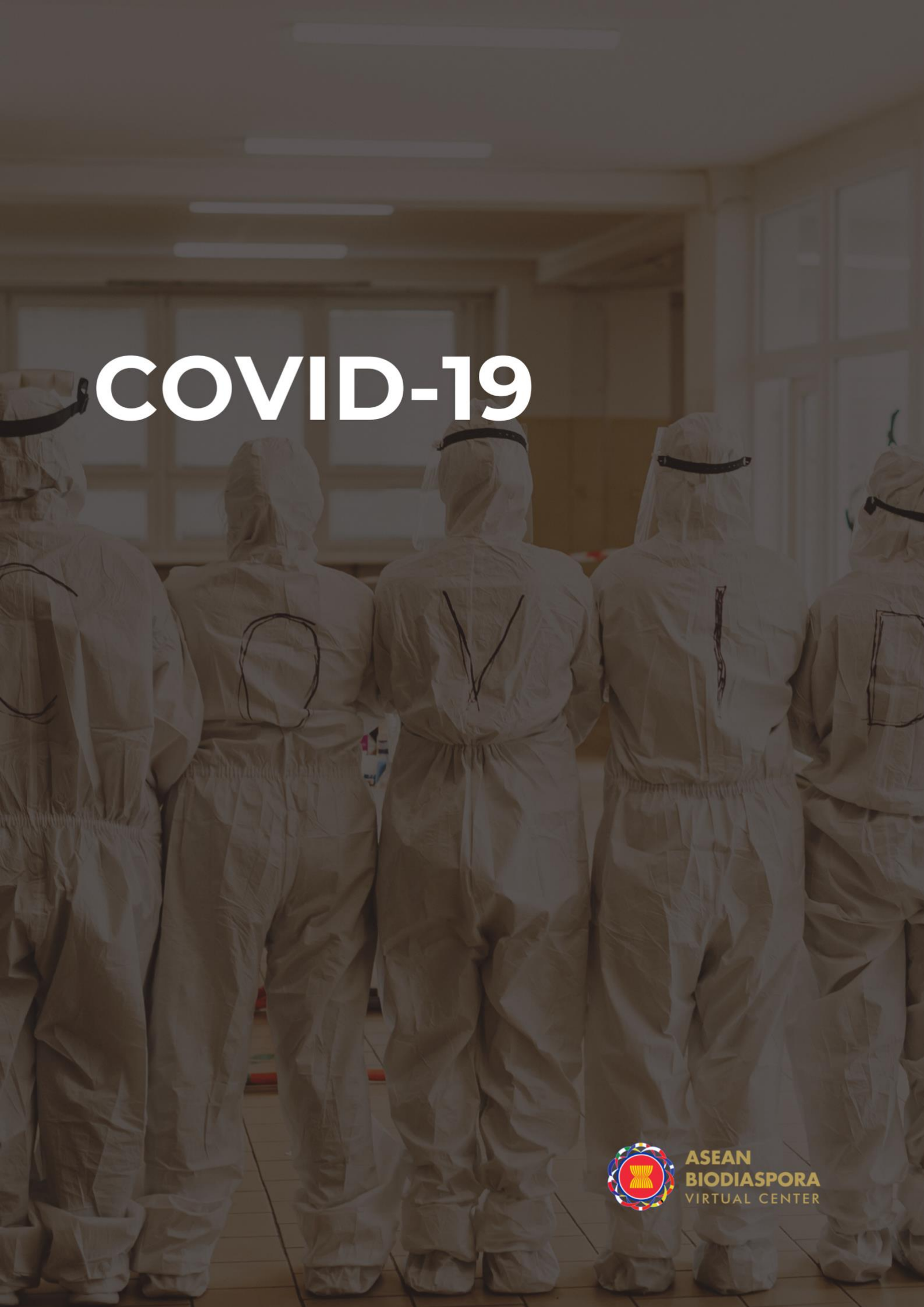

COVID-19: Highlights and Situation Overview

COVID-19 Global Updates

- **Worldwide**, over 697 million cases and over 6 million deaths have been attributed to COVID-19.
- **Bulgaria** reported 357 new COVID-19 cases in the first of November after 2,765 tests conducted in the last 24 hours. This result has a nearly 13% positive rate. Besides, two new deaths occurred, bringing the total to 38,555 deaths (Novinite, 2023). while 65 were hospitalized, more than 700 patients have recovered. In total, the number of COVID-19 patients in Bulgaria has reached 451, with 26 in intensive care units (Novinite, 2023). [[Full article](#)]
- **India** experienced a single-day increase in COVID-19 infections, with active cases at 252 and death toll at 5,33,294. The country's COVID-19 case tally was over 45 million, with a recovery rate of 98.81% and a case fatality rate of 1.19% (ETHealthworld, 2023). [[Full article](#)]
- **Nigeria** Centre for Disease Control and Prevention reported that over 5,708,974 samples have been tested, 266,675 cases confirmed with COVID-19, and 259,953 cases recovered from the virus (Ramalan, 2023). [[Full article](#)]
- **Pakistan** reported 16 new COVID-19 cases over the past week, with a case positivity rate of 0.52%. The government strengthened Border and Health Services' role, implemented surveillance systems at entry points, and 90% of the population has been vaccinated against the virus (The Nation, 2023). - **Russia's** COVID-19 incidence has increased by 30.1% in the past week, with 18.32 new infections per 100,000 population. The number of hospitalizations increased by 19.2%, with 3,781 people hospitalized in 56 regions, exceeding the national average (Ysia, 2023). [[Full article](#)]

- As of 02 November 2023 (5PM, GMT+7), worldwide, there were **697,263,691** confirmed cases, including **6,933,637** deaths. Globally, Case Fatality Rate (CFR) was **0.99%**.
- 36,430,795 total confirmed cases** of COVID-19 have been reported in the **ASEAN Region**.
- The CFR in the **ASEAN Region** was **1.01%**.

