GLOBAL

Clade IIb mpox remains the predominant variant globally. To date, 103,898 cases and 231 deaths (CFR=0.22%) have been reported from **124 countries**.




Figure 1. Global Distribution of Mpox Cases Source: Our World in Data (https://www.


AFRICA

The Democratic Republic of the Congo (DRC) has reported a total of 4,606 cases with 27 deaths (CFR=0.59%), predominantly clade Ib variant. Several African countries have also seen hundreds of cases.

Several African countries have reported increased cases




Figure 4. Trends of Mpox Cases in several African Countries

> Distribution of Mpox Variant (Clade) in ASEAN and Neighbouring Countries Last updated September 11, 2024




Figure 5. The distribution of mpox cases in the ASEAN region




Figure 6. Trends of mpox in the ASEAN Region, July 2022 to September 11, 2024




Figure 7. Trends of mpox among ASEAN member states, July 2022 to September 11, 2024
