GLOBAL

To date, 138,897 cases of mpox and 328 deaths (CFR=0.24%) have been reported across 133 countries globally with clade II as a dominant variant. Seventeen countries outside Africa have also reported severe clade Ib (Sweden, Thailand, India, Germany, the United Kingdom, the United States, Canada, Belgium, Oman, Pakistan, France, China, Qatar, the United Arab Emirates, Brazil, Switzerland, and Australia).

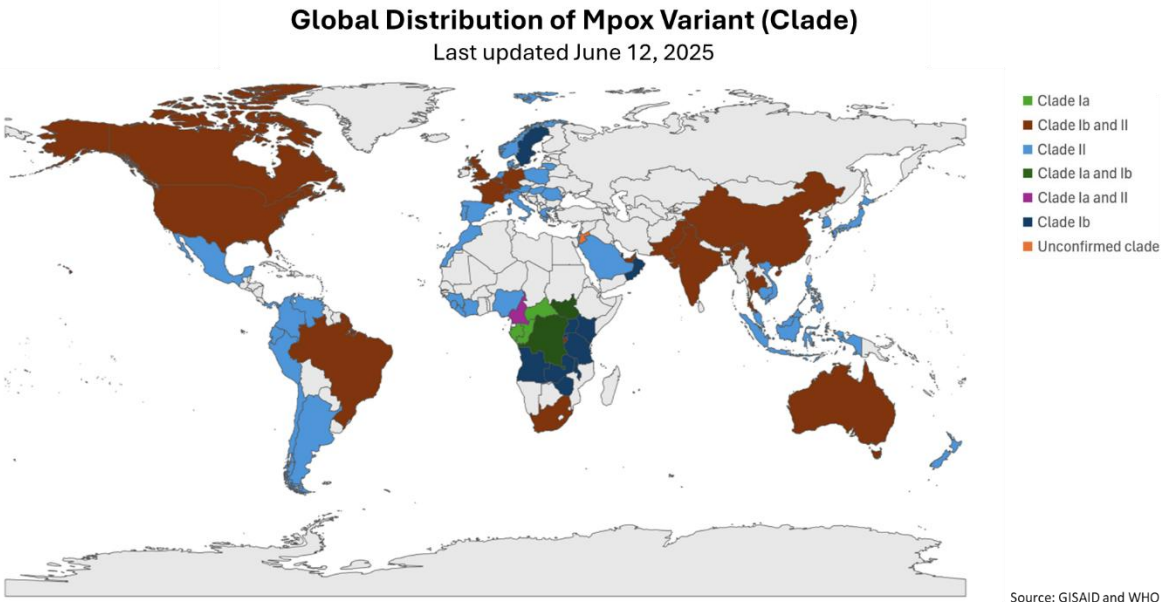


Figure 1. Global Distribution of Mpox Clade

AFRICA

As of June 12, 2025, The Democratic Republic of the Congo (DRC) has reported a total of 19,944 cases with 51 deaths (CFR=0.26%), predominantly clade Ib variant.

