevention and Control on April 29 afternoon, the city's leaders said the epidemic situation in the coming days would develop, especially in the context that numbers of people will return to the city after the holiday. As a precaution, Hanoi and Ho Chi Minh City have shut all bars, nightclubs, and karaoke parlors starting today (April 30).
- A shortage of hospital beds in Thailand has put a strain on its public health system as a new wave of COVID-19 infected more than 34,000 patients this month. On Thursday (April 29), the Centre for COVID-19 Situation Administration (CCSA) reported 1,871 new cases and 10 more deaths. Although the daily case number did not exceed 2,000 for the first time in six days, hospitals are increasingly filled with patients with severe conditions. The continued increase of infections has led to the opening of several field hospitals and hotel hospitals nationwide, where more than 10,000 beds remain available. However, these facilities can only accommodate asymptomatic patients and those with mild symptoms. For those with moderate symptoms or severe conditions, they need to be treated at regular hospitals. Government authority today (April 30) announced that starting midnight Saturday (May 2), tightened disease control measures will take effect, including restrictions set nationwide as well as restrictions based on the recent color-coded zoning by the CCSA. Under the new zoning, 6 provinces are classified as "dark red" zones under the highest control to slow the spread of the coronavirus. Those provinces include Bangkok, Chon Buri, Chiang Mai, Nonthaburi, Pathum Thani, and Samut Prakan. The restrictions will be in place for at least 14

days which include prohibiting alcohol sales at restaurants; bars, other nightlife and entertainment venues, schools and tutoring centres will also be closed. Parties and large gatherings are banned, except for household and traditional gatherings and ceremonies like funerals. Face masks will be required in public places in all provinces, although most provinces have already imposed local measures requiring the masks to be worn. The latest restrictions and measures were approved during the Centre for COVID-19 Situation Administration (CCSA) meeting chaired by Thailand's Prime Minister.

### **Vaccine Update**

- Thailand converted part of Suvarnabhumi Airport's check-in area into an immunization centre as part of efforts to speed up its COVID-19 vaccine rollout. Cordons and suitcases were replaced with evenly-spaced chairs at check-in counters, where immigration and airport staff and cabin crew lined up to register for the vaccines, of which more than 1,000 will be administered each day. Thailand's government has yet to start mass vaccinations and is rushing to secure vaccine supplies to supplement those set to be manufactured locally from June.
- As of April 29, 2021, 12,280,765 Indonesians have received their first vaccinations, or 167,877 more than the day before (April 28). Meanwhile, 7,566,371 people have received their second vaccination, or 191,913 more than the previous day. The government began its COVID-19 Vaccination Program on January 13, 2021. It is split into four phases with healthcare workers receiving the first batch of vaccines, followed by public servants and then other members of the public. The government aims to inoculate a total of 181,554,465 people by early 2022.
- Philippine Ambassador to Russia announced that the first batch, 15,000 doses, of Sputnik V vaccines is now on its way to the Philippines and would arrive in the country by May 1. The initial batch of the vaccine developed by Russia's Gamaleya Institute was supposed to be delivered on April 28 but was delayed due to flight restrictions like having no direct flights from Moscow to Manila. The office of the President earlier said this Sputnik V batch will be distributed in Metro Manila once the vaccine doses arrive. Sputnik V already secured an emergency use authorization from the country's Food and Drug Administration (FDA) and can be administered to people 18 years old and above. At present, the national government is inoculating healthcare workers, senior citizens, and persons with comorbidities. The Philippines is aiming to vaccinate the general public by August once there is a sufficient supply of COVID-19 vaccines

### **Travel Advisories** (new update/s)

- Thailand: Thailand will increase the current mandatory quarantine period for international travellers from 10 days, to 14 days and make wearing mask mandatory in all provinces starting May 1 in bid to contain a rapid surge of COVID-19 cases in the country. The Phuket governor also issued an order to close all land borders to the island province from 11PM to 5AM each day. The borders include the main Tha Chat Chai entry checkpoint in the Thalang district. The closure order will be in place until May 12. Only essential travel will be allowed to pass through the checkpoints during the late night and early morning hours, including ambulances and trucks transporting food, medicine or important chemicals. Drivers who have been vaccinated against COVID-19, or who have negative results for COVID-19 in a rapid test, can pass through.
- Philippines: Starting May 1, the Philippines will be lifting its ban on the entry of foreign nationals except for those coming from India or with a history of travel to India. Foreign nationals, however, will be subject to conditions including: 1) travellers must have a valid and existing visa, except for those under Balikbayan Program; 2) travellers must have pre-booked accommodation for at least seven nights

in an accredited quarantine hotel or facility; 3) travellers must be subject to COVID-19 testing on the sixth day of arrival; and 4) travellers are subject to the maximum capacity of inbound passengers (1,500 per day) at the port and the date of entry.

