GLOBAL

To date, 150,974 cases of mpox and 380 deaths (CFR=0.25%) have been reported across 137 countries globally with clade II as a dominant variant. Eighteen countries outside Africa have also reported severe clade Ib (Sweden, Thailand, India, Germany, the United Kingdom, the United States, Canada, Belgium, Oman, Pakistan, France, China, Qatar, the United Arab Emirates, Brazil, Switzerland, Australia, and Italy).

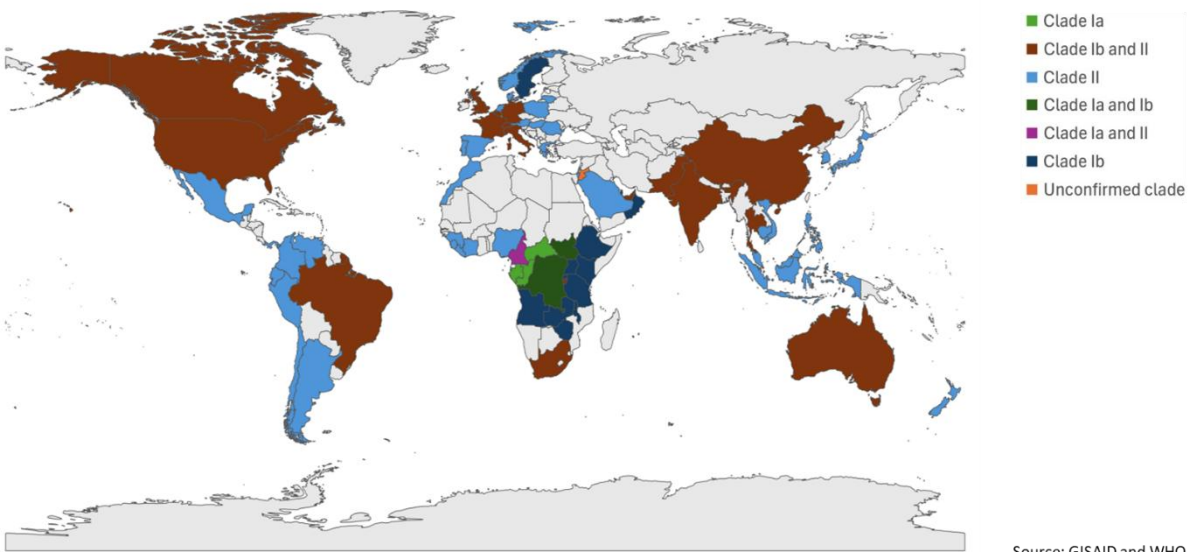


Figure 1. Global Distribution of Mpox Clade

AFRICA

As of August 21, 2025, The Democratic Republic of the Congo (DRC) has reported a total of 24,462 cases with 70 deaths (CFR=0.29%), predominantly clade Ib variant.

