

AFRICA

Clade II mpox remains the predominant variant globally. To date, 110,570 cases and 237 deaths (CFR=0.21%) have been reported from 124 countries.



ASEAN

A total of 1,201 confirmed cases, including 18 deaths (CFR=1.50%), have been reported. One case of the lb clade was reported in Thailand. There has been no additional confirmed case of mpox since the previous report on October 18, 2024.



As of October 21, The Democratic Republic of the Congo (DRC) has reported a total of 7,414 cases with 27 deaths (CFR=0.36%), predominantly clade Ib variant. A vaccination campaign targeting health workers and vulnerable groups began on October 5 and is currently underway in three provinces, reaching 14,180 people in North Kivu, South Kivu, and Tshopo.




Figure 5. The distribution of mpox variants in the ASEAN region



Weekly trends of mpox in African Countries (2022-2024)




Figure 4. Weekly trends of Mpox Cases in African Countries (2022-2024) Source: Our World in Data (https://raw.githubusercontent.com/c




Figure 6. Trends of mpox cases in the ASEAN Region, July 2022 to October 21, 2024




Figure 7. Trends of mpox cases among ASEAN member states, July 2022 to October 21, 2024
