
# ASEAN Biodiaspora Virtual Center Brief Summary Mpox Situation Report GLOBAL & ASEAN REGION

## GLOBAL

**Clade IIb mpox** remains the predominant variant globally. **To date, 103,898 cases and 231 deaths (CFR=0.22%)** have been reported from **124 countries**.



# **AFRICA**

The Democratic Republic of the Congo (DRC) has reported a total of **4,606** cases with 27 deaths (CFR=0.59%), predominantly clade lb variant.

## **ASEAN**

A total of 1,177 confirmed cases, including 18 deaths (CFR=1.53%), have been reported. There have been no additional confirmed cases since the previous report on September 11, 2024. One case of the lb clade was reported in Thailand.




Figure 5. The distribution of mpox cases in the ASEAN region






Figure 4. Trends of Mpox Cases in several African Countries Figure 7 Source: Our World in Data (<u>https://raw.githubusercontent.com/owid/monkeypox/main/owid-monkeypox-data.csv</u>)




Figure 6. Trends of mpox in the ASEAN Region, July 2022 to September 13, 2024




Figure 7. Trends of mpox among ASEAN member states, July 2022 to September 13, 2024