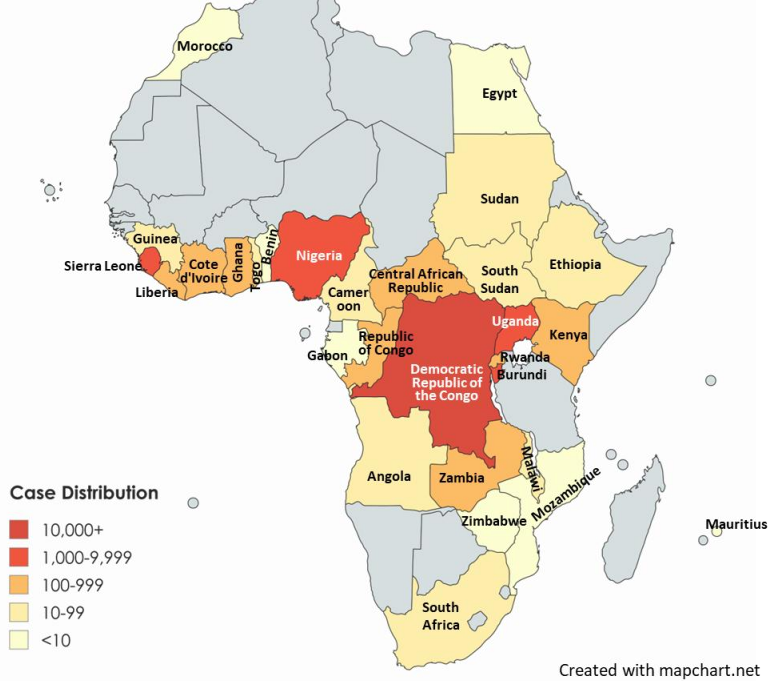


Figure 2. Distribution of Mpox cases in African Countries, 2022-2025

Weekly New Mpox Cases in African Countries as of August 21, 2025

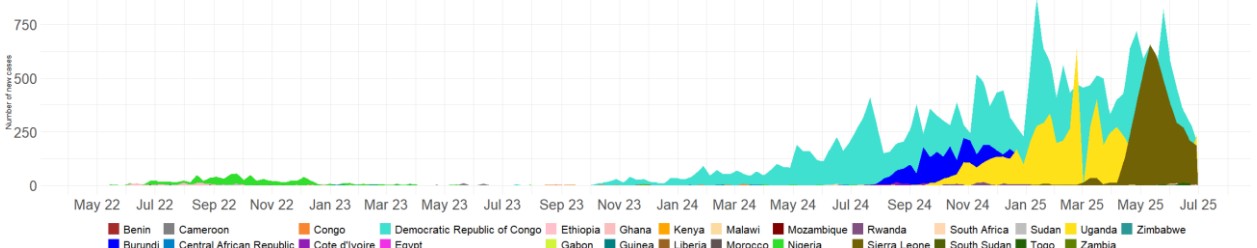