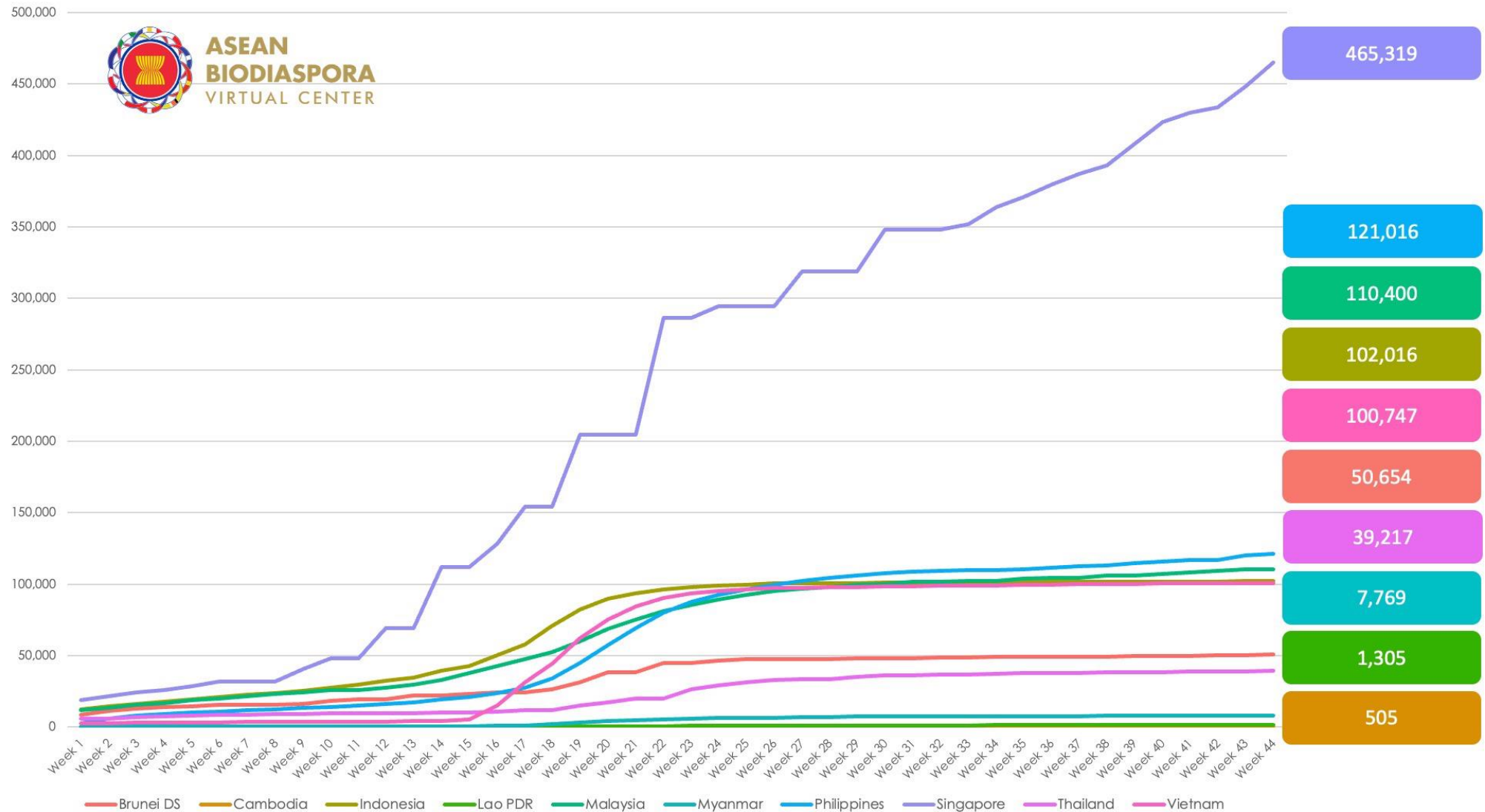

From January 1 to November 02, 2023

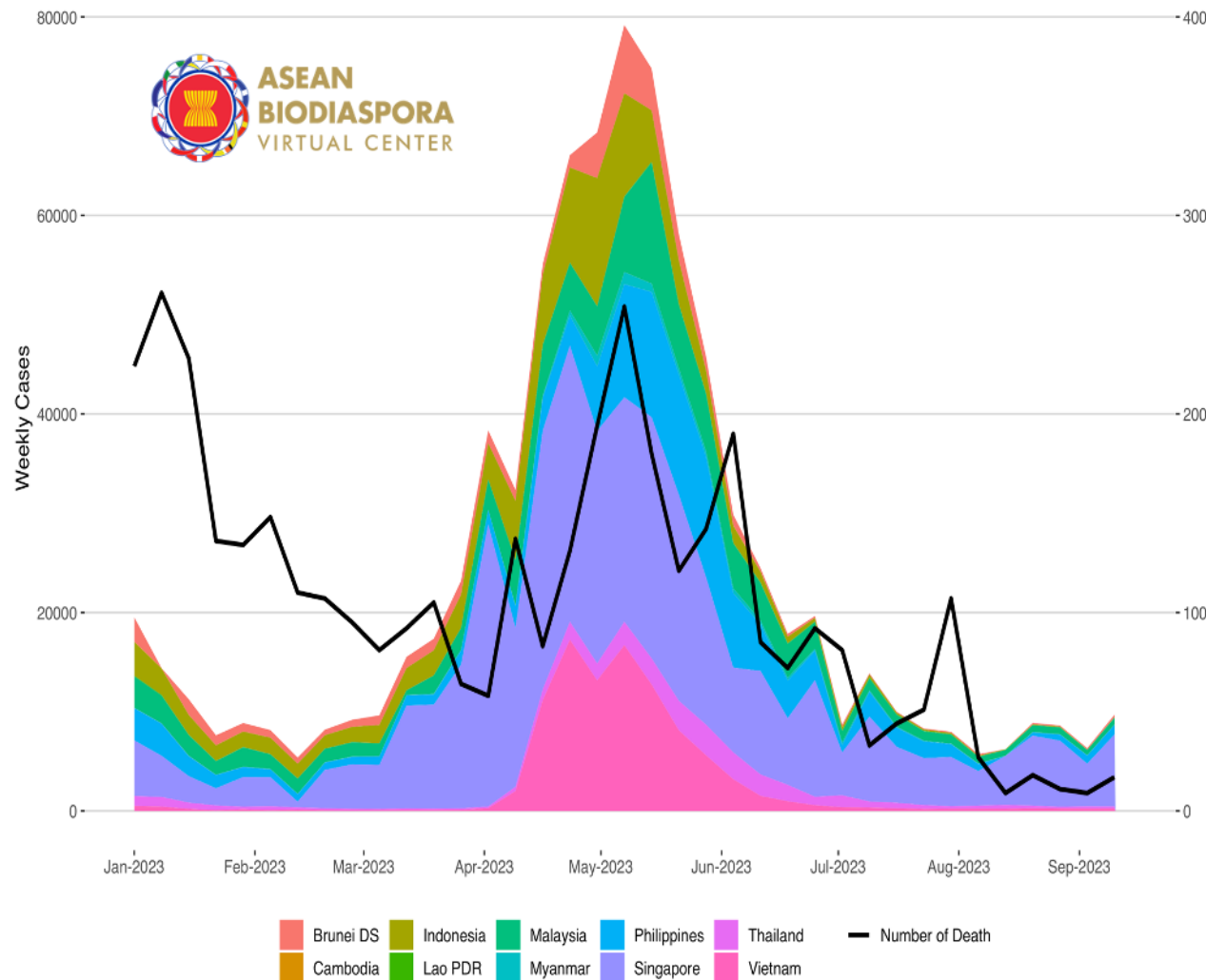

From January 1, 2023 to November 02, 2023



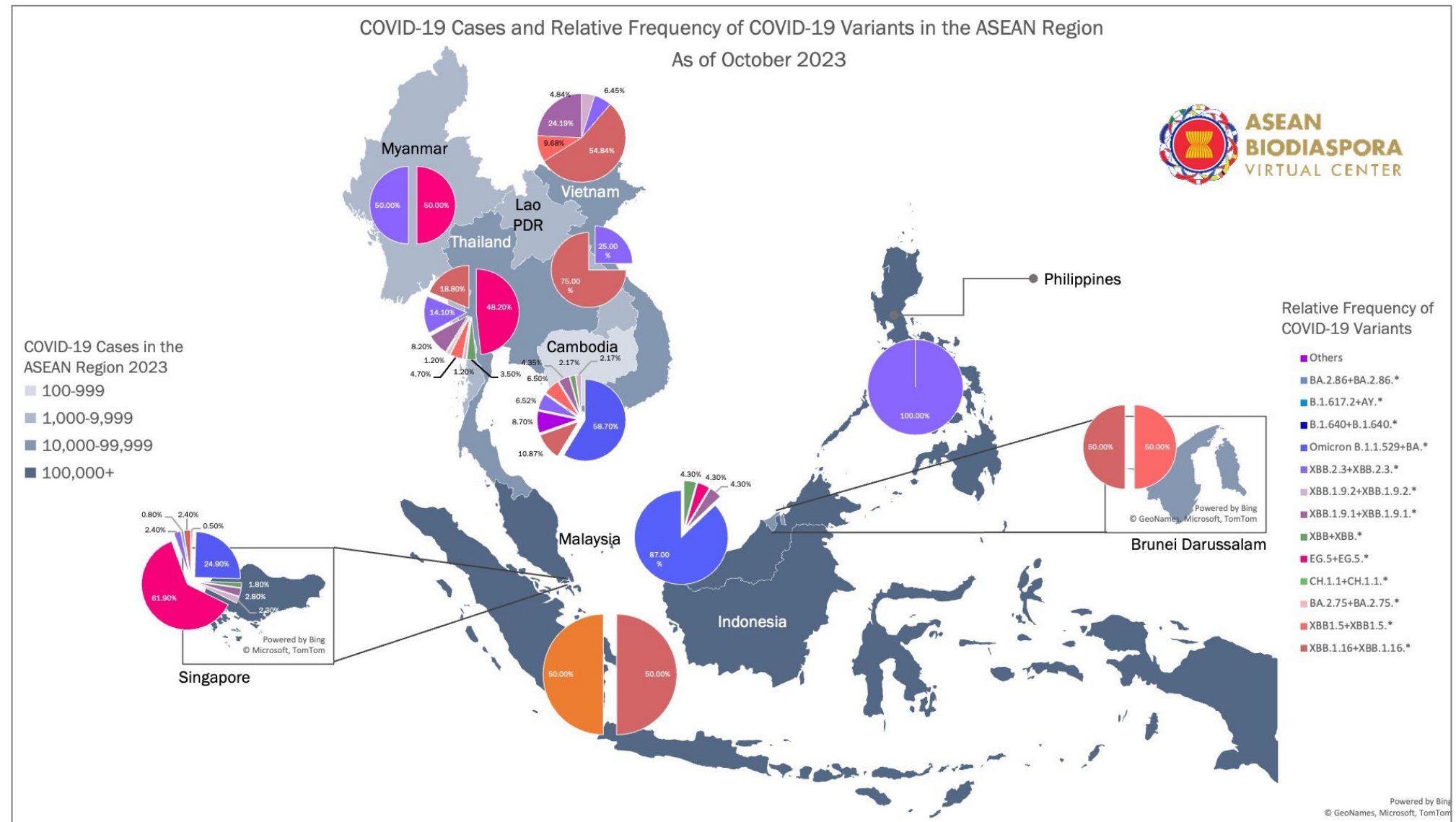

As of October 2023

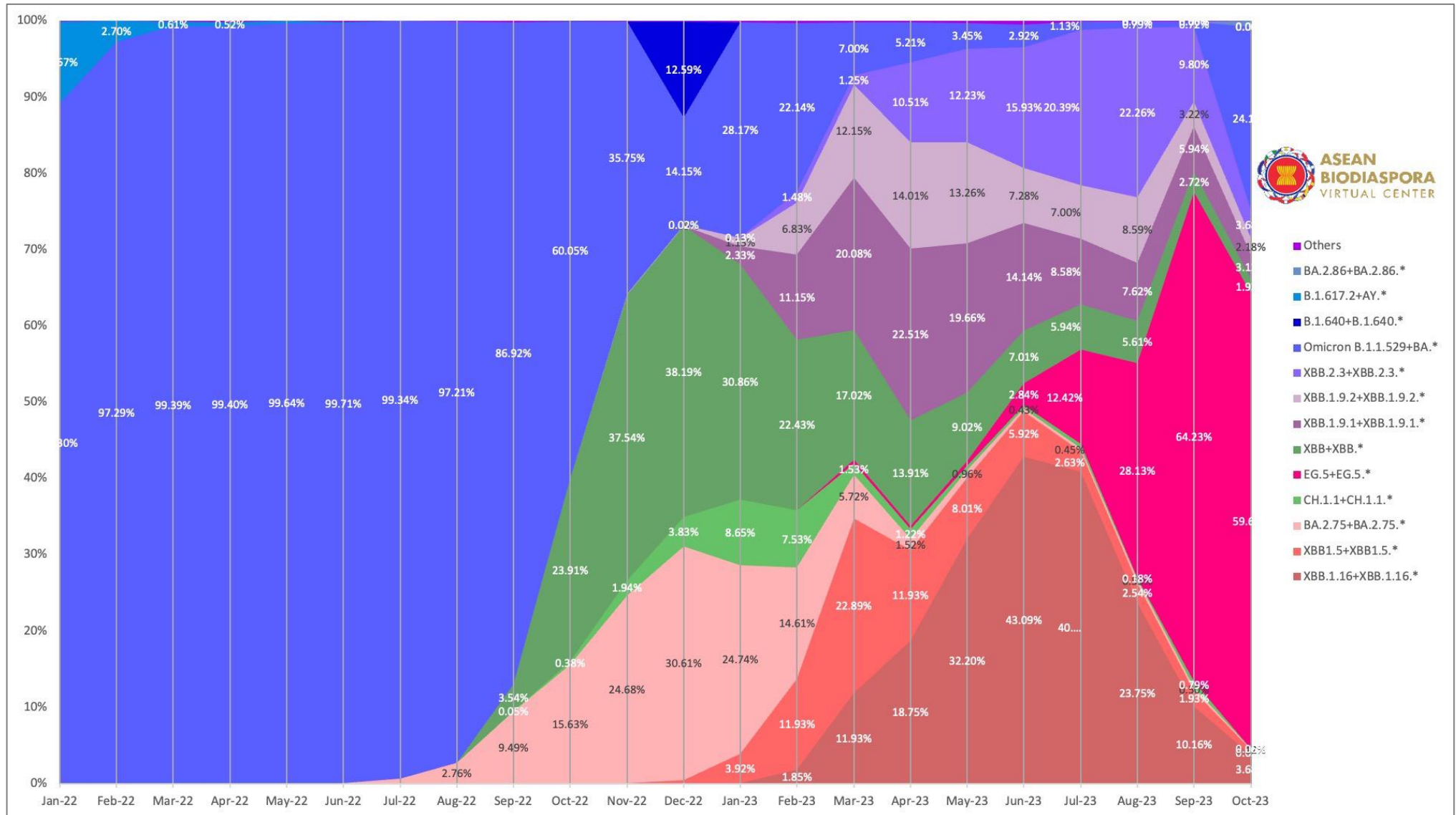

From January to October 2023

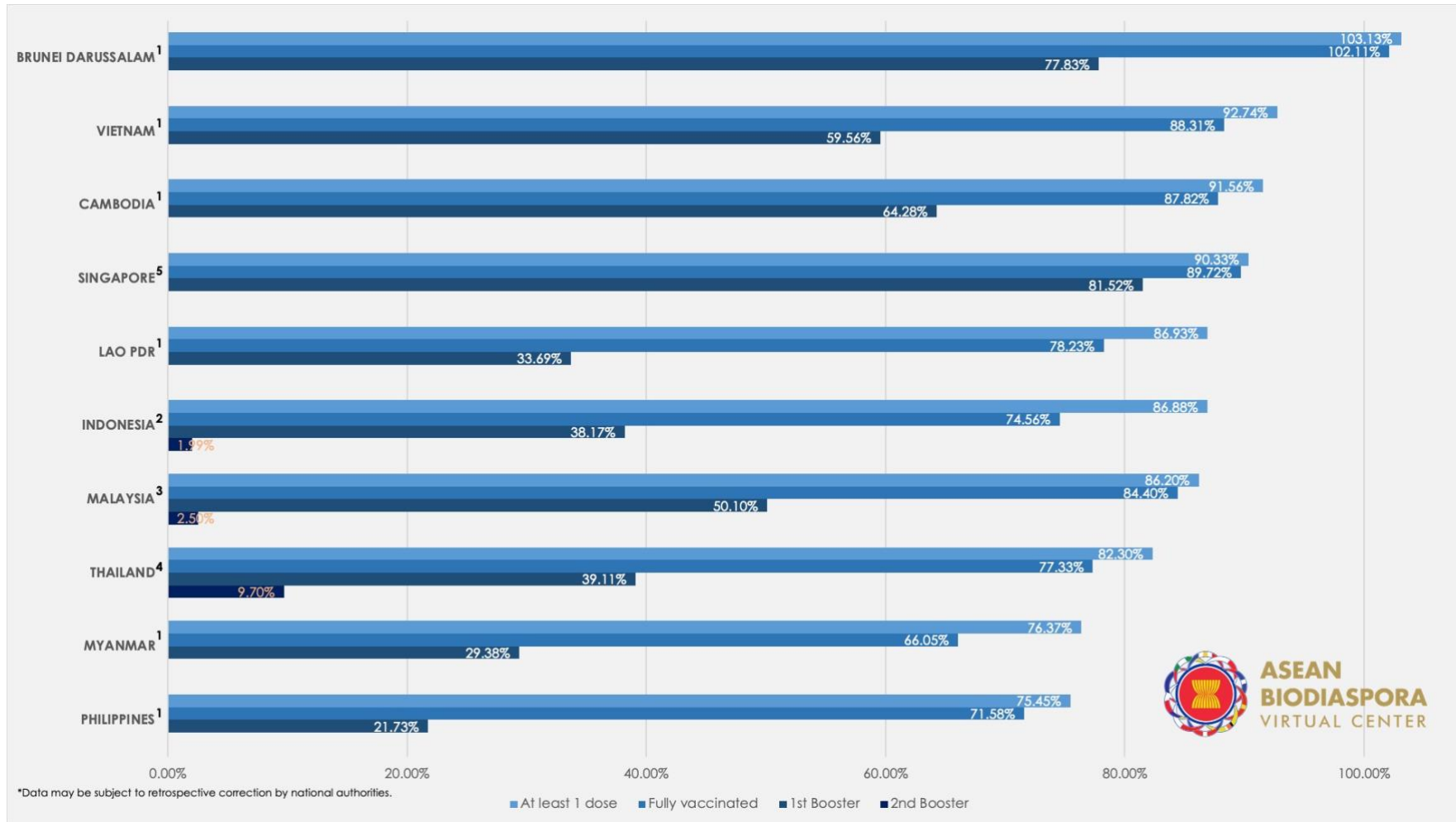