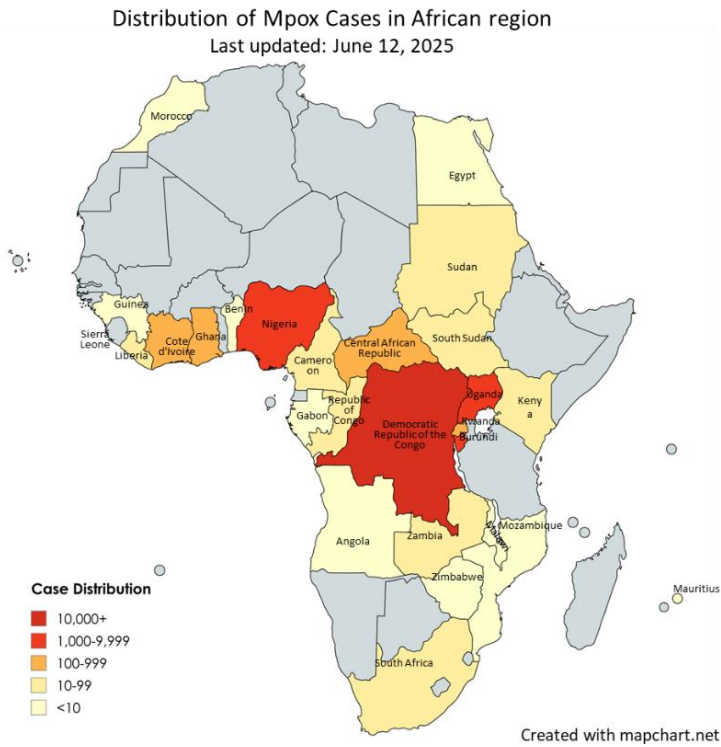


Figure 2. Distribution of Mpox cases in African Countries, 2022-2025

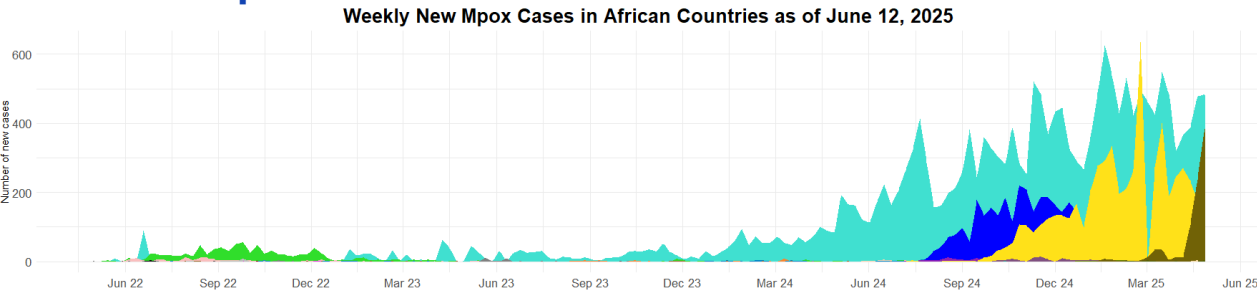


Figure 3. Weekly Trends of Mpox Cases among African Countries

Weekly trends of mpox in African Countries (2022-2025)

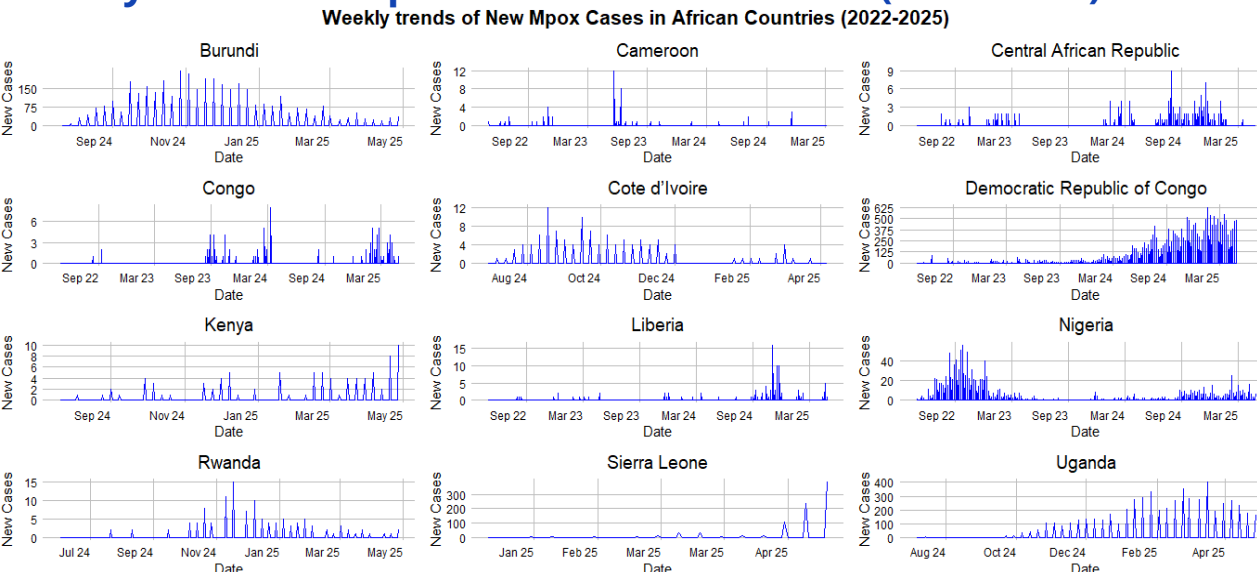


Figure 4. Weekly trends of Mpox Cases in African Countries (2022-2025)

A total of 1,394 confirmed cases, including 26 deaths (CFR=1.87%), has been reported in the region. There was 1 case confirmed since the previous report.