Figure 3. Weekly Trends of Mpox Cases among African Countries

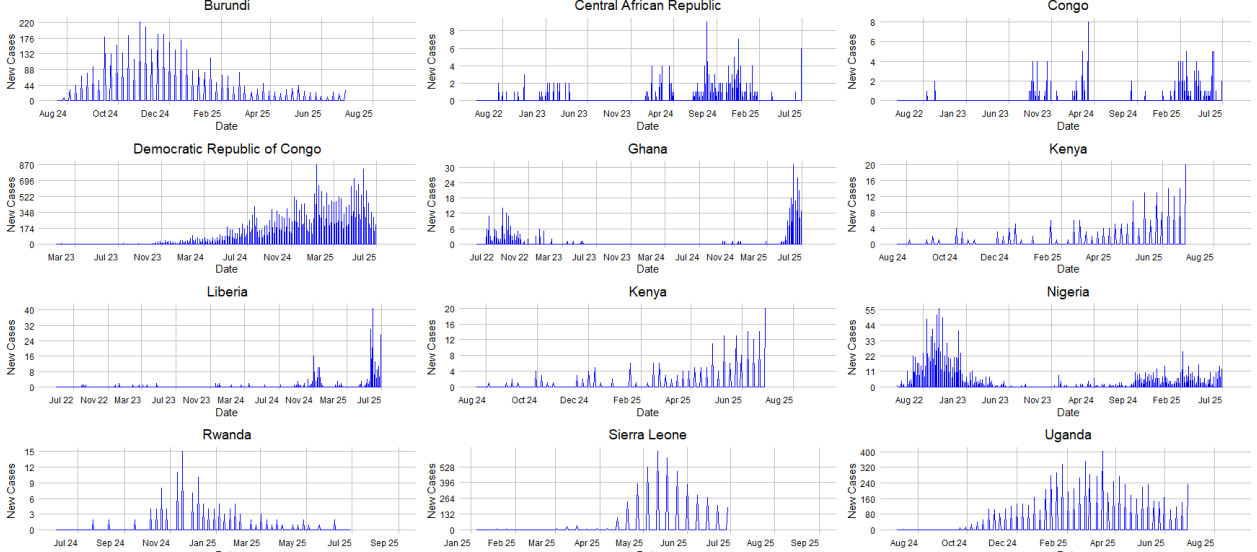


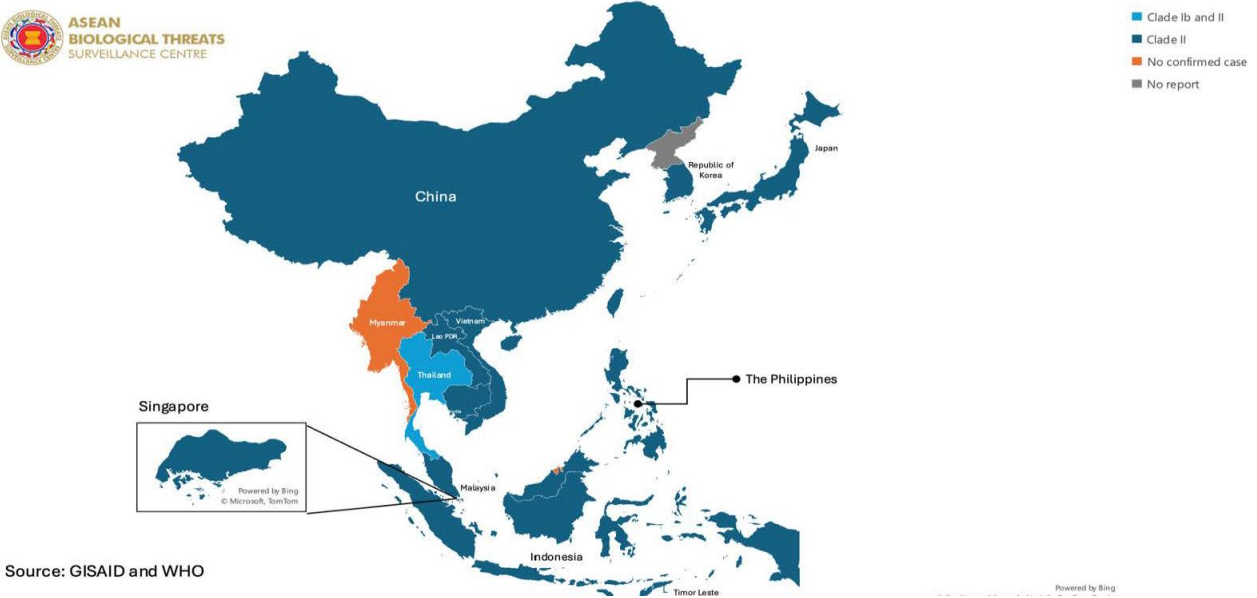
Figure 4. Weekly trends of Mpox Cases in African Countries (2022-2025)

