COVID-19: Highlights and Situation Overview

Global Updates

- Worldwide, over 695 million cases and over 6 million deaths have been attributed to COVID-19.
- **Bulgaria** has confirmed 305 new cases of coronavirus in the last 24 hours, with a 13.7% positive rate (Novinite.com, 2023). There are 343 hospitalized patients with COVID-19, 26 in intensive care units, and 54 new hospital admissions. 252 people have been cured, and 3,475 active cases have been reported. Currently, 38,470 people in Bulgaria have lost their battle against the virus. [Full article]
- **USA**: Two Sheridan County residents died due to COVID-19, bringing the total to 94 (The Sheridan Press, 2023). Both were not hospitalized but had health conditions putting them at higher risk. Deaths are added to the state's coronavirus-related death total based on permanent residence location and death certificate information. [Full article]
- India has recorded 38 new coronavirus infections, 396 active cases, and 5,32,034 deaths, according to Union Health Ministry data, with the death toll at 8 am (PTI, 2023). [Full article]

Regional Updates

• **Singapore** experienced a significant increase in COVID-19 infections from September 17 to 23, with 14,843 people diagnosed, more than double the previous week's 6,401 cases (Khalik, 2023). The Ministry of Health is monitoring the situation but does not worry about the current spike in cases. The peak number of infections was 28,410 a week in March, with 159 hospitalizations and seven ICU admissions. However, hospitalization and ICU admissions usually lag infections. [Full article]

COVID-19 Cases and Deaths

- As of 05 October 2023 (5PM, GMT+7), there were 695,873,553 confirmed cases worldwide, including 6,920,677 deaths. Globally, Case Fatality Rate (CFR) was 1.0%.
- 36,415,690 total confirmed cases of COVID-19 have been reported in the ASEAN Region.
- The Case Fatality Rate in the **ASEAN** Region was 1.01%.

Mpox: Highlights and Situation Overview

- From 01 January to 26 September 2023, there were **6,517** confirmed cases worldwide in 2023, including **83** deaths. Globally, the Case Fatality Rate (CFR) was **1.27%.**
- **403 confirmed cases** including **1 death** in the ASEAN region in 2023, with a CFR of **0.25%**.
- **6,112 confirmed cases** of mpox have been reported in other **5 regions** in 2023 (other than the ASEAN region):

Regional Updates

• Vietnam: Ho Chi Minh City has reported a new monkeypox case, with a 34-year-old male patient showing suspected symptoms (Vietnam+, 2023). The patient, who lives in Binh Chanh district, has not had contact with foreigners or gone abroad recently. The city has recorded four monkeypox cases since 2022, including two female patients returning from abroad. The patient has been quarantined for treatment. [Full article]