### Cases and Deaths as of 30 April 2021

- As of 30 April 2021 (2PM, GMT+8), worldwide, there were **151,408,963** confirmed cases, including **3,179,872** deaths. Globally, Case Fatality Rate (CFR) is **2.1**.
- In **China**, there were **103,583** confirmed cases with **4,857** deaths, including deaths in Hong Kong (209) and Taiwan (12). Confirmed cases in China include confirmed cases in Hong Kong (11,771), Macau (49), and Taiwan (1,121).
- **3,380,469 confirmed cases** of COVID-19 have been reported in the ASEAN region with a total of **67,527 deaths**, with a CFR of **2.0**.

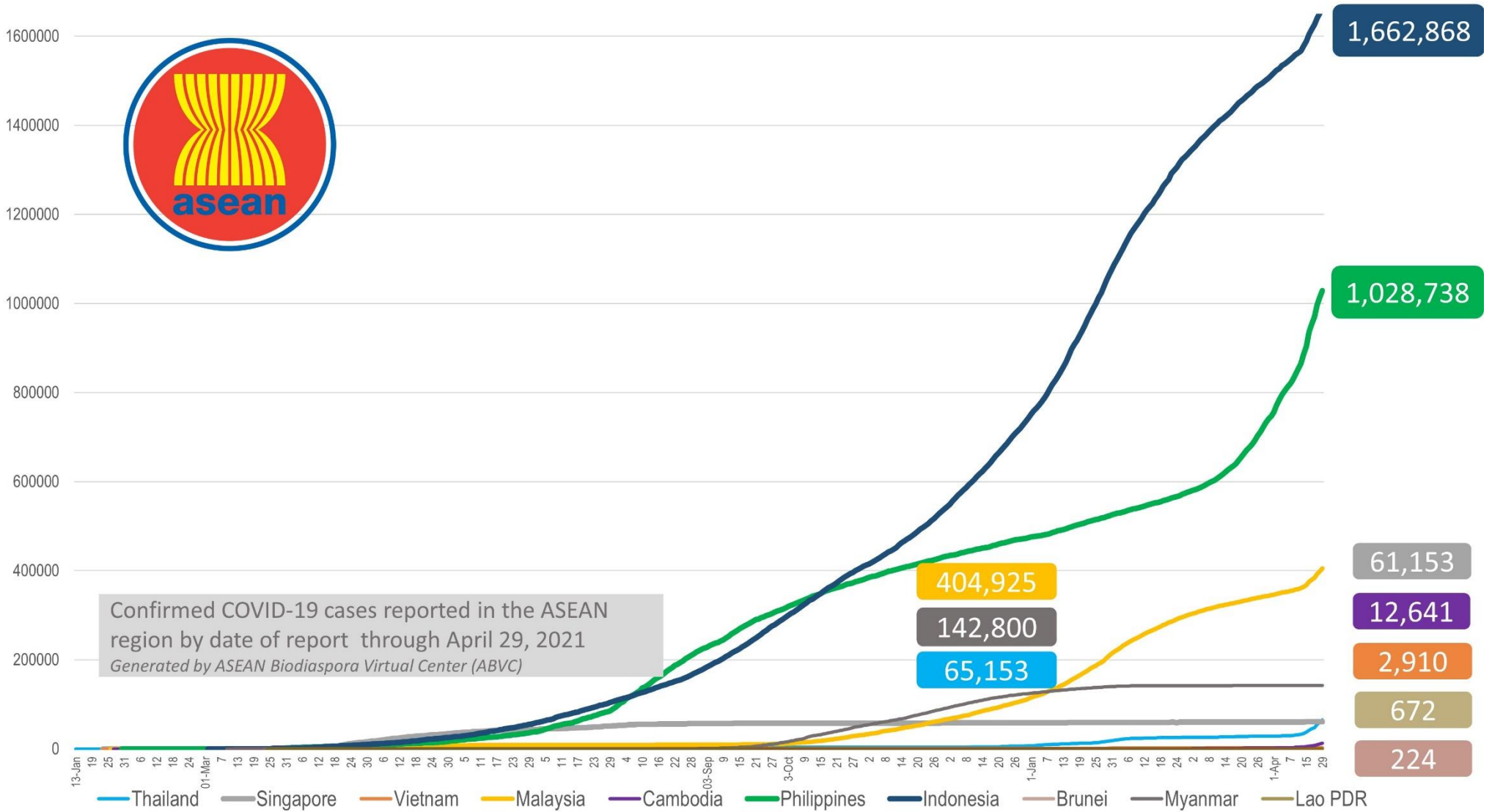

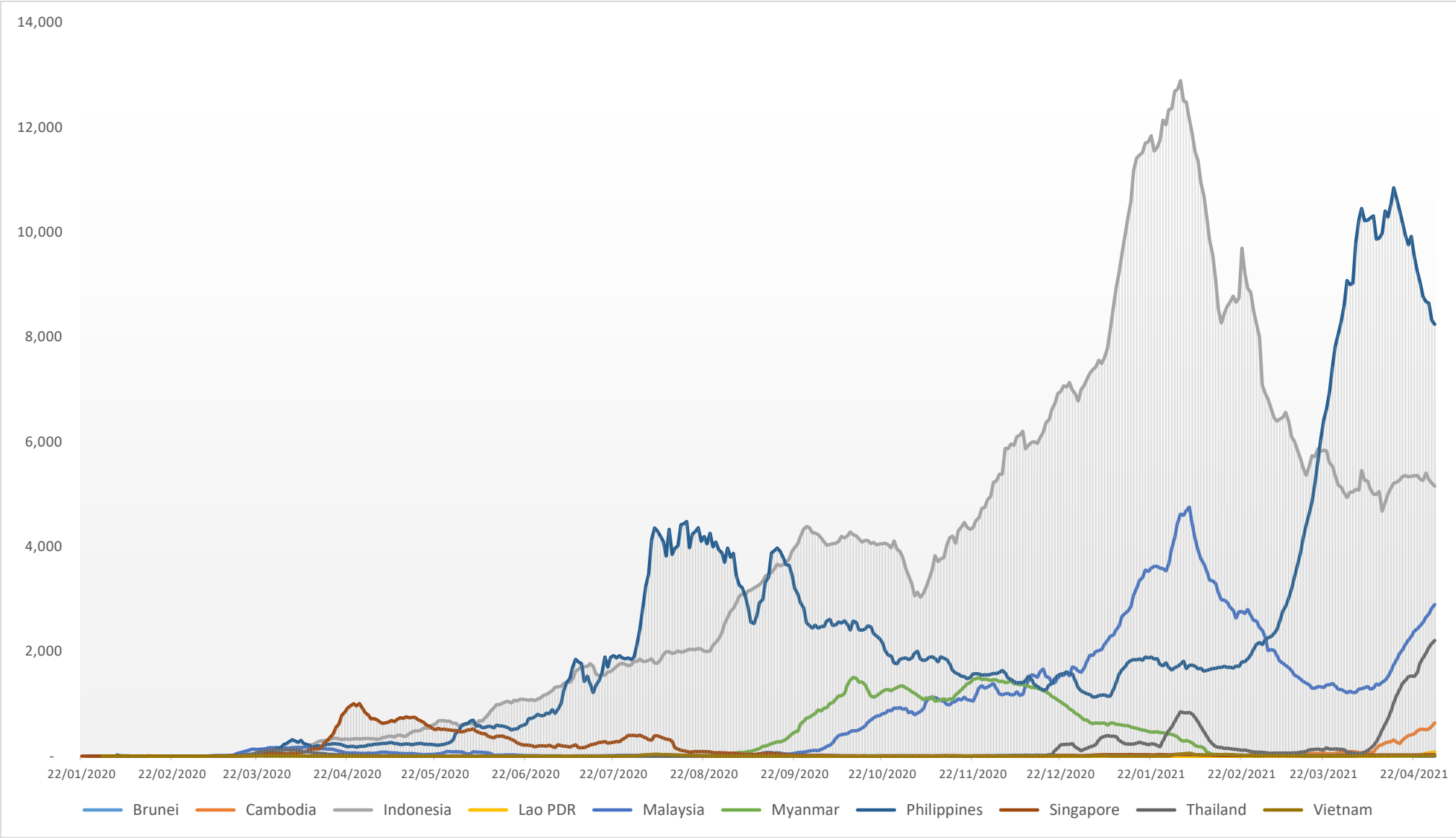
# COVID-19 Epi curve among ASEAN Countries
