#### **GLOBAL**

To date, 118,367 cases of mpox and 268 deaths (CFR=0.23%) have been reported across 127 countries globally with clade II as a dominant variant. Nine countries outside Africa have also reported severe clade Ib (Sweden, Thailand, Germany, the United Kingdom, the United States, Canada, Belgium, France, and China).




Figure 1. Global Distribution of Mpox Clade

#### **AFRICA**

As of January 23, 2025, The Democratic Republic of the Congo (DRC) has reported a total of **10,492 cases with 45 deaths (CFR=0.43%), predominantly clade Ib variant**.




Figure 2. Distribution of Mpox cases in African Countries, 2022-2025




Figure 3. Weekly Trends of Mpox Cases among African Countries

### Weekly trends of mpox in African Countries (2022-2025)




Figure 4. Weekly trends of Mpox Cases in African Countries (2022-2025)

A total of 1,279 confirmed cases, including 20 deaths (CFR=1.56%), have been reported in the region. There is no new confirmed case since the previous report.




Figure 5. The distribution of mpox variants in ASEAN and Neighbouring Countries and Areas




Figure 6. Trends of mpox cases in the ASEAN Region, July 2022 to January 23, 2025




Figure 7. Trends of mpox cases among ASEAN member states, July 2022 to January 23, 2025
