COVID-19: Highlights and Situation Overview

Global Update

- Worldwide, there have been over 164 million cases and more than 3 million deaths attributed to COVID-19.
- India reported a further decline in new COVID-19 cases on Monday (May 17), although daily deaths remained above 4,000. The government issued detailed guidelines on Sunday for monitoring COVID-19 cases, with the Health Ministry asking villages to look out for people with a flu-like illness and get them tested for COVID-19. Some Indian states said on Sunday (May 16) that they would extend COVID-19 lockdowns to help contain the pandemic. Meanwhile, the country received 60,000 more doses of the Sputnik V vaccine from Russia on May 16. The country's average vaccination rate over seven days fell to 1.7 million on Sunday, from 1.8 million a week ago, after Maharashtra, the richest state, and Karnataka (South part) put the rollout of shots on hold for adults younger than 45. So far, India has fully vaccinated just over 40.4 million people, or 2.9% of its population.

Regional Update

- Thailand has provided funds, medical equipment, and other essential items to the government of Laos as assistance in the fight against COVID-19. The Royal Thai Embassy, in cooperation with the Thai community in Laos, came together to provide cash, testing equipment, hospital beds, and facemasks to Laos. The Thai government plans to deliver additional medical equipment to help increase the country's capability in Covid-19 testing at Bokeo and Xayaboury provincial hospitals, as well as other equipment. Thailand will also provide medical equipment for use in hospitals in Savannakhet province and will provide online medical public health consultations, to strengthen COVID-19 testing capacity and collaboration between Thai and Laotian medical staff, especially at the Thai-Laos border, to help prevent the spread of COVID-19.
- Authorities in Vientiane Capital (Laos) have divided the city into color-coded zones with the aim of limited future lockdowns to affected areas only. Certain villages in Vientiane Capital have been designated dark red, red, and yellow zones in accordance with the number of cases of COVID-19 confirmed in the village. Residents of red and dark red zones, including government employees, will be prohibited from leaving their homes for work, while markets and factories in these areas will be closed. The new measures are designed to prevent further spread of COVID-19 in residential areas without having to close the entire city.

Vaccine Update

Indonesia's Ministry of Health said on Sunday (May 16) that Indonesia has suspended distribution of a batch of AstraZeneca's COVID-19 vaccine to run tests for sterility and toxicity following the death of a 22-year-old man a day after immunization. The batch consists of 448,480 vaccine doses that arrived in Indonesia last month which is part of a delivery of more than 3.85 million doses from the COVAX Facility. The national committee in charge of monitoring effects of novel coronavirus vaccination launched an investigation earlier this month after a 22-year-old man in Jakarta died a day after receiving an AstraZeneca shot from the CTMAV547 batch. However, Health Ministry's spokesperson assured that the tests are just a form of caution by the government to ensure the safety of this vaccine and that

the distribution of other batches of AstraZeneca vaccines will not be affected. The batch test could take at least two weeks, and after it is proven that it is sterile and does not contain toxins, the use of the vaccine will be resumed.

- Malaysia's Coordinating Minister for the National COVID-19 Immunisation Programme said that the country has no plans to stop the use
 of the AstraZeneca vaccine in Malaysia following Indonesia's decision to suspend its use. He added that the COVID-19 Immunisation Task
 Force held a meeting this morning (May 17) and to date, there have not been any serious side effects since using the AstraZeneca
 vaccine in Malaysia. Malaysia have already vaccinated almost half a million, or 475,984 citizens who have been given at least one dose
 of the vaccine. The minister said vaccinations in Malaysia would be ramped up within the next two months once regular deliveries of an
 expected 2.5 million doses of Pfizer and Sinovac vaccines begin by July.
- Singapore's Health Minister said on Sunday (May 16) that Singapore is studying if it should change its COVID-19 vaccination strategy to extend the time between vaccine shots to allow more people to get protection from a first dose. If implemented, this will take place in phase two of the country's vaccination programme. So far, Singapore has followed the recommended administration by the vaccine manufacturers two doses of the Pfizer-BioNTech vaccine are given three weeks apart, while the two jabs of the Moderna vaccine are given four weeks apart.
- Vietnam' Health Ministry announced that the country will get 31 million COVID-19 vaccine doses developed by U.S.-based firm Pfizer and Germany's BioNTech Pfizer Inc. this year. In addition, 38.9 million of AstraZeneca vaccine will be provided to Vietnam via the global vaccine access mechanism Covax, of which, around 1.7 million doses under this program are scheduled to arrive in Vietnam on Sunday. Vietnam began its own COVID-19 inoculation program on March 8 after using the AstraZeneca vaccine that arrived either through contracts or Covax. So far, over 969,697 people in 62 cities and provinces, or around 1% of the country's population, have been inoculated which mainly include frontline workers and medics at local hospitals.

Travel Advisories (new update/s)

- Malaysia: Sabah will reintroduce all inter-district travel beginning May 27 to June 3. According to the state COVID-19 spokesman, only movements by residents between Kota Kinabalu, Putatan and Penampang districts are allowed, while residents in other districts must remain in their respective districts.
- Singapore: The launch of the Singapore-Hong Kong air travel bubble, originally planned for May 26, will be deferred for the second time. The postponement comes amid a recent increase in unlinked COVID-19 community cases in Singapore. According to Singapore's Ministry of Transport (MOT) on Monday (May 17), the country is "unable to meet the criteria to start" the air travel bubble. He added that the authorities will review a new launch date towards the end of Phase 2 (Heightened Alert), which runs until June 13.

Cases and Deaths as of 17 May 2021

- As of 17 May 2021 (2PM, GMT+8), worldwide, there were 164,107,070 confirmed cases, including 3,397,898 deaths. Globally, Case Fatality Rate (CFR) is 2.1.
- In China, there were 104,736 confirmed cases with 4,858 deaths, including deaths in Hong Kong (210) and Taiwan (12). Confirmed cases in China include confirmed cases in Hong Kong (11,825), Macau (49), and Taiwan (2,017).
- 3,688,557 confirmed cases of COVID-19 have been reported in the ASEAN region with a total of 73,214 deaths, with a CFR of 2.0.