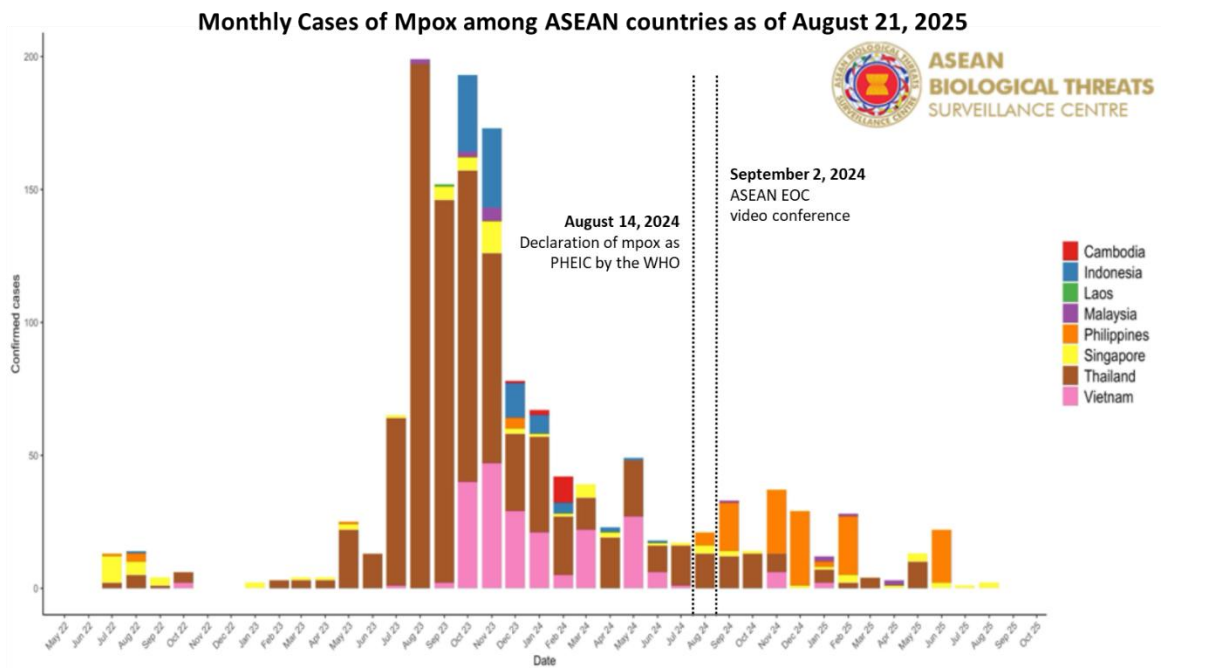


Figure 6. Trends of mpox cases in the ASEAN Region, July 2022 to August 21, 2025

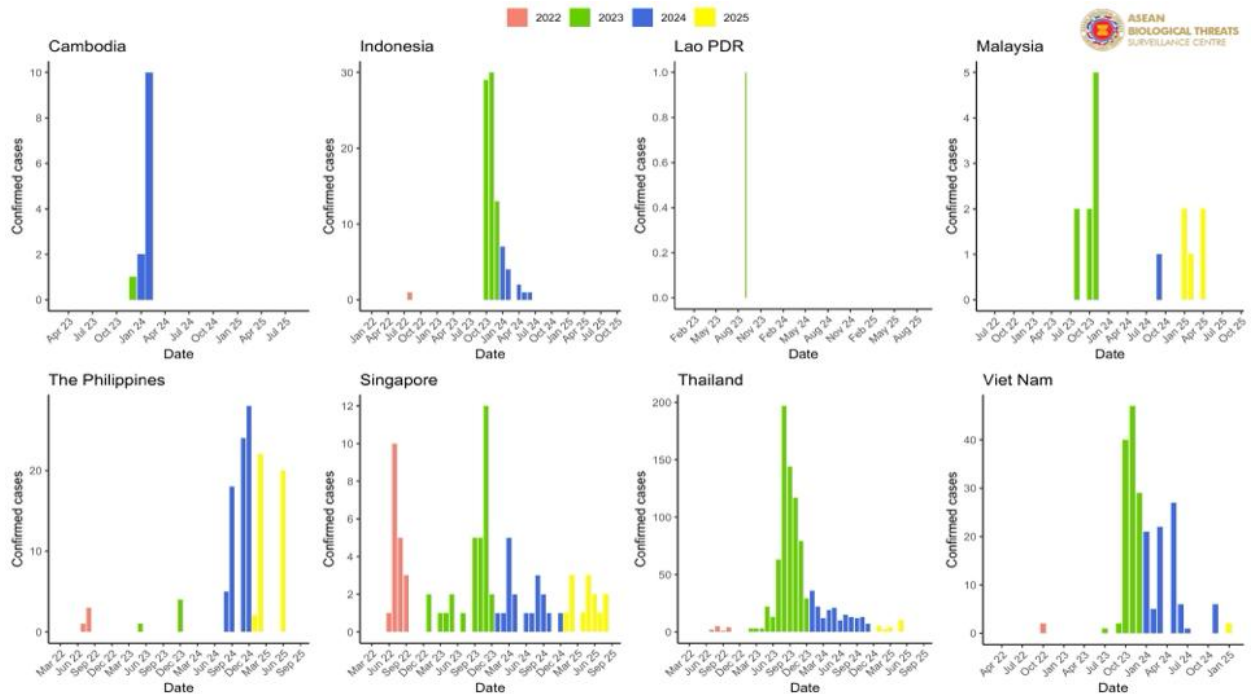


Figure 7. Trends of mpox cases among ASEAN member states, July 2022 to August 21, 2025
