



Clade II mpox remains the predominant variant globally. To date, 110,570 cases and 237 deaths (CFR=0.21%) have been reported from 124 countries.



AFRICA

As of October 29, The Democratic Republic of the Congo (DRC) has reported a total of 7,414 cases with 27 deaths (CFR=0.36%), predominantly clade **Ib variant**. A vaccination campaign began on October 5 and is currently underway, reaching 40,547 people.



ASEAN

A total of 1,228 confirmed cases, including 18 deaths (CFR=1.47%), have been reported in the region. One case of the Ib clade was reported in Thailand. There are no new confirmed cases since the previous report on October 25, 2024.

Distribution of mpox cases in ASEAN Region 2023-2024








Figure 6. Trends of mpox cases in the ASEAN Region, July 2022 to October 29, 2024




Figure 7. Trends of mpox cases among ASEAN member states, July 2022 to October 29, 2024