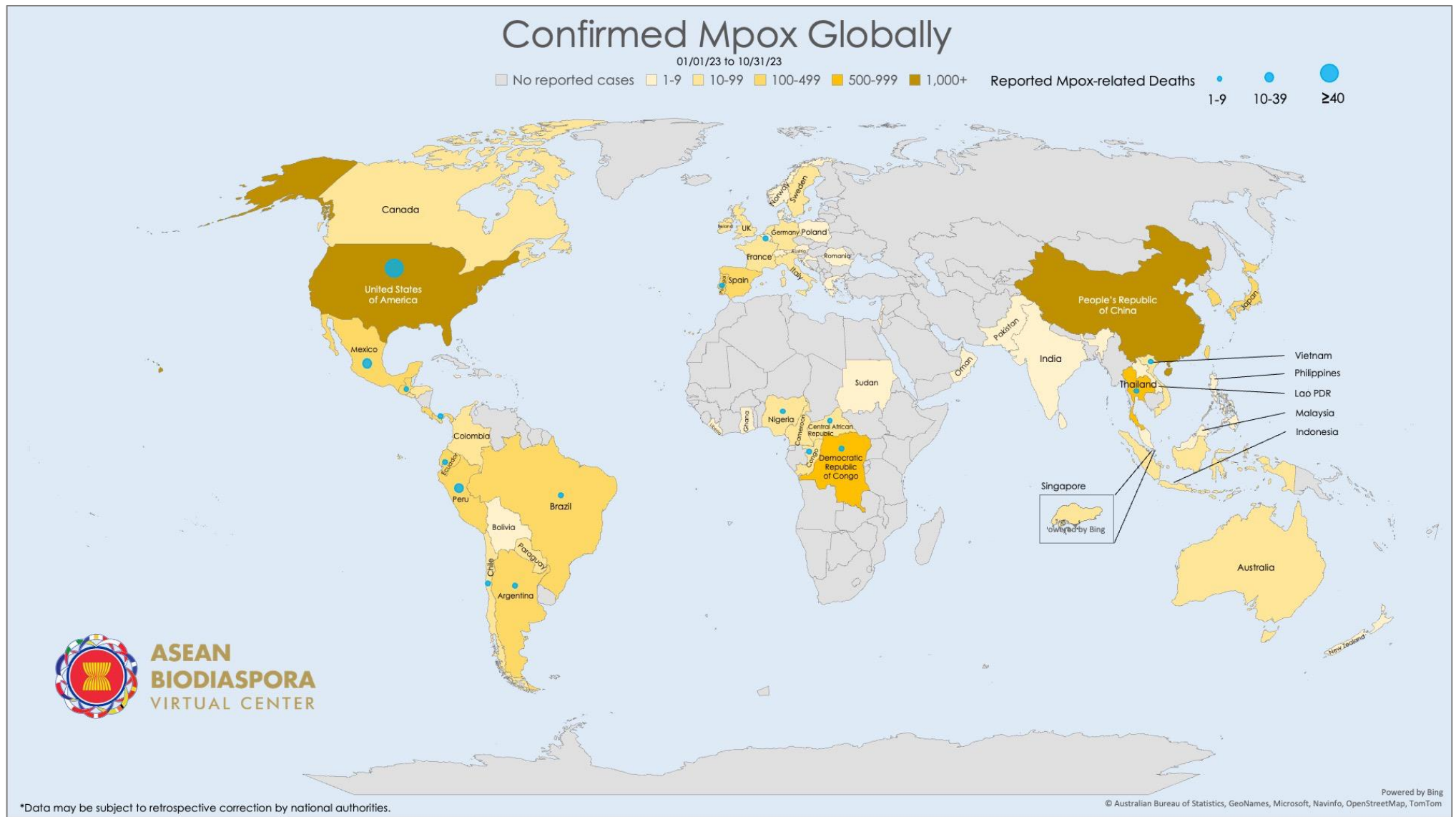

January 1 – October 31, 2023

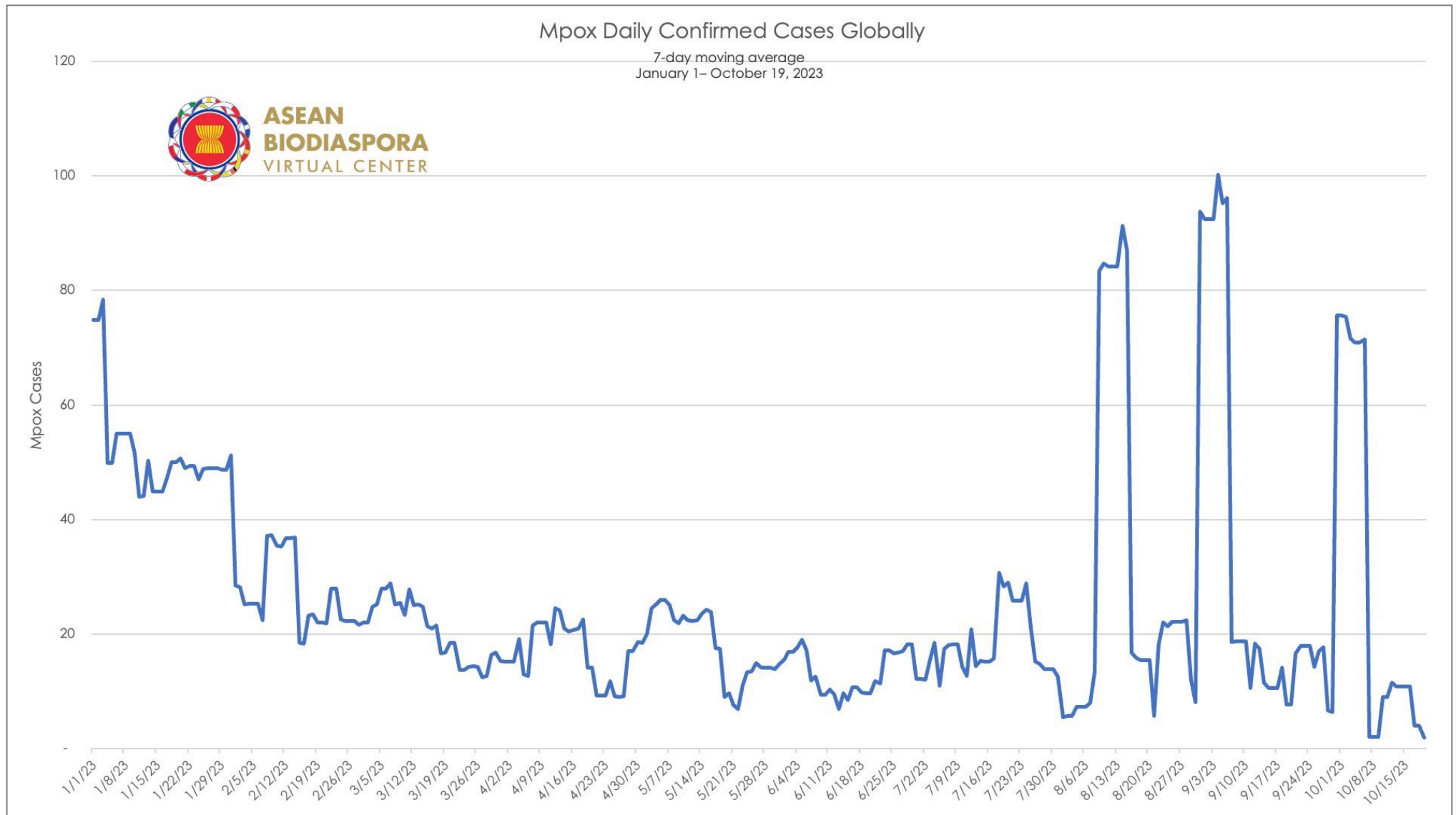

Mpox: Highlights and Situation Overview

- From 01 January to 02 November 2023, there were **7,290** confirmed cases worldwide in 2023, including **93** deaths. Globally, the Case Fatality Rate (CFR) was **1.28%**.
- 633 confirmed cases** including **2 deaths** in the ASEAN region in 2023, with a CFR of **0.32%**.
