# **GLOBAL**

To date, 150,889 cases of mpox and 377 deaths (CFR=0.25%) have been reported across **137 countries globally** with **clade II** as a dominant variant. Eighteen countries outside Africa have also reported severe clade Ib (Sweden, Thailand, India, Germany, the United Kingdom, the United States, Canada, Belgium, Oman, Pakistan, France, China, Qatar, the United Arab Emirates, Brazil, Switzerland, Australia and Italy).





Figure 1. Global Distribution of Mpox Clade Source: Our World in Data (https://raw.githubusercontent.com/owid/monkeypox/main/owid-monkeypox-data.csv)

# **AFRICA**

As of July 24, 2025, The Democratic Republic of the Congo (DRC) has reported a total of 24,378 cases with 67 deaths (CFR=0.27%), predominantly clade Ib variant.



# **ASEAN**

A total of 1,426 confirmed cases, including 27 deaths (CFR=1.89%), has been reported in the region, with no new cases since the last update.

Distribution of Mpox Variant (Clade) in ASEAN and Neighbouring Countries and Areas




Figure 5. The distribution of mpox variants in ASEAN and Neighbouring Countries and Areas







Figure 4. Weekly trends of Mpox Cases in African Countries (2022-2025) Source: Our World in Data (https://raw.githubusercontent.com/owid/monkeypox/main/owid-monkeypox-data.csv)




Figure 7. Trends of mpox cases among ASEAN member states, July 2022 to July 24, 2025