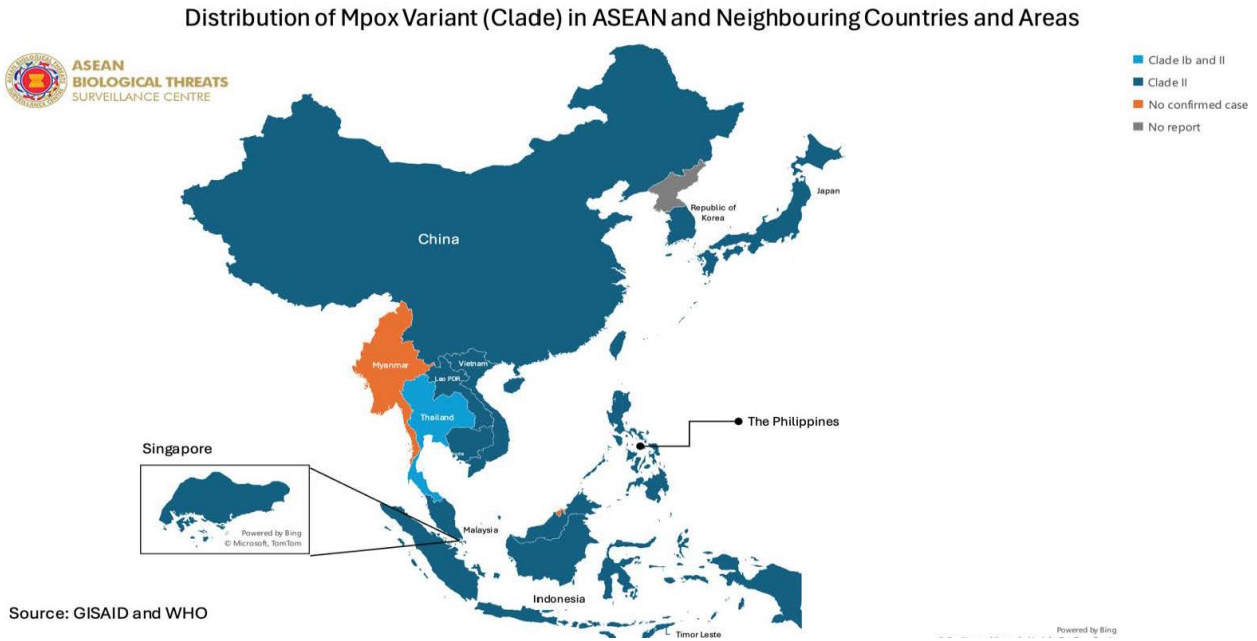


Figure 5. The distribution of mpox variants in ASEAN and Neighbouring Countries and Areas

