GLOBAL

To date, 122,764 cases of mpox and 272 deaths (CFR=0.22%) have been reported across 128 countries globally with clade II as a dominant variant. Nine countries outside Africa have also reported severe clade Ib (Sweden, Thailand, Germany, the United Kingdom, the United States, Canada, Belgium, France, and China).




Figure 1. Global Distribution of Mpox Clade

AFRICA

As of January 30, 2025, The Democratic Republic of the Congo (DRC) has reported a total of 12,544 cases with 45 deaths (CFR=0.36%), predominantly clade Ib variant.




Figure 2. Distribution of Mpox cases in African Countries, 2022-2025




Figure 3. Weekly Trends of Mpox Cases among African Countries




Figure 4. Weekly trends of Mpox Cases in African Countries (2022-2025)




Figure 5. The distribution of mpox variants in ASEAN and Neighbouring Countries and Areas




Figure 6. Trends of mpox cases in the ASEAN Region, July 2022 to January 30, 2025




Figure 7. Trends of mpox cases among ASEAN member states, July 2022 to January 30, 2025
