GLOBAL

To date, 122,766 cases of mpox and 272 deaths (CFR=0.22%) have been reported across 129 countries globally with clade II as a dominant variant. Nine countries outside Africa have also reported severe clade Ib (Sweden, Thailand, Germany, the United Kingdom, the United States, Canada, Belgium, France, and China).





Figure 1. Global Distribution of Mpox Clade Source: Our World in Data (<u>https://raw.githubusercontent.com/owid/monkeypox/main/owid-monkeypox-data.csv</u>)

AFRICA

As of February 13, 2025, The Democratic Republic of the Congo (DRC) has reported a total of **12,544 cases with 45 deaths (CFR=0.36%), predominantly clade lb variant**.



ASEAN

A total of 1,290 confirmed cases, including 20 deaths (CFR=1.55%), has been reported in the region. One new confirmed case has been detected since the previous report.

Distribution of Mpox Variant (Clade) in ASEAN and Neighbouring Countries and Areas




Figure 5. The distribution of mpox variants in ASEAN and Neighbouring Countries and Areas




Figure 6. Trends of mpox cases in the ASEAN Region, July 2022 to February 13, 2025




Figure 7. Trends of mpox cases among ASEAN member states, July 2022 to February 13, 2025