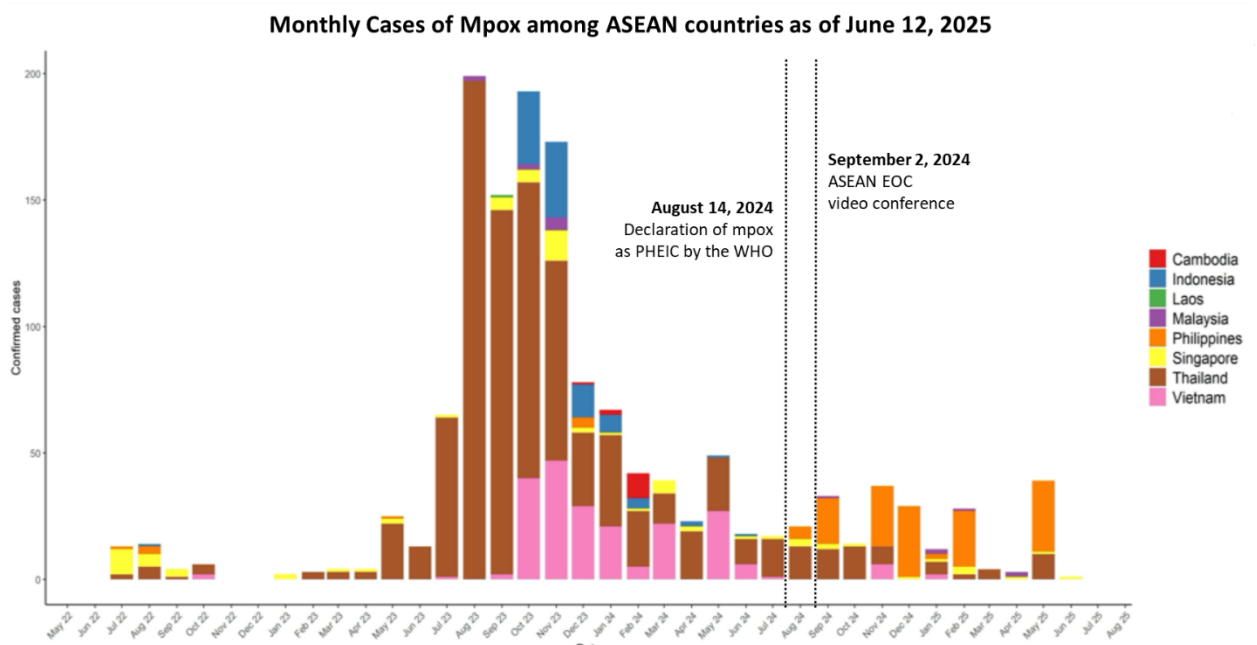


Figure 6. Trends of mpox cases in the ASEAN Region, July 2022 to June 12, 2025

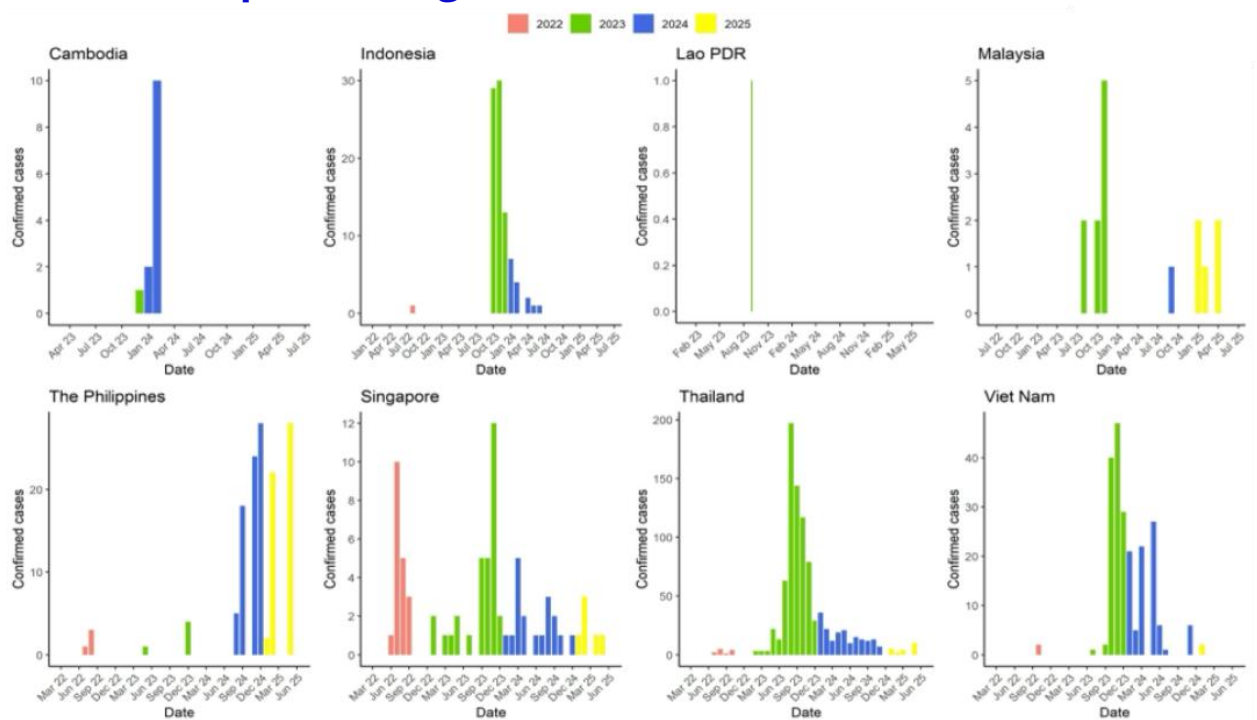


Figure 7. Trends of mpox cases among ASEAN member states, July 2022 to June 12, 2025
