GLOBAL

To date, 116,015 cases of mpox and 255 deaths (CFR=0.22%) have been reported from 124 countries with clade II remaining the predominant variant worldwide.

Five countries outside Africa have also reported severe clade lb (**Sweden**, **Thailand**, **Germany**, **the United Kingdom**, **and the United States**), with the United Kingdom reporting a case in a person returning from an African country who subsequently infected three other contacts, the first local transmission outside Africa to date.




Figure 1. Global Distribution of Mpox Clade Source: Our World in Data (<u>https://raw.githubusercontent.com/owid/monkeypox/main/owid-monkeypox-data.csv</u>)

AFRICA

As of November 20, The Democratic Republic of the Congo (DRC) has reported a total of **10,702 cases with 45 deaths (CFR=0.42%), predominantly clade lb variant.** A vaccination campaign began on October 5 and is currently underway, reaching over 50,000 people.



ASEAN

A total of 1,243 confirmed cases, including 18 deaths (CFR=1.45%), have been reported in the region. One case of the lb clade was reported in Thailand. There are 15 new confirmed cases since the previous report on November 12, 2024.

Distribution of Mpox Variant (Clade) in ASEAN and Neighbouring Countries and Areas




Figure 5. The distribution of mpox variants in the ASEAN region



Weekly trends of mpox in African Countries (2022-2024)





Figure 4. Weekly trends of Mpox Cases in African Countries (2022-2024) Source: Our World in Data (<u>https://raw.githubusercontent.com/owid/monkeypox/main/owid-monkeypox-data.csv</u>)




Figure 7. Trends of mpox cases among ASEAN member states, July 2022 to November 20, 2024