- 6,657 confirmed cases** of Mpox have been reported in other **5 regions** in 2023 (other than the ASEAN region):

Mpox Global Updates

- In **the USA**, California Riverside County Public Health reported a new mpox case in October 31, the second this week, involving a man over 40. The county has reported 320 mpox cases since the outbreak began last spring. The mpox can be spread through close contact with skin lesions or bodily fluids of infected animals or humans, including droplets. Public health officials encourage residents most at-risk of mpox infection to get vaccinated with the Jynneos vaccine, approved in 2019 for smallpox and mpox prevention in people aged 18 and older. The vaccine consists of two doses taken one month apart, and a person is considered fully vaccinated two weeks after their second shot (Sasic, 2023). [\[Full article\]](#)
- In **Hongkong (SAR)**, the Centre for Health Protection (CHP) of the Department of Health (DH) is investigating a confirmed mpox case and urging the public to increase vigilance and avoid close physical contact with those suspected of contracting the disease. The case involved a 56-year-old male patient who developed vesicles since October 29 and was admitted to Princess Margaret Hospital. The CHP is continuing its epidemiological investigations and will report the case to the World Health Organization. The CHP has set up an mpox telephone hotline to help those who suspect or are concerned about high-risk contact with confirmed patients. The government has activated the alert level of the preparedness and response plan for the disease and will continue to assess the risk based on the latest scientific evidence (The Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region, 2023).
