GLOBAL

To date, 124,831 cases of mpox and 287 deaths (CFR=0.23%) have been reported across 130 countries globally with clade II as a dominant variant. Fifteen countries outside Africa have also reported severe clade Ib (Sweden, Thailand, India, Germany, the United Kingdom, the United States, Canada, Belgium, Oman, Pakistan, France, China, Ireland, the United Arab Emirates, and Brazil).




Figure 1. Global Distribution of Mpox Clade Source: Our World in Data (https:// nain/owid-monkeypox-data.csv)

AFRICA

As of March 13, 2025, The Democratic Republic of the Congo (DRC) has reported a total of 12,323 cases with 45 deaths (CFR=0.37%), predominantly clade Ib variant.




Figure 2. Distribution of Mpox cases in African Countries, 2022-2025




Figure 3. Weekly Trends of Mpox Cases among African Countries Source: Our World in Data (https://raw.githubusercontent.com/owid/monl




Figure 4. Weekly trends of Mpox Cases in African Countries (2022-2025)

A total of 1,309 confirmed cases, including 23 deaths (CFR=1.76%), has been reported in the region. There is no new confirmed case reported since the previous report.




Figure 5. The distribution of mpox variants in ASEAN and Neighbouring Countries and Areas




Figure 6. Trends of mpox cases in the ASEAN Region, July 2022 to March 13, 2025




Figure 7. Trends of mpox cases among ASEAN member states, July 2022 to March 13, 2025
