

GLOBAL

To date, 146,732 cases of mpox and 343 deaths (CFR=0.23%) have been reported across 137 countries globally with clade II as a dominant variant. Eighteen countries outside Africa have also reported severe clade Ib (Sweden, Thailand, India, Germany, the United Kingdom, the United States, Canada, Belgium, Oman, Pakistan, France, China, Qatar, the United Arab Emirates, Brazil, Switzerland, Australia and Italy).

Global Distribution of Mpox Variant (Clade)






Figure 1. Global Distribution of Mpox Clade

AFRICA

As of July 3, 2025, The Democratic Republic of the Congo (DRC) has reported a total of 23,238 cases with 51 deaths (CFR=0.22%), predominantly clade Ib variant.




Figure 2. Distribution of Mpox cases in African Countries, 2022-2025




Figure 3. Weekly Trends of Mpox Cases among African Countries

Weekly trends of mpox in African Countries (2022-2025)




Figure 4. Weekly trends of Mpox Cases in African Countries (2022-2025)




Figure 5. The distribution of mpox variants in ASEAN and Neighbouring Countries and Areas




Figure 6. Trends of mpox cases in the ASEAN Region, July 2022 to July 3, 2025




Figure 7. Trends of mpox cases among ASEAN member states, July 2022 to July 3, 2025
